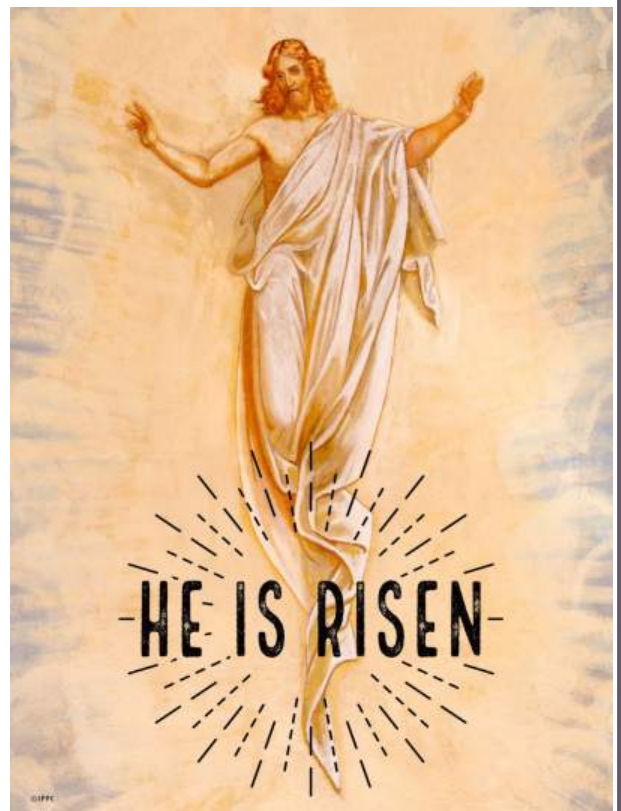

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Easter! Wesołego Alleluja! What matters is that you are willing to encounter the Risen Christ in his mercy, in this gathering of his people, at this altar, and then in the people and events of your daily life. Let this Easter find your heart open and ready to meet and receive him.

THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY will be celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. Mass on ***April 7***, the first Sunday after Easter, which is called Divine Mercy Sunday. Confessions will be heard from Noon to 1:00 p.m., followed by Recitation of the Rosary at 1:00 p.m., and Mass celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. On the day of Sister Faustina's canonization, April 30th, 2000, Pope John Paul II instituted the feast for the whole Church. The institution of the feast was inspired by a desire of Jesus which was conveyed by Sister Faustina. The Lord Jesus told her: *I desire that the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy (Diary 299). I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened (Diary 699).*



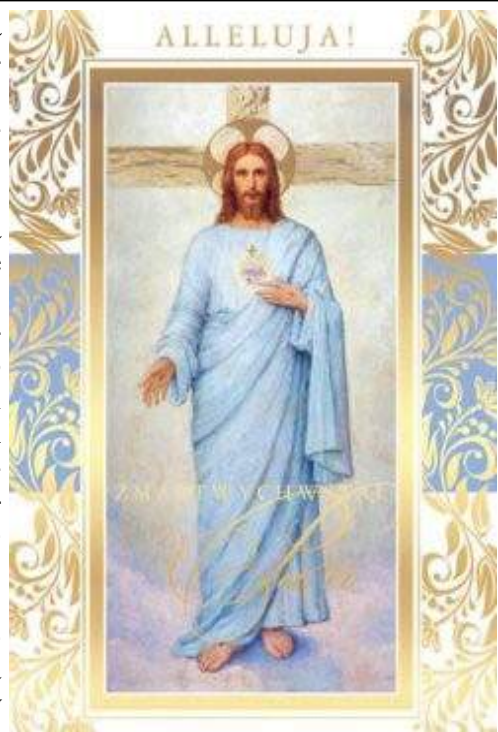

STAN'S - On ***May 3-4***, First Friday and First Saturday, the Basilica of St. Stanislaus will host five relics of St. Padre Pio for public veneration (Friday: 12:30 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.; Saturday 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.). The first- and second-class relics are as follows: crusts of Saint Pio's wounds, a white fingerless glove with Saint Pio's blood stains, a lock of Saint Pio's hair, a handkerchief with Saint Pio's perspiration, and a piece of the saint's habit. BIULETYN Parafialny

„W tym dniu wspaniałym wszyscy się weselmy” – powtarzamy za psalmistą. Wielkanoc, najstarsze a zarazem najważniejsze dla chrześcijan święto, obchodzimy co roku. Może nam już trochę spowszedniało. Ta sama liturgia Triduum Paschalnego, męka, grób, zmartwychwstanie. Jak zrozumieć tę największą tajemnicę naszej wiary?

Spójrzmy na film pt. „Zmartwychwstały” (2016) w reżyserii Kevina Reynoldsa, który przedstawia śledztwo w sprawie Jezusa. Historię śmierci i zmartwychwstania Jezusa widzimy oczami rzymskiego Trybuna Claviusa, któremu Poncjusz Piłat zleca odnalezienie uczniów skazanego właśnie na śmierć Jezusa. Zdaniem Piłata podpuszczanego przez Senhedryn, ciało Jezusa wykradli jego uczniowie, którzy chcieli nadal szerzyć „heretycką religię”. Clavius podążając za rzekomymi złodziejami, wyrusza też w głąb siebie. Rzymianin jedyne czego pragnie to „wolność od zabijania i śmierci”. Jest prostym zabijaką, wykonującym rozkazy, który chce jednak pozostać zgodny ze swoim sumieniem. Ono zmienia się stopniowo w kontakcie z uczniami Jezusa.

