

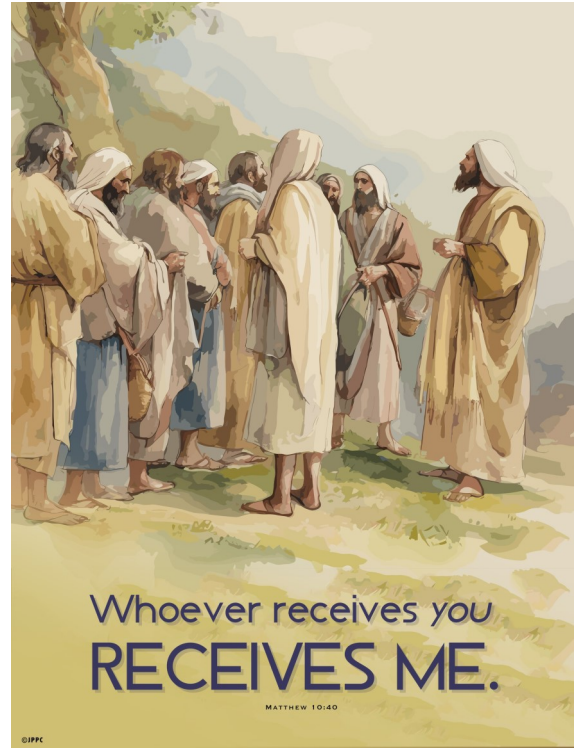

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you. This past week we received the sad news that beloved former pastor, Fr. Joe Bayne, suddenly passed away in the friary in Chicago after he had returned from vacation. The friars and the people he served will always remember his joyful, magnanimous spirit and the good zeal and dedication he brought to ministry. In addition to his term as pastor here at St. Stan's, Fr. Joe dedicated many years of his life to the troubled youth who passed through The



Franciscan Center in Buffalo, NY. As the descendant of firefighters, including his dad, who died in the line of duty, Fr. Joe always had a special place in his heart for first responders, including here in Chicopee. Most recently he served those beginning their Franciscan formation as postulants. He will be deeply missed.

In this Sunday's word of God, we hear a scripture reading often proclaimed at the Mass of Christian Burial: "We were buried with Christ through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life.... If then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him" (Romans 6:4, 8). With firm hope in this promise of eternal life in Christ given to us in baptism, we commend Fr. Joe to the goodness and mercy of the Lord. May Fr. Joe rest in eternal peace and joy.

The Basilica of St. Stanislaus will celebrate a special Memorial Mass for Fr. Joe on the one-month anniversary of his death, **Sunday, July 23rd, at 4:00 p.m.** A reception will follow. Please plan to join us for this special Mass, the most powerful prayer we can offer.



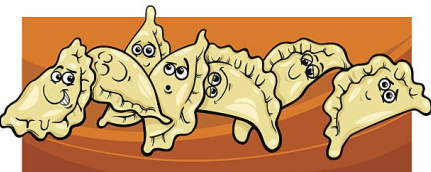

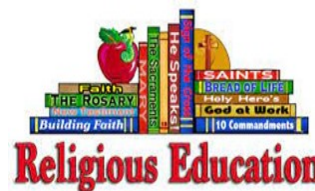

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK - One of the titles of Jesus is that of "Divine Healer." He is healer of our bodies and our souls. The gospels are filled with stories of Jesus healing the sick, who came to him. Jesus is our divine physician and his healing ministry continues in the Church in different ways. The most obvious is the Sacrament of the Sick. Through the laying on of hands and the imposition of holy oil on the forehead and palms, the priest offers the healing presence of Jesus to those who are ill.

Catholics should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick if they are in danger of dying, seriously ill, preparing for or recovering from surgery, experiencing a chronic health issue or suffering from the effects of aging. The Sacrament may be received multiple times as long as the illness or condition persists.

