

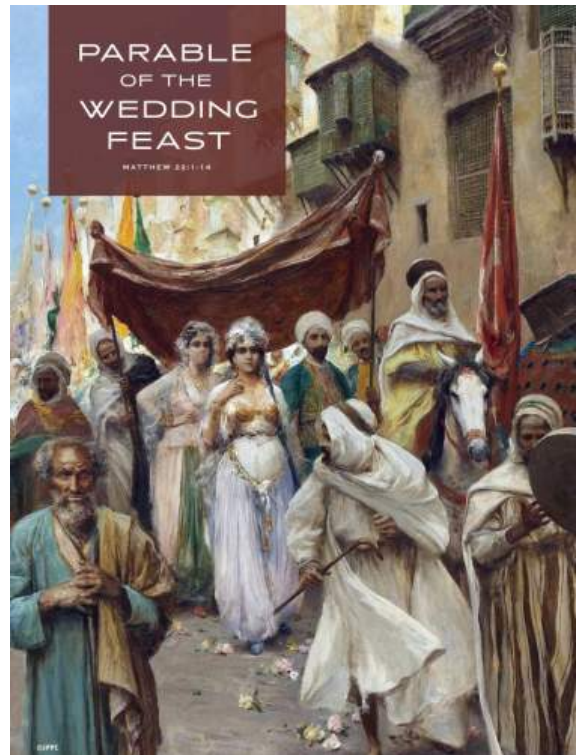

Even with the warning that one be properly dressed for the feast, this is a vision toward which we can all work and for which we can all long. May the Good Shepherd heal our own hearts of all that prevents peace and turn our words and deeds in the direction of God's holy mountain.



Participation in this special Mass is a meaningful way to remember our loved ones.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Św. Paweł, zaprawiony do różnych, zmiennych warunków codziennego życia, wyznaje w Liście do Filipian: „Wszystko mogę w Tym, który mnie umacnia”. Jest to zasada aktualna nie tylko dla Apostoła Narodów, ale również dla każdego chrześcijanina, który pragnie liczyć w swoim życiu na Bożą pomoc. Zmartwychwstały Pan jest bowiem źródłem mocy dla każdego z wiernych.

Kard. Avery Dulles (1918-2008), uważany za największego teologa katolickiego w USA. Był nawróconym na katolicyzm prezbiterianinem i pracownikiem wojskowego wywiadu Stanów Zjednoczonych. Tak wyznał: „W ciemnościach mego wewnętrznego świata najwyższe ludzkie instynkty stanęły wobec próżni. I w tę próżnię wstąpiła łaska Boża. (...) Wstąpiłem do Kościoła jak jeden z tych tchórzliwych pływaków, co zamykają oczy, gdy wskakują do morza. Odkryłem później, że wody wiary są niesłychanie pławne. Gdy człowiek jest odziany łaską, ocean wiary jest jego naturalnym elementem”. Kard. Dulles doświadczył, że wiara wymaga ciągłego przezwyciężania ułomności ludzkiej natury, a życie duchowe to nieustanne borykanie się, by wzrastać w pokornej wierze, nadziei i miłości.

Pawłowe wyznanie: „Wszystko mogę w Tym, który mnie umacnia” jest zaprzeczeniem słów, które bardzo często padają nawet z ust ludzi wierzących: „Rób dobre uczynki i się zbawisz”. Skoro sam mam się zbawić, to do czego jest mi potrzebny Bóg? Dla uczniów Chrystusa to podstawową kwestią pozostaje to, żeby nie głosić samozbawienia. Nie człowiek bowiem zbawia sam siebie, ale zbawia go Bóg. Zbawienie to dzieło Bożej miłości, która zostaje nam ofiarowana jako darmowy dar. Naszym zadaniem pozostaje współpraca z łaską Bożą, z Tym, który w sposób nadprzyrodzony udziela się człowiekowi, zapraszając go do pełnej jedności ze Sobą. Nie chodzi więc o to, by robić wiele dla Jezusa, ale realizować swoją codzienność z Jezusem, pomnażając w swoim życiu miłość.

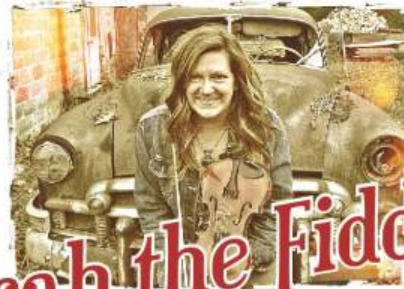

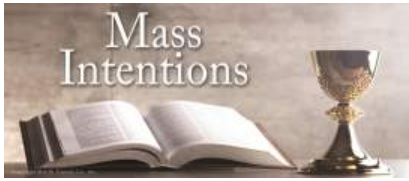
