

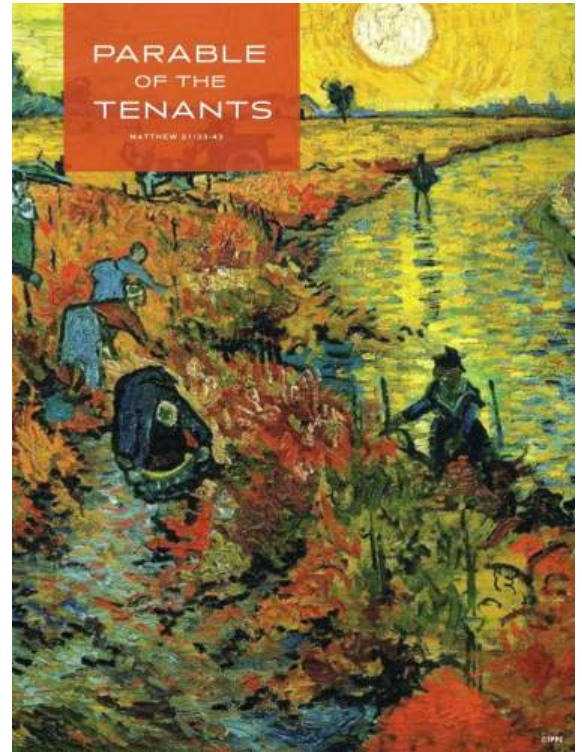

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! This weekend is a special one of celebration for our young people who are going to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday afternoon. As they step forward to be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit through the anointing with sacred chrism, each of them is affirming a more mature faith in Jesus Christ and making a commitment to let that faith show forth in deeds. I ask all of you to keep them in prayer as they complete their Christian initiation and assume more personal responsibility for their Catholic faith and its practice. Congratulations!

Speaking of Catholic faith and practice, October is known as a month dedicated to Mary, particularly under her title of Queen of the Most Holy Rosary (October 7). While the practice of praying the rosary was promoted by the Dominican Order and predates the October feast, this devotion gained momentum after Christian forces defeated the Turks in October 1571. This powerful prayer immerses us in the mysteries of our redemption, and as the prayer ending its recitation reminds us, calls us to imitate what those mysteries contain and obtain what they promise.

If the rosary is not part of your daily prayer, consider starting it this month, even a decade or two each day. I often pray it in the car as a way to quiet down and focus my attention on what truly matters: the heart of our faith. May Mary, our Mother and Queen, bless you and your families and keep us all united in prayer and charity.

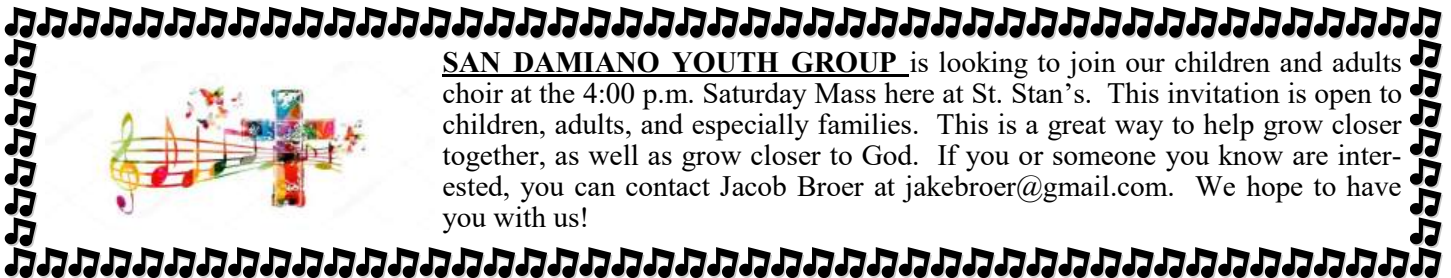

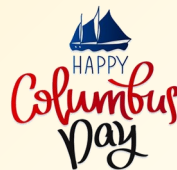

## BIULETYN Parafialny

W życiu codziennym ważne miejsce zajmuje zaufanie. Gdy komuś ufam, to znaczy, że nie boję się go. Nie mam obaw, że mnie oszuka albo skrzywdzi. Wiem, że mogę liczyć na pomoc tej osoby; czuję się wobec niej swobodny, bo mnie nie wykpi, ani nie potępi, ani nie osądzi wobec innych, nie zdradzi mojej tajemnicy. Każdy ma blisko siebie jedną czy kilka osób, którym ufa, ale człowiekowi nie można do końca zaufać, bo jest słaby i może zawieść. Nawet wtedy, kiedy człowiek zawodzi, mogę jeszcze wyciągnąć rękę do Boga – gospodarza winnicy.

Ks. Jan Twardowski w wierszu „Zaufałem drodze” prowadzi taką oto refleksję:

„Zaufałem drodze  
wąskiej  
takiej na łeb na szyję  
z dziurami po kolana  
takiej nie w porę jak w listopadzie spóźnione buraki  
i wyszedłem na łąkę stała święta Agnieszka  
- nareszcie – powiedziała  
- martwiłem się już  
że poszedłeś inaczej  
prościej  
po asfalcie  
autostradą do nieba - z nagrodą do ministra  
i że cię diabli wzięli”.



Co jest istotne w naszym życiu? Ks. Twardowski wskazuje, że „zaufanie drodze”. Jakże dobrze to stwierdzenie pasuje do myśli św. Pawła: „Bracia, o nic się już nie martwcie, ale w każdej sprawie wasze sprawy przedstawiajcie Bogu w modlitwie i błaganu z dziękczynieniem”. Św. Paweł wskazuje, że należy wystrzegać się sytuacji, które stają się źródłem wewnętrznego niepokoju. Człowiek wierzący, choć ma te same troski i zmartwienia, co wszyscy ludzie, posiada skuteczny sposób przewycięzania tego rodzaju utrapień. Ten, kto oddaje i powierza się Bogu, wraz z całym swoim życiem, otrzyma w darze pokój, który „przewyższa wszelki umysł”. To oznacza, że przewyższa wszelkie ludzkie wyobrażenia i inicjatywy na rzecz pokoju. Dzieje się to już teraz, ponieważ źródłem prawdziwego pokoju jest sam Bóg.

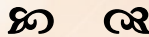

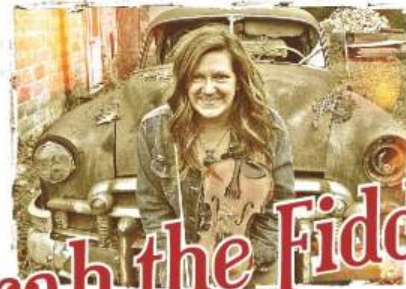

The RCIA is a communal process that assists the candidates in their discernment and gradual inclusion into the Catholic community. Through prayer, scripture study, formation sessions, and various liturgical rites, the candidates are brought into full communion with the Catholic Church. Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion are celebrated at the Easter Vigil. Here at St. Stanislaus, we have an ardent desire to reach out to anyone who has an interest in becoming a Catholic. If you know of anyone who has expressed the desire to become Catholic or simply wants to learn more about the Catholic Church, please encourage them to contact one of the friars or deacons.
