Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things to you! We are fast coming to the end of the 50 days of Easter with its Pentecost finale next weekend. This Seventh Sunday of Easter offers us a different kind of gospel passage, a small excerpt from what biblical scholars call Jesus' great priestly prayer. Although the Lord offers this prayer before his passion, death, and resurrection, this gospel also answers the question of what Jesus is doing now. Jesus is praying and interceding for us before the throne of his Father.

For what is Jesus praying? He prays for unity among his followers so that we may reflect the unity, love, and joy in the heart of the Triune God. Jesus prays that we may be protected from the evil one and consecrated in the truth, the truth of who we are as beloved sons and daughters of God and the truth of who Jesus is as Son of God and Savior of the world.

As we allow ourselves to be caught up into the prayer of Jesus in this Eucharist, we also pray for all mothers on this Mother's Day and for the children who received their First Communion this Saturday. May families stay close to Jesus, especially in his Real Presence in the Eucharist, and experience unity, love, joy, and protection from all that would harm them. May we grow deeper in the truth to which Jesus and the church bear witness. Congratulations to all our First Communicants! Happy Mother's Day!

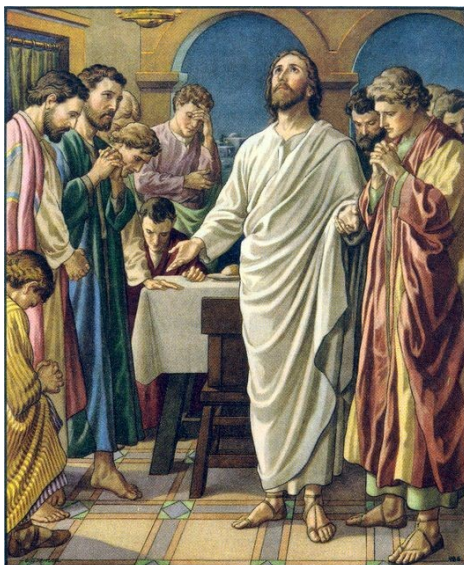

BIULETYN Parafialny

Jednym z wyzwań nowego tysiąclecia jest prymat modlitwy w życiu uczniów Chrystusa. Chrześcijanie żyją „w świecie”, chociaż „nie są ze świata”, dlatego modlitwa może uchronić ich przed „zagubieniem” w świecie naznaczonym obojętnością i synkretyzmem. Papież nawołuje wspólnoty chrześcijańskie do „stawania się autentycznymi szkołami modlitwy, w których spotkanie z Chrystusem nie wyraża się jedynie w błaganii o pomoc, ale także w dziękczynieniu, chwaleń, adorowaniu, kontemplowaniu, skupionym słuchaniu uczuć, aż do prawdziwego oczarowania serca” (NMI 33). Autentyczna modlitwa jest zawsze swoistego rodzaju „sztuką”. Wyrażenie to sugeruje, że modlitwa nie tylko jest darem, owocem działania Ducha Świętego, który kształtuje słowo, myśl i uczucia, ale wskazuje też na piękno jej inspiracji, na radość i trud, które nieodłącznie towarzyszą procesowi uczenia się modlitwy. Modlitwa chrześcijańska jest więc „dana i zadana”.



Takiej modlitwy uczył Jezus, który sam modlił się nieustannie (Mk 1,35; 6,46; Mt 14,23; Łk 5,16; 6,12; 22,39-42). W „ewangelicznej szkole modlitwy” nie uczono formuł ani technik modlitwy. Jezus nie dawał swoim uczniom wskazówek teoretycznych na temat modlitwy, ale bezpośrednio wprowadzał ich w praktykę, w rzeczywistość wewnętrznej rozmowy z Bogiem, w kontemplację Ojca. Konkretnym tego przykładem jest 17. rozdział Ewangelii św. Jana. Zwykło się go nazywać modlitwą arcykapłańską lub modlitwą pożegnalną. Wieńczy on cały szereg pouczeń skierowanych do uczniów. W modlitwie arcykapłańskiej pobrzmiewają wyraźne tony modlitwy „Ojcze nasz”, której Jezus nauczył swoich uczniów (Mt 6, 8b-15; Łk 11,1-4).

Treścią modlitwy pożegnalnej Jezusa jest potrójna prośba: o jedność (17,11), o zachowanie [uczniów] od zła (17,15) i uświęcenie w prawdzie (17,17-19). Wprowadzeniem do tej części modlitwy jest rozwinięta inwokacja: „Ojczy święty!”. W rozumieniu biblijnym świętość oznacza oddzielenie od świata. Jezus prosi więc Ojca, aby oddzielił uczniów od świata i zachował ich „w [swoim] imieniu”. W modlitwie „Ojczy nasz” zawarta jest podobna prośba: „święć się Imię Twoje”, co oznacza „uświęć swoje Imię pośród nas”. Apostołowie są uczniami Jezusa nie poprzez osobisty wysiłek, inteligencję, wyjątkowe cechy osobowe, ale dlatego, że otrzymali dar powołania i wezwanie do świętości. W tym sensie św. Jan uświadamia wszystkim, że to Bóg pierwszy nas umiłował: „W tym przejawia się miłość, że nie my umiłowaliśmy Boga, ale że On sam nas umiłował (...); kto pozostaje w miłości, pozostaje w Bogu, a Bóg w nim” (1 J 4,10.16). Głęboka jedność między uczniami opiera się na uprzedzającej inicjatywie Boga i modlitewnej więzi z Nim. Przyczyną tej jedności jest Imię, którego Ojciec udzielił Synowi (J 8,28). Świętość Imienia Bożego ustrzeże uczniów od zła i uświęci w prawdzie, o ile będą potrafili tworzyć święte zgromadzenie, czyli wspólnotę tych, którzy słuchają i są posłuszni słowu Bożemu.

Weź pod uwagę darowiznę na rzecz Bazyliki—uwzględniając Bazylikę św. Stanisława w swoich planach posiadłości typu podarunku w formie spadku w swoim testamencie, funduszu z konta emerytalnego lub ubezpieczenia na życie w bardzo znaczący sposób przyczynisz się do utrzymania Bazyliki i wszystkich jej posług przez wiele lat. Planowanie zapisu pozwala teraz zachować kontrolę nad swoim majątkiem przez całe życie, zapewniając jednocześnie spokój sumienia, wiedząc, że przyczyniłeś się do dalszego istnienia Bazyliki. Jeśli Twoja sytuacja się zmieni, zawsze możesz zmodyfikować swój zapis. Co więcej, większość prezentów od Twojego majątku jest zwolniona z podatków federalnych. Mamy nadzieję, że rozważysz jedną z planowanych możliwości przekazania darowizny. Jeśli masz pytania dotyczące tego, która z różnych opcji jest dla Ciebie najlepsza, skonsultuj się z doradcą finansowym, prawnikiem, lub Twoim doradcą podatkowym.

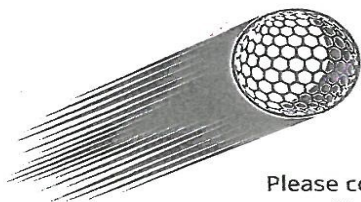

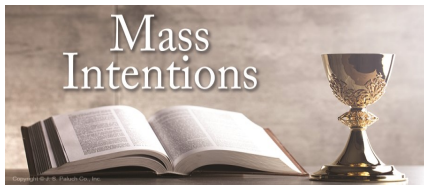
