Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! It may come as a surprise to many Christians that the word *Trinity* does not appear in the New Testament. The church father Tertullian (ca. 160 – 225 A.D.), from Roman North Africa, was the first to use the Latin term to express divine three-ness in one-ness. Since the time of Tertullian, theological writings on the Trinity can make one's head spin. Attempting to speak and write about the very mystery of God is a daunting task for anyone.

The feast we celebrate today, however, is not a celebration of Christian scholarship on the Trinity. It is about the Mystery at the heart of our life. The authors of the Old and New Testaments do not speculate about God; they tell us how God has worked in human history. Christians, like Muslims and Jews, are monotheistic. Our Creed begins: “I believe in one God...” However, we Christians hold that God has revealed divine reality as a community of persons with distinct yet harmonious roles in salvation history. We summarize that sacred history every time we sign ourselves with the cross, a powerful gesture that reminds us of our baptism “in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”

Because humanity is created in the image and likeness of God, we are called to witness to a unity among ourselves that is held together by self-sacrificing love—the very life of the Trinity in us. May this feast bring us closer to living this divine life and love in our parish, our homes, and in our own hearts.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Niepojęta dla ludzkiego rozumu prawda, że Bóg objawił się w Trzech Osobach, stanowi centralną tajemnicę naszej wiary i skupia w sobie również wszystkie inne jej tajemnice. Jest związana z centralnym wydarzeniem, jakie miało miejsce w naszym życiu, czyli z przyjęciem chrztu św., który został nam udzielony „w imię Ojca i Syna, i Ducha Świętego”.

Ojciec Przedwieczny posyła swego Syna Jednorodzonego na świat, aby dał ludziom zbawienie, a Duch Święty ma obudzić w sercach wiarę, dzięki której otwierają się z zaufaniem przed Bogiem, by przyjąć dar życia wiecznego. Koniecznym warunkiem wspólnoty z Bogiem jest zatem wiara, bez której „nie można podobać się Bogu”. A „kto nie uwierzył, już został potępiony”. Potępienie stanowi zatem wybór kierunku przeciw Bogu, a zbawienie jest wejściem na drogę ku Niemu. Człowiek, póki żyje, może ten kierunek zmieniać, może w wolności decydować o sobie i swoim losie. Pójście drogą Bożą zakłada budowanie wspólnoty z Bogiem, a koniecznym warunkiem jest tu posłuszeństwo woli Bożej, objawionej przez Chrystusa w czasie Jego ziemskiej misji.



Źródłem wiary jest Duch Święty, dzięki Niemu możemy wołać: „Abba, Ojcze!”. To Duch Pański oznajmia nam wolę Bożą, przekonuje nas o prawdzie Ewangelii oraz napełnia mocą, byśmy odważnie świadczyli o Jezusie. I dlatego, jeśli zamykamy się na działanie Ducha, jesteśmy bezsilni w rozwoju naszego życia wiarą, którą otrzymaliśmy jako dynamizm chrzcielny.

Znane jest porównanie Trójcy do trzech świec, których płomień łączą się, stanowiąc jeden płomień. Porównywano także Trójcę do koniczyny, która choć posiada trzy liście, jest przecież jedna. Z kolei A. Pronzato zauważa, iż człowiek żyje na trzech płaszczyznach: pionowej, poziomej i wewnętrznej. Stąd również Boga postrzega wielowymiarowo: jest dla niego Ojcem miłosiernym, szanującym wolność swoich dzieci; jest także bratem w osobie Jezusa Chrystusa; mieszka również w naszym wnętrzu jako Duch.

Weź pod uwagę darowiznę na rzecz Bazyliki—uwzględniając Bazylikę św. Stanisława w swoich planach posiadłości typu podarunku w formie spadku w swoim testamencie, funduszu z konta emerytalnego lub ubezpieczenia na życie w bardzo znaczący sposób przyczynisz się do utrzymania Bazyliki i wszystkich jej posług przez wiele lat. Planowanie zapisu pozwala teraz zachować kontrolę nad swoim majątkiem przez całe życie, zapewniając jednocześnie spokój sumienia, wiedząc, że przyczyniłeś się do dalszego istnienia Bazyliki. Jeśli Twoja sytuacja się zmieni, zawsze możesz zmodyfikować swój zapis. Co więcej, większość prezentów od Twojego majątku jest zwolniona z podatków federalnych. Mamy nadzieję, że rozważysz jedną z planowanych możliwości przekazania darowizny. Jeśli masz pytania dotyczące tego, która z różnych opcji jest dla Ciebie najlepsza, skonsultuj się z doradcą finansowym, prawnikiem, lub Twoim doradcą podatkowym.

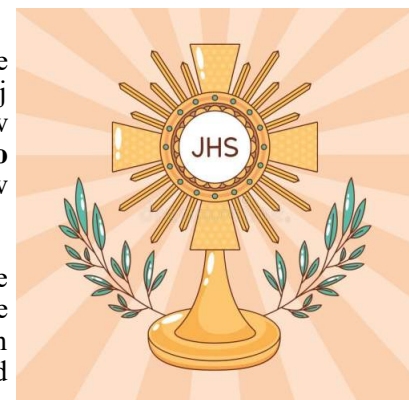

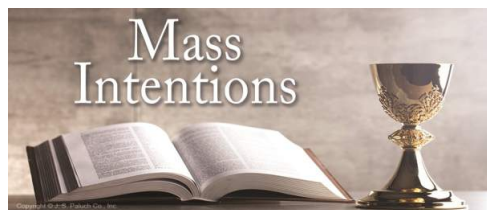