The Sacrament of the Sick may be celebrated communally, gathering together those who are in need of Jesus' healing touch. Here at St. Stanislaus we are renewing the practice of anointing the sick after the Sunday Mass once a month.

Beginning Sunday, July 23, 2023 we will celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick on **the fourth Sunday of each month** after each Sunday Mass (including the Saturday Vigil Mass). The anointing will take place after the closing hymn of the Mass. The presider will remain in the sanctuary and will invite those who are in need of the sacrament to come forward for the laying on of hands and the anointing with holy oil. We encourage you and/or your loved ones who are ill to take advantage of this opportunity each month to celebrate this wonderful sacrament of God's love and healing.

BIULETYN Parafialny



Nie lubimy zazwyczaj ludzi, którzy od nas dużo wymagają. Uczniowie, studenci boją się nauczycieli i profesorów, którzy są surowi, wymagający na egzaminach. Nie lubimy wymagających dyrektorów i przełożonych. Przez świat przelewa się wręcz fala łatwizny. Sprzyjają temu społeczne prądy młodzieżowe, liberałowie głoszący hasła, że człowiek do niczego nie jest zobowiązany; że może robić, co mu się chce, co mu się podoba, bo jest wolny. Dzisiaj rzeczy, którymi się człowiek posługuje, są coraz lepsze, i oczekiwania człowieka wobec przedmiotów codziennego użytku też są coraz wyższe, lecz sam człowiek dzięki nim wcale się lepszym nie staje. Być lepszym, to w trudzie pracować nad sobą, stawiać sobie wymagania, nie iść na uproszczenia. Gdyby sportowiec nie trenował na stadionie, nie mógłby startować w igrzyskach sportowych i swoimi wyczynami nie zachwycałby widzów. Gdybyśmy leżeli na tapczanie przed szklanym ekranem, nie pracowali, nie przesiadywali w bibliotece, w laboratorium zapewne dzisiaj jeszcze ludzkość nie wyszłaby z epoki kamienia gładzonego.

Św. Jan Paweł II nauczał Polaków: „Nie chcecie Polski, która by was mało kosztowała”. A do młodzieży często powtarzał: „Musicie od siebie wymagać, nawet gdyby inni od was nie wymagali”. I to dużo więcej, bez obawy uszczerbku na zdrowiu. A jest odwrotnie, w wielu środowiskach postępowi nauczyciele życia lansują hasła wyzwolenia od wszelkiego trudu, wysiłku, wszystko zdobyć jak najłatwiej, bez zobowiązań. Postuluje się, by rodzice od swoich dzieci za wiele nie wymagali. Zaleca się wychowanie bezstresowe, czyli kształtowanie takiego człowieka, który w przyszłości potknie się o najmniejszą nierówność. Bo nie będzie przygotowany do tego, by omijać napotkane przeszkody.

W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Chrystus staje przed nami jako Ten, który stawia nam bardzo wysokie wymagania: „Kto miłuje ojca lub matkę bardziej niż Mnie, nie jest Mnie godzien. Kto nie bierze krzyża swego, a idzie za Mną, nie jest Mnie godzien”. Chrystus chce być pierwszy od twojej matki, od twego ojca, od twojego kochanego dziecka, syna i córki. A więc wymagania jakby wbrew naszej naturze. Co więcej, mówi o tych, co nie biorą krzyża, a idą za Nim, że nie są Go godni. Są również tacy ludzie, którzy idą za Chrystusem, ale bez wymagań. Przyklaskują Chrystusowi, przyklaskują papieżowi. Ale już te trudniejsze wymagania Ewangelii podają w wątpliwość, zostawiają na boku, nie chcą o nich słyszeć.

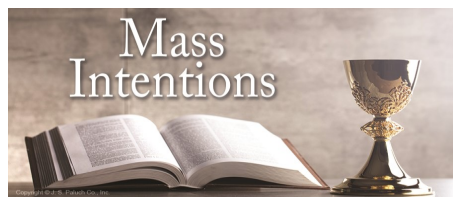
