Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! The season of Ordinary Time and the proverbial slower days of summer should provide us opportunities to reflect on aspects of our faith and discipleship outside of the great seasons and feasts of the liturgical calendar. This Ordinary Time we are reading continuously from the Gospel of Matthew. This Sunday gives us the famous passage from Matthew 11 in which we are invited to overhear Jesus' prayer to his Father and then respond to Jesus' invitation to seek him as the true source of rest and peace.

There is consolation also in Jesus' words that those who are simple, straightforward, and childlike in approaching God may believe in him more readily than those who are "wise and learned." We know from experience that children tend to be trusting, candid, and filled with wonder. When we approach Jesus with a childlike (not "childish") faith and trust, we are more disposed to grow in a true personal relationship with him as risen and ever-present Lord rather than just study him as a nice idea or one option among many. Such childlike faith can move us to say with all our heart, "Jesus, I trust in you!" Renewing that prayer throughout the day, every day, will make our lives as Christians anything but ordinary.

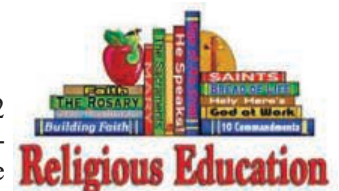

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK - One of the titles of Jesus is that of “Divine Healer.” He is healer of our bodies and our souls. The gospels are filled with stories of Jesus healing the sick, who came to him. Jesus is our divine physician and his healing ministry continues in the Church in different ways. The most obvious is the Sacrament of the Sick. Through the laying on of hands and the imposition of holy oil on the forehead and palms, the priest offers the healing presence of Jesus to those who are ill.

Catholics should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick if they are in danger of dying, seriously ill, preparing for or recovering from surgery, experiencing a chronic health issue or suffering from the effects of aging. The Sacrament may be received multiple times as long as the illness or condition persists.

The Sacrament of the Sick may be celebrated communally, gathering together those who are in need of Jesus’ healing touch. Here at St. Stanislaus we are renewing the practice of anointing the sick after the Sunday Mass once a month.

Beginning Sunday, July 23, 2023 we will celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick on **the fourth Sunday of each month** after each Sunday Mass (including the Saturday Vigil Mass). The anointing will take place after the closing hymn of the Mass. The presider will remain in the sanctuary and will invite those who are in need of the sacrament to come forward for the laying on of hands and the anointing with holy oil. We encourage you and/or your loved ones who are ill to take advantage of this opportunity each month to celebrate this wonderful sacrament of God’s love and healing.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Hans Urs von Balthasar – jeden z największych teologów XX w. - mówił: „Ten, kto nie słucha najpierw Boga, nie ma świata nic do powiedzenia”. A niedzielna Eucharystia stwarza doskonałą okazję do słuchania słowa Bożego, które wzywa nas do pokory. Jezus mówi: *Przyjdźcie do Mnie wszyscy, którzy utrudzeni i obciążeni jesteście, a Ja was pokrzepię. Weźcie moje jarzmo na siebie i uctcie się ode Mnie, bo jestem cichy i pokorny sercem, a znajdziecie ukojenie dla dusz waszych* (Mt 11:28-29).

Pismo Święte pokazuje nam obraz pokornego Jezusa. Tego, o którym powie Zachariasz, że *idzie do ciebie, sprawiedliwy i zwycięski. Pokorny - jedzie na osiołku, na oślaku, zrebiciu oślicy* (Za 9,9). To Jezus ciągle zatroskany o nas: „wszędzie pozostawił przykłady swego miłosierdzia” (św. Grzegorz Wielki). To Jezus, który wskrzesza, leczy, uwalnia zniewolonych. Czasem wręcz nie czeka, aby Mu przyniesiono chorego, ale mówi: *Przyjdę i uzdrowię go* (Mt 8,7). Nawet w momencie swojej śmierci troszczy się o tych, którzy Go otaczają. Oddaje siebie z miłości. *On bowiem jest ofiarą prześlągalną za nasze grzechy i nie tylko za nasze, lecz również za grzechy całego świata* (1 J 2:2). I pokorny pozostaje z nami w Komunii Świętej. Niektórzy nawet oskarżali Jezusową Ewangelię o to, że wprowadza na świat zarazę pokory.



Idea pokory fascynowała św. Franciszka z Asyżu, który zwykł był wołać: „Patrzcie bracia na pokorę Boga!” i zwracając się do Boga mówił: „Jesteś pokorą!”. Dlatego w *Pieśni słonecznej* uczynił z wody symbol pokory. „Pochwalony bądź, Panie mój, przez siostrę wodę, która jest pożyteczna i pokorna, i cenna, i czysta”. Woda jest pokorna, ponieważ rozdaje siebie, zawsze schodzi aż do osiągnięcia najniższego punktu. Woda wybiera zawsze dla siebie ostatnie miejsce. W przeciwieństwie do pary, która zawsze dąży do góry i dlatego słusznie jest łączona z pychą.

Pokora nie tylko nie poniża człowieka, ale czyni go prawdziwym, autentycznym. Pokorny to ten, który chodzi po ziemi, kto twardo trzyma się ziemi, kto nie ulega zmieniającym się modom, nie wbija się w pychę z powodu pochwał. Ciągłe powtarza sobie jak św. Paweł: „Cóż masz, czego byś nie otrzymał? A jeśliś otrzymał, to czemu się chełpisz, tak jakbyś nie otrzymał?” (1 Kor 4,7).



Ukazała się nowa książka związana z męczennikami z Pariacoto: **„RAZEM DAMY RADE! Cuda i łaski za wstawiennictwem męczenników z Pariacoto”**. To pierwsza taka pozycja od beatyfikacji związana z męczennikami, w której znajdziemy poruszające do głębi świadectwa niezwykle realnie i prawdziwie pokazujące, jak błogosławieni franciszkanie działają w naszym świecie, w konkretnych osobach. Zapis tych nadzwyczajnych interwencji daje nadzieję, że nie jesteśmy osamotnieni ze swoimi troskami, że w drodze do domu kochającego Ojca zawsze możemy liczyć na pomoc męczenników z Pariacoto. *br. Jan Hruszowiec OFMConv* - Promotor Kultu Męczenników z Pariacoto.

LECTIO DIVINA

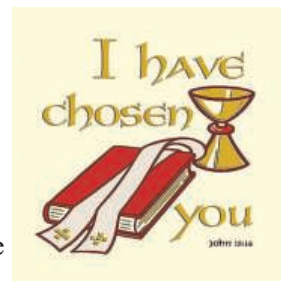

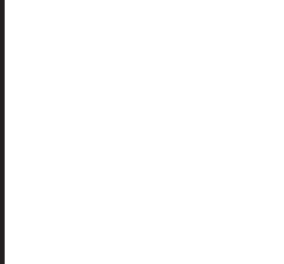
