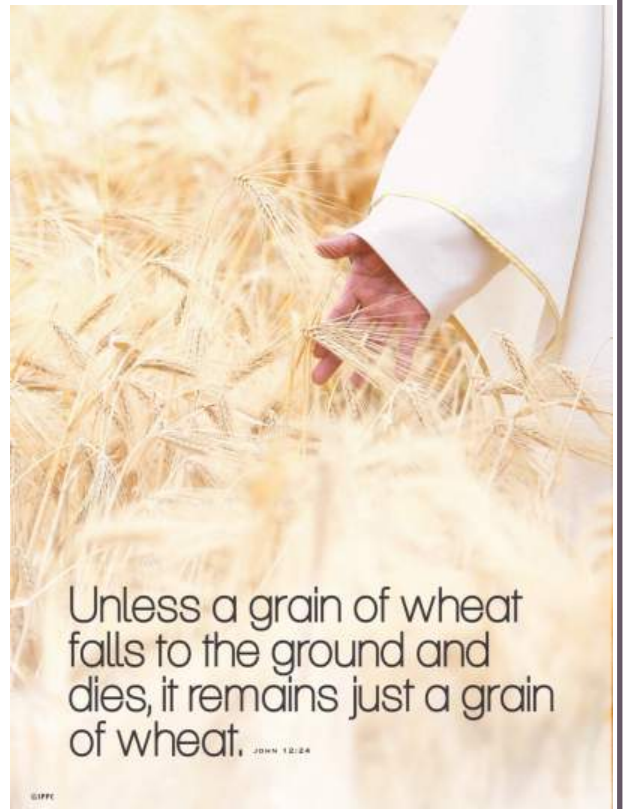

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This year the Fifth Sunday of Lent coincides with a time-honored Irish American feast day: St. Patrick, the great apostle of Ireland. March 17<sup>th</sup> has religious origins, but we all know that many of those celebrating today have lost the connection to the Catholic roots of this feast. The day has become a good reason to feast on corned beef and cabbage and drink Irish beer, usually to excess.

For those of us who truly celebrate the great patron of Ireland, the day is a reminder to pray fervently for the country that once was a bulwark of Catholicism. The tide of secularism and relativism has washed over the Emerald Isle in a powerful way, and that fact reminds all of us that we can never be content with a superficial practice of our faith or expect to remain firm in our faith through cultural connections alone.

This Sunday we hear the hopeful words of the prophet Jeremiah. With the prospect of exile and the destruction of the Temple facing them, the people of Israel knew they could survive only if the law of God were written upon their hearts, a place no government, military might, or ideology could destroy. Our Lenten prayer and penance should find the grace of God and the heart of Jesus Christ more deeply penetrating our own hearts. May St. Patrick intercede for all of us!

## BIULETYN Parafialny

Jezus mówił przed swoją męką: „Nadeszła godzina, aby został uwielbiony Syn Człowieczy... Przyszedłem na tę godzinę”. Jezus używa słowa „godzina” określając nim ustalony przez Ojca moment dokonania dzieła zbawienia. Nadejście tej „godziny” oznacza rozpoczęcie Paschy – przejścia Jezusa z ziemi do Ojca w Niebie. „Godzina” Jezusa wskazuje na Jego uwielbienie i wywyższenie przez mękę, śmierć i zmartwychwstanie. To wywyższenie Jezusa rozpoczyna się z chwilą wejścia w uniżenie „do końca” – aż do śmierci krzyżowej.



Jezus jest w pełni świadomy swojej godziny oraz drogi i celu, do którego zmierza. Przeżywa tę „godzinę” w głębokiej łączności z Ojcem i w posłuszeństwie Jego woli. Dla Jezusa śmierć nie jest końcem, ale właśnie Paschą czyli „przejściem” do Ojca. „Godzina” Jezusa to najwyższy akt Jego miłości. Samo pojęcie „miłości” zyskuje tu nową, niespotykaną głębię. Syn Boży pokazuje, że miłość to całkowity, świadomy i dobrowolny dar z siebie. Jego męka, wszystko co przeżywa, jest wyrazem takiej bezgranicznej miłości. Całe życie i posłannictwo Jezusa znajdują w tej „godzinie” swoje wypełnienie. Wszystko, co Jezus mówi i czyni, dokonuje się tu w kontekście żydowskiego świętowania Paschy, która jest uroczystą celebracją wyzwolenia z niewoli. Można więc stwierdzić, że całe Jego życie jest skierowane ku tej „godzinie”, w której Jego miłość do Ojca i do ludzi osiąga punkt kulminacyjny.
