BIULETYN Parafialny

Wśród kryteriów dojrzałej osobowości ks. prof. Zdzisław Chlewiński podaje, jako pierwsze, wewnętrzną wolność. Jeśli jest w człowieku wewnętrzna wolność, to potrafi on zachować własne poglądy nawet przy naciskach czy pewnych zewnętrznych uwarunkowaniach. Wewnętrzna wolność to także wierność własnym przekonaniom, nawet jeśli jakaś grupa ludzi będzie miała zupełnie inne przekonania. Natomiast źródła smutku, niepokoju, niezadowolenia, frustracji leżą nie w trudnościach życia codziennego, ale w naszym wewnętrznym ograniczeniu, zniewoleniu.



Na taką rzeczywistość zwraca uwagę dzisiejsza Ewangelia. Jezus w synagodze w Kafarnaum dokonuje wyzwolenia człowieka opętanego. Tylko Pan ma moc uwolnienia nas z wszystkiego, co nas krępuje i pozwala nam żyć w wolności. Patrząc na życie Jezusa i słuchając Jego słów widzimy, że prawdziwie wolny jest ten, który postępuje zgodnie z prawdą własnego sumienia. Syn Boży był wewnętrznie wolny. On w całym swoim życiu zachował to, co głosił. Za swoją odwagę i za prawdę zapłacił cenę najwyższą. A my? Często wolimy nie narażać się. Mówimy: przecież tak robią wszyscy, czemu więc ja miałbym się wychylać?

Najważniejszą rzeczą jest to, aby ochronić w sobie łaskę Bożą: ten bowiem, kto żyje pod parasolem łaski, jest chroniony przez Boga. W życie łaską wprowadzają nas sakramenty, przez które działa Duch Święty. Na pierwszym miejscu trzeba postawić systematyczną spowiedź i Eucharystię. Zasada w walce duchowej jest jedna: bronić w sobie życia łaski Bożej. Dzięki temu Król – Jezus Chrystus – będzie mógł w nas panować. Chociaż Zły będzie się starał, nie przemoże tej wewnętrznej twierdzy, jaką tworzy w nas łaska uświęcająca.

Consider Leaving a Lasting Legacy

Qualified Charitable Distribution

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can make a tax-smart decision while increasing the impact of your support of St. Stanislaus Basilica by considering a transfer from your IRA.

Many of you may be familiar with the term “*Qualified Charitable Distribution*” or QCD. This is a distribution from your IRA paid directly to a charity.

If you are required to take a distribution from your IRA, you can direct your IRA custodian to send a portion of your annual distribution up to \$100,000 to support St. Stanislaus Basilica.

Now, why would you want to do this?

The average standard deduction is much higher than it has been in the past and many taxpayers will find that they do not have enough to itemize. This means their gifts to St. Stanislaus Basilica will not count as a tax deduction.

If you are one of those people who can no longer itemize deductions and you write a check to St. Stanislaus Basilica, you will not get a tax deduction. But if you use the QCD option from your IRA, then you will directly reduce your income, save in taxes, and make a big impact on the future of St. Stanislaus Basilica and all its ministries.
