

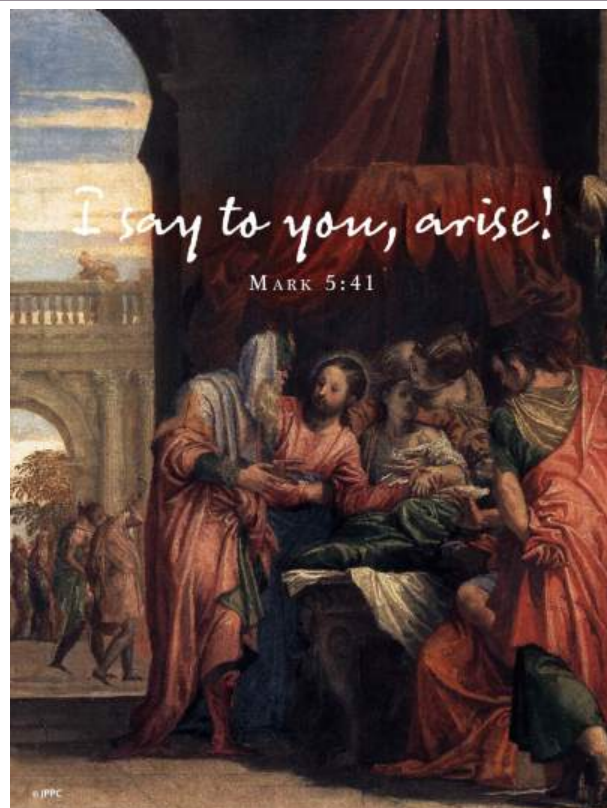

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! In my years of ministry as a friar-priest, I have heard often enough a question that comes from a soul in anguish: "What have I done to deserve this?" The implication is that somehow God is exacting payback for past sins of the person or his or her family. It seems that ancient Israel started out with this belief, largely taken over from the influence of their pagan neighbors. However, the witness of the Scriptures moves us in a different direction. This Sunday's first reading from the Book of Wisdom states quite clearly: "God did not make death, nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living. For he fashioned all things that they might have being...."

Jesus' ministry of stopping a hemorrhage and bringing a little girl back to life was a direct assault on the forces that work against life and its fullness. We could ask why God permits suffering, but we also see Jesus himself undergo suffering and make it a means to salvation. Nothing can stand in the way of God's will to give us the fullness of life unless we ourselves settle for less. Even physical suffering, accepted with and in Christ, can heal our souls and lead us to a deeper life in God.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia przywołuje obraz Jaira, jednego ze zwierzchników synagogi, który myślał o swoim dziecku znajdującym się w niebezpieczeństwie śmierci. Ten niepokój skupiał całą jego uwagę, przysłaniając wszystko inne. Wielkie cierpienie i wielka wiara sprawiły, że przyszedł do Jezusa, i upadł Mu do nóg prosząc usilnie: „Moja córeczka dogorywa, przyjdź i połóż na nią ręce, aby ocalała i żyła”. Czy Jair w tym momencie mógł myśleć, że „dla Boga nie ma nic niemożliwego”?



Jezus spełnił prośbę ojca dziewczynki i udał się we wskazanym kierunku. Jednak okazało się, że ludzie przynieśli wiadomość o śmierci córki. Chociaż sytuacja wydawała się być rozstrzygnięta kategorycznie, Nauczyciel mówi: „Nie bój się, tylko wierz”. Przełożony synagogi, wbrew oczywistej po ludzku sytuacji, nie wycofuje się, ale konsekwentnie idzie za Panem. Przychodzą do domu i Jezus mówi „dziewczynka nie umarła, tylko śpi”. Więc w oczach Pana Boga rzeczywistość może wyglądać zupełnie inaczej. To, co ludzie uznali za śmierć, Jezus uznał tylko za sen, z którego można się obudzić. I tak się stało. Boski Dawca życia wskrzesza dziewczynkę i w ten sposób przywraca rodzinie utraconą nadzieję.

Również i każdy z nas może przeżywać sytuacje zagrożenia życia swojego czy najbliższych. Nie wystarczy wtedy jedynie fachowa opieka medyczna dla naszego ciała, ale warto spojrzeć na trudne doświadczenie również w perspektywie wiary. I powierzyć sprawę „szlachetnego zdrowia” opiece Boskiego Lekarza Jezusa, który jest Panem życia. I który przyszedł po to, abyśmy „mieli życie i mieli je w obfitości”.

CZAS WYPOWIEDZIĆ SIĘ PRZECIWKO - Samobójstwu wspomaganemu przez lekarza!

Ustawodawcy Stanu Massachusetts mają jeszcze tylko 4 tygodni na rozważenie ustawy (**ustawa Senatu nr 1331**), która zalegalizowałaby samobójstwo wspomaganie przez lekarza. Projekt ustawy nosi tytuł „**Ustawa dotycząca opcji na koniec życia**”. Razem, możemy dołączyć do pracowników służby zdrowia, grupy osób niepełnosprawnych, seniorów, i niezliczonych innych osób, aby **powiedzieć NIE** wspomaganemu samobójstwu! Możemy także przyłączyć się do naszych sąsiadów w New Hampshire i powstrzymać dalsze prace legislacyjne podczas tej sesji. Oto kilka niepokojących faktów, które należy wziąć pod uwagę, zanim skontaktujesz się z wybranymi senatorami:

