

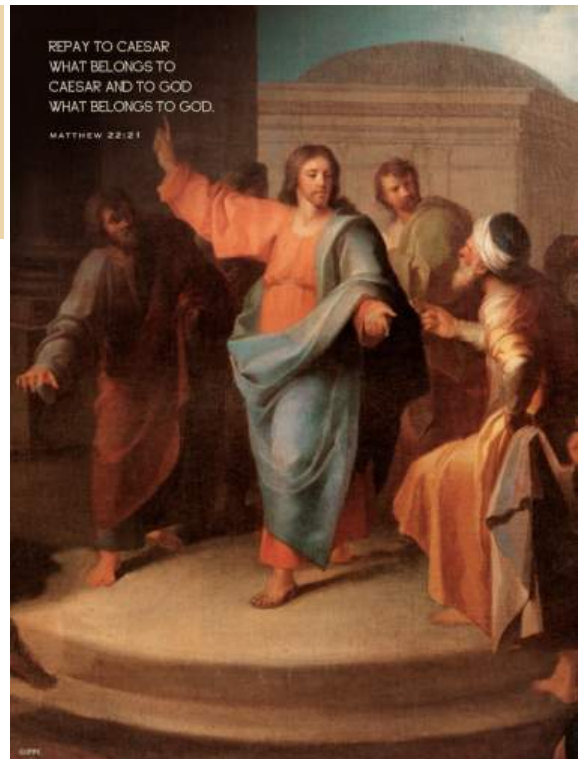

BIULETYN Parafialny

Psalmista wzywa nas: „Pośród narodów głoscie chwałę Pana”. Tę prawdę doskonale rozumiał św. Jan Paweł II, który w ciągu 27 lat trzydzieści razy okrążył ziemię. Był pierwszym papieżem, dla którego pielgrzymki stały się nieodłącznym elementem pontyfikatu. Odwiedził 129 krajów podczas 104 pielgrzymek zagranicznych. Ojciec Święty sam podkreślał: „Od samego początku mojego pontyfikatu zdecydowałem się podróżować aż po krańce ziemi, by dać wyraz tej trosce misyjnej, i właśnie bezpośredni kontakt z ludami, które nie znają Chrystusa, przekonał mnie bardziej, jak pilna jest ta działalność”. Stąd ważne by Kościół stanowił dla świata jasne świadectwo służąc najuboższym i naśladowując prostotę życia Jezusa z Nazaretu. Jest to potrzebne szczególnie w kontekście tego, co możemy zaobserwować we współczesnym świecie: „wielkim niebezpieczeństwem współczesnego świata, z jego wieloraką i przygniatającą ofertą konsumpcji, jest smutek rodzący się w przyzwyczajonym do wygody i chciwym sercu, towarzyszący chorobliwemu poszukiwaniu powierzchownych przyjemności oraz wyizolowanemu sumieniu” (Ewangelii gaudium 2).



Uczniowie faryzeuszów i zwolennicy Heroda sprawdzają natomiast wiarygodność Jezusa, którego życie jest głosem chwały Ojca. Naśłani przez faryzeuszów mówią do Jezusa: „Nauczycielu, wiemy, że jesteś prawdomówny i drogi Bożej w prawdzie nauczasz. Na nikim Ci nie zależy, bo nie oglądasz się na osobę ludzką”. Kategoria „prawda” zajmuje szczególne miejsce w Bożym planie zbawienia. Nie tylko inni mówią o Synu Bożym, że jest prawdomówny i naucza prawdy. On sam stwierdza, że jest prawdą. Nawet pytanie-pułapka faryzeuszów nie jest w stanie wytrącić Jezusa z równowagi i zaburzyć Jego wewnętrzne przekonania. Również Duch Święty, Pan i Ożywiciel, jest Duchem Prawdy.

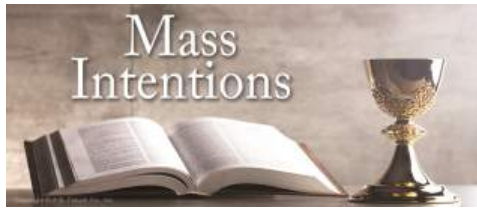