Clavius zdaje sobie powoli sprawę, że wszystkiego nie da się wytłumaczyć wyłącznie rozumem. Widział przecież dziwne odbicie na całunie, stopione pieczęcie, pęknięte, a nie przecięte liny, odsunięty głaz, który musiałyby przesunąć kilku silnych mężczyzn. Doświadczył też niezwykłej dobroci płynącej od uczniów cieśli. Ostatecznie rozmawiając z objawiającym się uczniom Jezusem, Clavius jest pełen wątpliwości. „Ty widziałeś i masz wątpliwości. Wyobraź sobie co będą czuli, ci, którzy nie widzieli, a chcą uwierzyć” – mówi mu Zbawiciel.



WEŻ POD UWAGĘ DAROWIZNE NA RZECZ BAZYLIKI—uwzględniając Bazylikę św. Stanisława w swoich planach posiadłości typu podarunku w formie spadku w swoim testamencie, funduszu z konta emerytalnego lub ubezpieczenia na życie w bardzo znaczący sposób przyczynisz się do utrzymania Bazyliki i wszystkich jej posług przez wiele lat. Planowanie zapisu pozwala teraz zachować kontrolę nad swoim majątkiem przez całe życie, zapewniając jednocześnie spokój sumienia, wiedząc, że przyczyniłeś się do dalszego istnienia Bazyliki. Jeśli Twoja sytuacja się zmieni, zawsze możesz zmodyfikować swój zapis. Co więcej, większość prezentów od Twojego majątku jest zwolniona z podatków federalnych. Mamy nadzieję, że rozważysz jedną z planowanych możliwości przekazania darowizny. Jeśli masz pytania dotyczące tego, która z różnych opcji jest dla Ciebie najlepsza, skonsultuj się z doradcą finansowym, prawnikiem, lub Twoim doradcą podatkowym.

POWTANIE NOWYCH PARAFIAN - nasza parafialna rodzina się powiększa! Przez ostatnie półtora roku ponad sześćdziesiąt rodzin dołączyło do Św. Stanisława ! Chcemy formalnie powitać ich Mszą św. w nowej parafii. Spotkanie powitalne odbędzie się na Mszy św. w sobotę 27 kwietnia 2024 r. o godzinie 4:00 PM i kontynuowane będzie w kafeterii szkolnej. Przyjęcie powitalne będzie obejmowało posiłek, rozrywkę i krótki program powitający rodziny i przedstawianie ich naszemu duchowieństwu, pracownikom i organizacjom parafii. Zapraszamy do wzięcia udziału w tym radosnym wydarzeniu i powiadomienie Biura Parafialnego abyśmy mogli przygotować wystarczającą ilość posiłków.



WIOSENNE SPRZĄTANIE CMENTARZA PARAFIALNEGO - Zbliża się wiosna, a wraz z nią nasza prośba o usunięcie dekoracji zimowych i bożonarodzeniowych, w tym wszelkich sztucznych ozdób nagrobnych, wszelkiego rodzaju przedmiotów, w szczególności zniczy i wszystkiego, co nie jest dozwolone zgodnie z „Regulaminem” naszego cmentarza, ponieważ są one niebezpieczne dla pracowników cmentarza i gości. 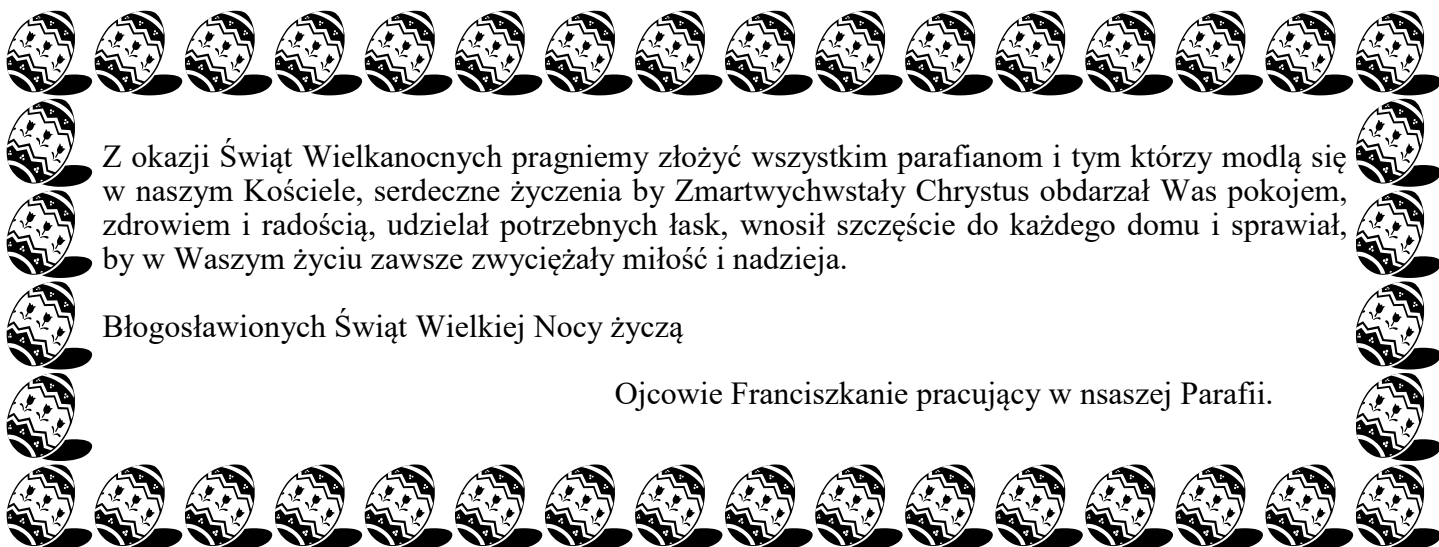