- ◆ Projekt ustawy umożliwiłby lekarzowi podawanie śmiertelnej mieszanki leków osobie, u której zdiagnozowano mniej niż 6 miesięcy życia, która po spożyciu spowodowałaby śmierć.
- ◆ Diagnoza może być błędna. Niezliczona liczba osób przeżyła tę sześciomiesięczną diagnozę i cieszyła się wieloma cennymi miesiącami i latami spędzonymi z rodziną i przyjaciółmi.
- ◆ Brak rzeczywistych zabezpieczeń – bezbronna osoba, która jest niepełnosprawna fizycznie, w depresji lub boi się, że będzie „ciężarem”, może podlegać nadmiernemu wpływowi innych osób, aby zażyła mieszankę leków, zwłaszcza jeśli zachętą jest korzyść finansowa.
- ◆ Wybrani senatorzy powinni skupiać się przede wszystkim na ustawodawstwie zapewniającym wysokiej jakości opiekę zdrowotną, opiekę psychiatryczną i opiekę paliatywną chorym i umierającym – szczególnie w społecznościach niedostatecznie zaopatrzonych, biednych i mniejszościowych, które najbardziej cierpią. WEŻ POD UWAGĘ DAROWIZNE NA RZECZ BAZYLIKI—uwzględniając Bazylikę św. Stanisława w swoich planach posiadłości typu podarunku w formie spadku w swoim testamencie, funduszu z konta emerytalnego lub ubezpieczenia na życie w bardzo znaczący sposób przyczynisz się do utrzymania Bazyliki i wszystkich jej posług przez wiele lat. Planowanie zapisu pozwala teraz zachować kontrolę nad swoim majątkiem przez całe życie, zapewniając jednocześnie spokój sumienia, wiedząc, że przyczyniłeś się do dalszego istnienia Bazyliki. Jeśli Twoja sytuacja się zmieni, zawsze możesz zmodyfikować swój zapis. Co więcej, większość prezentów od Twojego majątku jest zwolniona z podatków federalnych. Mamy nadzieję, że rozważysz jedną z planowanych możliwości przekazania darowizny. Jeśli masz pytania dotyczące tego, która z różnych opcji jest dla Ciebie najlepsza, skonsultuj się z doradcą finansowym, prawnikiem, lub Twoim doradcą podatkowym.

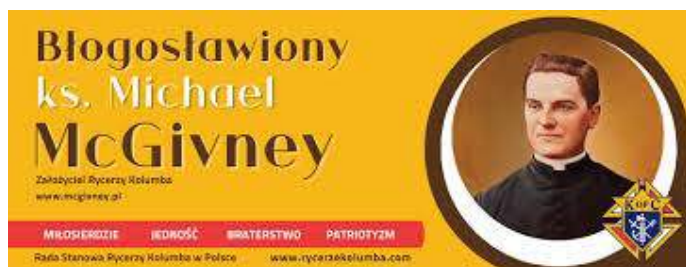

Though Soviet communism in Eastern Europe ended in the early 1990's, its destructive effects linger in the societies where it once ruled. Under the communist system, cultural values of charity and volunteerism disappeared. Rapid, sometimes harsh economic transitions led to a state of materialism that has left many poor and dependent such as children, seniors and persons with disabilities.

Latin America has suffered similar effects. Years of political, social and economic upheaval, rapid changes in leadership and systems have likewise taken their toll on so many, with families and the vulnerable suffering the most.

Both Eastern Europe and Latin America are populated largely by our Catholic brothers and sisters. The collection for the Church in Eastern Europe and the collection for the Church in Latin America are ways for Catholics in the United States to unite more closely with our brothers and sisters in faith throughout these expansive regions.

The collection for the Church in Latin America supports diocesan pastoral catechetical and family life ministries, seminary studies and formation programs for religious brothers and sisters. The collection even helps the poorest dioceses obtain basic necessities that they otherwise would be unable to afford, leaving them unable to minister to the faithful. IT'S TIME TO SPEAK OUT IN OPPOSITION TO PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE

The Massachusetts State Legislature has only **six more weeks** to consider legislation (Senate Bill 1331) that would legalize the practice of Physician Assisted Suicide. The bill is titled, "*An Act relative to end of life options*". Working together, we can join health care professionals, disability groups, senior citizens, the infirmed and countless individuals in saying **NO** to assisted suicide! We can also join our neighbors in New Hampshire¹ and stop the legislation from moving forward this session.

Here are some troubling facts to consider before you contact your elected officials:

- 1.) The bill would allow a physician to provide a deadly drug mixture to an individual diagnosed with less than 6 months to live that, when consumed, would cause death.
NOTE - The diagnosis could be wrong. Countless individuals have outlived that 6-month diagnosis and enjoyed many more precious months and years with family and friends.
- 2.) No Real Safeguards - A vulnerable individual who is physically disabled, depressed, or fears being a "burden" may be subject to undue influence by others to take the drug mixture, especially if there is a financial benefit as an incentive.
- 3.) The primary focus of elected officials should be dedicated to legislation providing quality health care, mental health care and palliative care to the sick and dying – particularly in the underserved, poor and minority communities that suffer the most at the time of need.

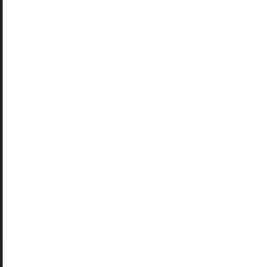
