

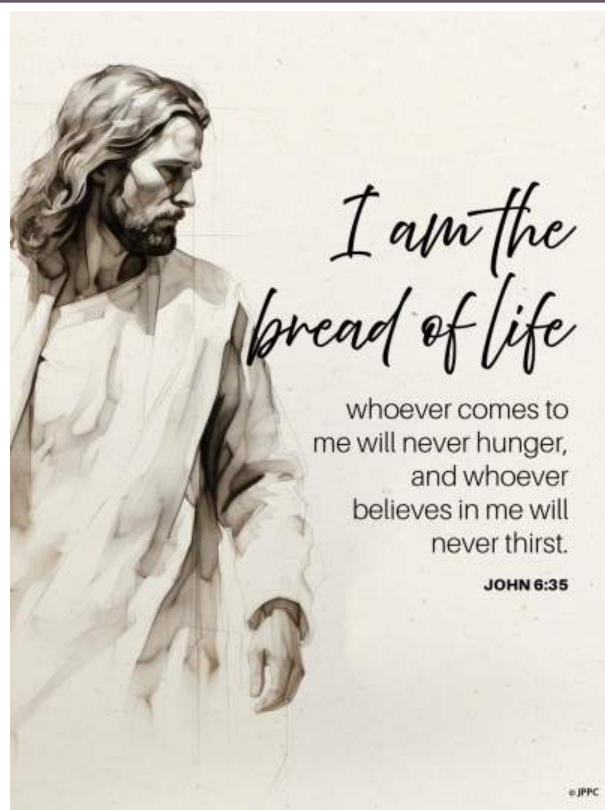

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! As we continue this Sunday to hear from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John, the liturgy provides us with another opportunity to reaffirm and deepen our faith in Jesus Christ, truly present in the Eucharist. Since our Savior sometimes repeats himself in this long chapter of the Fourth Gospel, it is helpful to remember that the gospel each Sunday is paired thematically with the first reading from the Old Testament. If we listen to Exodus 16 today, the theme is clear: grumbling.

We have all grumbled at some point in our lives for various reasons: a long to-do list; homework; difficult family situations; leftovers for dinner; an arduous task at work; crazy drivers. The ancient Israelites were grumbling because of comfort and convenience. Separated from us by three thousand years or so, they still sound like us! Because the Israelites were pioneering a new life with God in the desert, their rumbling stomachs even made them think about returning to slavery in Egypt rather than put trust in the Lord's providential care to move them forward. The Lord does, in fact, give the people what they need and provide bread from heaven.

Jesus takes this providential care and trust to a whole new level. In a couple of sentences, he declares that the Exodus bread from heaven will seem like nothing when the disciples receive the true Bread from heaven: Jesus' very self in his body and blood. Jesus challenges us beyond our grumbling and earthbound hungers to longing for the food that really matters, the Bread of Life that will prepare us for eternal life after a few decades on earth. Do you find yourself grumbling today? Come to Jesus.

Jezus mówi w Ewangelii: „Jam jest chleb życia. Kto do Mnie przychodzi, nie będzie łaknął; a kto we Mnie wierzy, nigdy pragnąć nie będzie”. Wakacje są dla wielu ludzi poszukiwaniem Boga, który gdzieś zagubił się na drogach codziennego pośpiechu, pogoni za pieniędzmi, znaczeniem, zdobywania kolejnych stopni awansu czy wspinania się po stopniach kariery. Warto więc budzić w swoim sercu pragnienie spotkania z Panem, zwłaszcza w Eucharystii.

„Na tym polega dzieło zamierzone przez Boga, abyście uwierzyli w Tego, którego On posłał.” Jak wyjaśnia św. Augustyn, „wierzyć” oznacza spożywać, jeść Chleb życia, tkwić w Chrystusie, tworzyć z Nim wspólnotę, być nasyconym w niewidzialny sposób. To wszystko dokonuje się w Kościele, w znaku celebracji liturgicznej. Najważniejsze zatem, by aby iść na Mszę św. z wielkim pragnieniem, z wielkim głodem spotkania Jezusa. Pomocą może okazać się post eucharystyczny, który pomaga obudzić wewnętrzne pragnienie Słowa Bożego i zjednoczenia z Jezusem w Komunii św. Głód duchowy nie rodzi się jednak automatycznie z głodu fizycznego. On wymaga pracy nad sobą, chęci doświadczenia Jezusa w Eucharystii. Ta godzina postu eucharystycznego to czas, w którym nasze pragnienie Jezusa powinno osiągnąć szczyt. To jest miejsce, by ten krótki czas, ta godzina, która w sposób fizyczny nas wiele nie kosztuje, kosztowała nas duchowo. To takie budzenie pragnienia, budzenie głodu Boga.

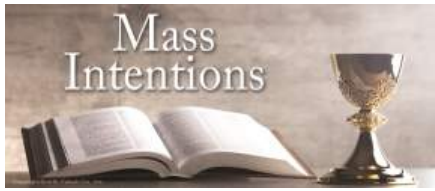
