

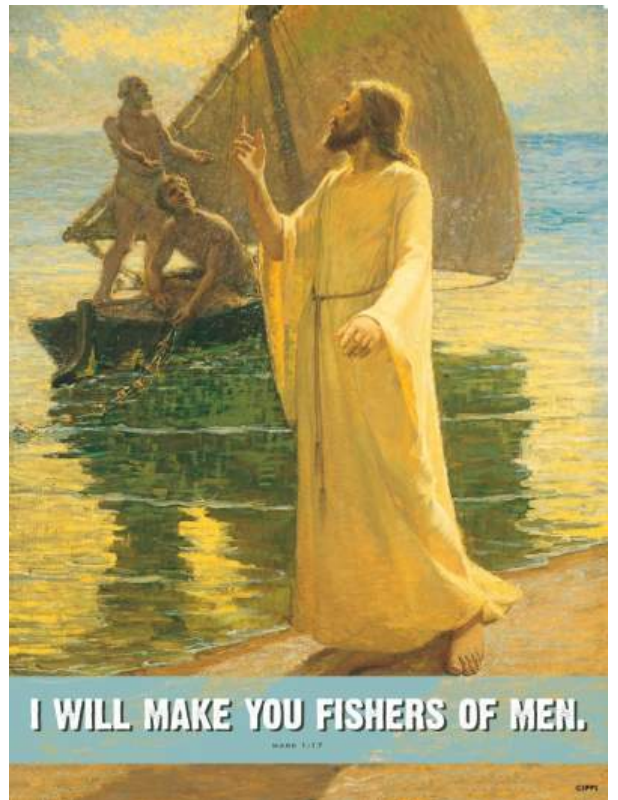

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This week I received a meme from a friar in the Midwest that went like this: “Help wanted: Fisher of men. You catch them. Jesus will clean them.” This is a fitting entry into this Sunday’s scripture readings. Although we could focus on the call of the first disciples, the pairing of the gospel with the story of Jonah in the first reading indicates that our attention should be fixed on the first words to come out of the mouth of Jesus in the Gospel of Mark: “This is the time of fulfillment.... Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

Repentance is not a popular word in our wider culture, accustomed as we have become to falsely equating the faithful Christian with being simply a nice person who generally avoids any serious wrongdoing and makes no waves. The other extreme is for a Christian to subject every thought and deed to microscopic scrutiny to look for sin even if there is none in a particular situation.

The honest truth is that you and I sin daily “in what we have done and what we have failed to do.” Jesus knows this; hence, the first words of his proclamation today are about repentance. Following Jesus is serious business, a graced adventure of bringing every thought, word, and deed of ours under his shepherding and into conformity with the will of our heavenly Father. When we do fall short and sin by commission or omission, Jesus is waiting to shower us with his mercy. That’s the good news and why we are here to celebrate.

Pewien człowiek, idąc ulicą, dostrzegł swojego przyjaciela, który spacerował ze swoim psem, bernardynem. Nie było by w tym nic dziwnego, gdyby nie fakt, że przyjaciel z pieskiem na smyczy szedł zygzakiem, od drzewka do drzewka. „Witaj, przyjacielu, dokąd idziesz?” – zagadnął. „Nie wiem, zapytaj mojego psa!” – odpowiedział tamten.



Okazuje się, że można być właścicielem psa, ale to nie my jego, ale on nas posiada. Co oznacza zatem Pawłowe wezwanie z Pierwszego Listu do Koryntian, że mamy stawać się jak „ci, którzy nabywają, jak gdyby nie posiadali”? To znaczy nabywać tak, żeby to, co nabywamy, nie posiadało nas w niewolę. Czy nie śmieszny jest ktoś, kto kupił sobie nowy sprzęt elektroniczny, a następnie skarży się, że nie może wyjść z domu, bo musi z niego korzystać? Albo ktoś, kto kupił nowy samochód i całe dnie spędza na podziwianiu, myciu i dopieszczaniu go, a noce na pilnowaniu, by go nikt nie ukraść?

W czym tkwi owa śmieszność? W tym, że elektronika czy samochód nie są warte naszego życia. Mają służyć nam, a nie my im. Jeśli jest odwrotnie, oddalamy się od prawdziwego szczęścia. Dlaczego? Ponieważ nie znamy właściwej hierarchii wartości, traktując jako coś najważniejszego rzeczy i sprawy mało istotne. To tak, jakby ktoś chciał, żeby go odwieźć do domu, ale próbował do tego przekonać nie kierowcę taksówki, ale... oponę.

Kiedy tak spojrzymy na życie, łatwiej będzie zgodzić się na to, że dzisiejszy fragment z Pierwszego Listu do Koryntian nie jest jakimś przeżytkiem, mającym tylko zniechęcić nas do czerpania z życia jak najwięcej przyjemności. Nie chodzi o to, by zanegować wszystkie przyjemności w życiu, ale o to, by wybrać to, co jest rzeczywiście dobre, ważne, wartościowe. A kluczem do właściwego wyboru są słowa: „przemija bowiem postać tego świata”. W ten sposób możemy odróżnić, co tak naprawdę jest ważne, a co nie.

Consider Leaving a Lasting Legacy

Qualified Charitable Distribution

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can make a tax-smart decision while increasing the impact of your support of St. Stanislaus Basilica by considering a transfer from your IRA.

Many of you may be familiar with the term “*Qualified Charitable Distribution*” or QCD. This is a distribution from your IRA paid directly to a charity.

If you are required to take a distribution from your IRA, you can direct your IRA custodian to send a portion of your annual distribution up to \$100,000 to support St. Stanislaus Basilica.

Now, why would you want to do this?

The average standard deduction is much higher than it has been in the past and many taxpayers will find that they do not have enough to itemize. This means their gifts to St. Stanislaus Basilica will not count as a tax deduction.

If you are one of those people who can no longer itemize deductions and you write a check to St. Stanislaus Basilica, you will not get a tax deduction. But if you use the QCD option from your IRA, then you will directly reduce your income, save in taxes, and make a big impact on the future of St. Stanislaus Basilica and all its ministries.
