

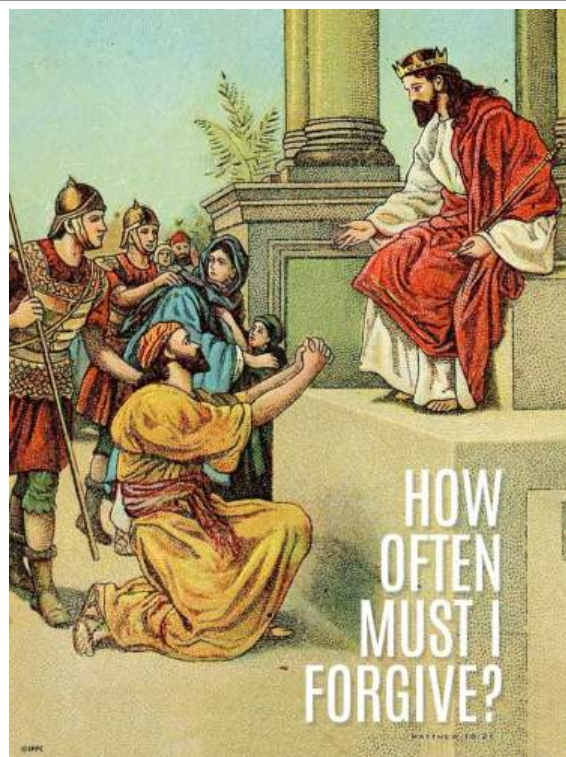

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This third weekend in September is Catechetical Sunday, a day when we honor catechists, the members of our parish who have been entrusted with teaching and handing on the faith to younger generations. As we commission our catechists at the 11:00 Mass this weekend, let me take this opportunity to say THANK YOU on behalf of the whole parish family for your service and example to our young people. We pray that the seeds of faith you plant each week may bear fruit in their lives and their families' lives too.

As part of my preparation for ordination as a friar-priest, I once spent a summer in Burlington, North Carolina, in a training program for hospital chaplains. My cohort at the hospital consisted of Baptists, Methodists, Presbyterians, and myself as the lone Roman Catholic. We got along well together, and so one of the Baptist members, a deacon in his church, invited me to lead a Sunday school class on the bible. He promised to send me to the easier crowd, which was, according to him, the 60-years-and-older group. What impressed me most about the experience was that everyone went to Sunday school, from the smallest child to the most senior member of the congregation.

Growth in our faith is a lifelong process that concludes only when we take our last breath. Faith formation consists of regular daily prayer, the sacraments, Sunday Eucharist, but also deepening our knowledge of the content of our faith. Many Roman Catholics equate Confirmation with graduation from faith formation. Consequently, when someone asks them as adults to explain or defend their Catholic faith, they stutter and stammer because they haven't developed a habit of lifelong learning. Why not pick up a Catechism of the Catholic Church this week and read a paragraph or two a day? There isn't a day that passes that I don't learn something more about my faith or how it all hangs together. I wish those same grace-filled moments for you.

BIULETYN Parafialny



W Mądrości Syracha słyszymy wezwanie: „Pamiętaj o rzeczach ostatecznych i przestań nienawidzić – o rozkładzie ciała, o śmierci, i trzymaj się przykazań!”. Tę naukę doskonale rozumiała Marianna, matka bł. ks. Jerzego Popiełuszki, zamordowanego przez Służbę Bezpieczeństwa w październiku 1984 roku. Jak wyznała: „Przebaczyłam mordercom swojego syna. Teraz się za nich modłę. To morderstwo zostawiło we mnie wielką bolesną ranę, ale nie trzeba jej rozdrapywać. Niech im Pan Jezus daruje. Najbardziej bym się cieszyła, gdyby mordercy mojego syna się nawrócili”.

Słowo Boże zachęca nas do patrzenia na rzeczywistość, w której żyjemy, w perspektywie życia wiecznego. We fragmencie dzisiejszej ewangelii słyszeliśmy o tym, że „Piotr podszedł do Jezusa i zapytał: «Panie, ile razy mam przebaczyć, jeśli mój brat zawini względem mnie? Czy aż siedem razy?»”. Jezus wyjaśnia, że darowanie winy bliźniemu otwiera nas

większą miłość, daje nam dostęp do Bożego przebaczenia. Natomiast naśladowanie nielitościwego dłużnika powoduje, że nasze chrześcijaństwo pozostaje tylko niewiele znaczącą deklaracją z przeszłości.

Wielu, którzy przebaczyli bliźnim ich poważne przewinienia, wyznaje: „bez wiary byłoby trudno”. Warto w tym momencie postawić sobie pytanie: na czym polega chrześcijańskie przebaczenie, które jest naszym obowiązkiem? Bez przebaczenie życie w rodzinie, sąsiedztwie czy społeczeństwie byłoby nie do zniesienia. Wzorem jest dla nas Ojciec niebieski, którego naśladowcami mają stawać się uczniowie Boskiego Mistrza. Wielkość Bożego przebaczenia doskonale ukazuje przypowieść o nielitościwym dłużniku. Widzimy w niej wszechmoc i majestat, który objawia wielkość Bożego miłosierdzia. Możemy również zauważyć, iż zapomniał o tym sługa z przypowieści: „Sługo niegodziwy! Dawałem ci cały ten dług, ponieważ mnie prosiłeś. Czyż więc i ty nie powinienes być ulitować się nad swoim współslugą, jak ja ulitowałem się nad tobą?”. Za to zaniedbanie spotkał owego sługę straszny sąd. Podobny los czeka każdego z nas, jeśli nie przebaczymy z serca tym, którzy wobec nas zawinili.

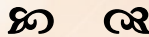
