

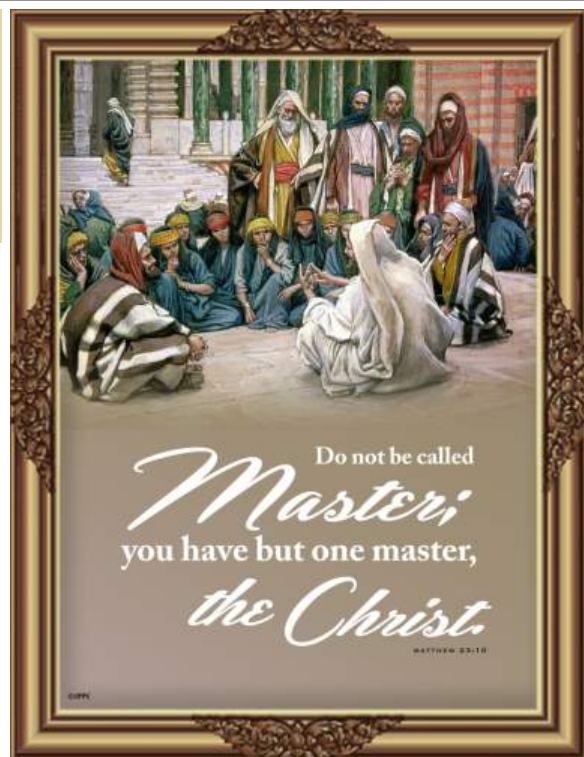

## BIULETYN Parafialny

Pewien biedny człowiek zarabiał na życie grą na skrzypcach. Odwiedzał miasteczka, a kiedy zaczynał grać, a ludzie zbierali się dookoła. Po skończonym graniu przechodził między słuchającymi podsuwając im podziurawiony beret. Miał nadzieję, że któregoś dnia ten beret się napęlni.



Pewnego dnia zaczął grać jak zwykle. Wokół zebrali się ludzie. W tym samym czasie przechodził tamtędy znany kompozytor i wirtuoz. Zatrzymał się i zbliżył się do zebranych ludzi. Za chwilę w jego rękach znalazł się instrument należący do biednego człowieka. Znany wirtuoz nastroił skrzypce, przygotował się i zagrał. Efekt? Sam właściciel, speszony i zadziwiony piękną grą, przechodził z jednej strony na drugą mówiąc: to przecież moje skrzypce! Moje skrzypce! Nigdy nie myślał, że w tych strunach drzemały takie możliwości.

Nie trudno zauważyć, że każdy z nas zagłębiając się nieco w siebie samego, może zdać sobie sprawę, jak bardzo nie wykorzystuje w pełni swoich możliwości. Jaskrawym przykładem tego typu zachowań są faryzeusze, o których mówi dzisiejsza Ewangelia. Faryzeusze funkcjonowali jak stare, podniszczone skrzypce, w dodatku nie nastrojone. Dlatego Jezus wytyka im obłudę, nieszczerłość czy wręcz hipokryzję. Pobożność miała miejsce tylko w ich życiu zewnętrznym: dawali dziesięcinę, modlili się i regularnie pościli, zachowywali zewnętrzne przykazania i byli nawet zaangażowani w prace misyjne.

Zarzut Jezusa dotyczy zatem rozdzwiewku pomiędzy nauczaniem faryzeuszów, a ich życiem. Prawdy nie da się przekazać samym słowem, trzeba to czynić przed świadectwo życia, dokonywanie konkretnych czynów. A faryzeusze? Swoją fasadową pobożność wykorzystywali, aby się ludziom przypodobać i uzyskać z tego wymierne korzyści. Przestroga skierowana do uczniów była jednocześnie wezwaniem do życia w prawdzie.

(w intencjach pielgrzymów ofiarowana przez naszego Ojca John Koziół), Festiwalu 400 000 świateł, a także zwiedzenie biblijnej ekspozycji alfabetu bożonarodzeniowego, nowo wyremontowanego Międzynarodowego Muzeum Żłobka, sklepu z pamiątkami, pokaz rekonstrukcji Galilei i Judei w czasach Jezusa i wiele, wiele więcej atrakcji. 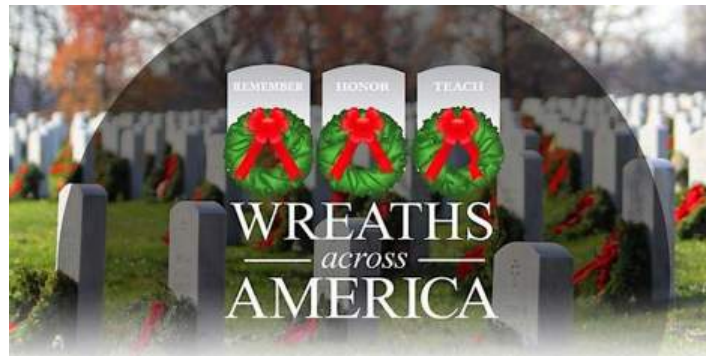

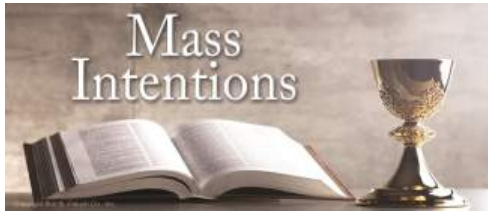
