Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! Last weekend I had a wonderful visit with a couple who was married here at St. Stan's just about a year ago. They live in the greater Boston area but reached out to me to come to Mass and share a meal. It was a blessing for me to know they are doing well in a new house and neighborhood, feeling at home in a new parish, and joyfully expecting their first child. When I said goodbye to them after a few hours, I lifted up a prayer of thanks to God for their lives and example.

As I reflected on this Sunday's readings from Genesis and Jesus' powerful, challenging words on divorce and adultery, I was tempted at first to invoke Pope Francis' words against what he calls "ideological colonization": the attack on traditional marriage, cultural rejection of biological gender, the sins of abortion and euthanasia—the list can go on. After last weekend's visit, I changed my mind. The best argument, after all, is the witness of a life—in this case, newlyweds who are doing their best to live the sacrament of Christian married love and welcome new life as they cooperate with God's grace to create a new family in Christ.

There is a time for doctrinal arguments, always with the hope that we proclaim the truth of our faith in charity. However, the best argument is the witness of a countercultural gospel life lived joyfully, faithfully, and perseveringly. This weekend let's pray for all married couples, especially newlyweds, with the words of today's psalm: "Blessed are you who fear the Lord, who walk in his ways.... May you see your children's children!"

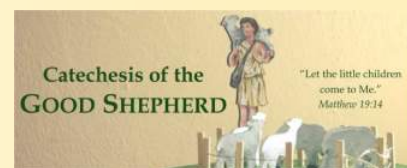

BIULETYN Parafialny

Autor natchniony w Księdze Rodzaju kończy opis stworzenia niewiasty stwierdzeniem: „mężczyzna opuszcza ojca swego i matkę swoją i łączy się ze swą żoną tak ściśle, że stają się jednym ciałem”. Taki był i jest Boży pomysł na szczęście i człowieka. Przypomina o tym Jezus w dzisiejszej Ewangelii w dyspucie z faryzeuszami: „Co więc Bóg złączył, tego człowiek niech nie rozdziela”. W ten sposób głosi, że od samego początku Stwórca proponuje małżeństwo jako wieczyste przymierze, w którym obowiązuje jedność myślenia, woli i miłości oraz nierozzerwalność. Zarówno mężowi, jak i żonie nie wolno zatem zrywać ustanowionej przez Boga jedności i związać się z innym partnerem, bo popełniają „cudzołóstwo”.



Pierwszy cud, na podstawie którego uczniowie uwierzyli, uczynił Jezus na weselu w Kanie Galilejskiej. Uświęcił w ten sposób związek małżeński, wnosząc przez swoją obecność błogosławieństwo i radość. Małżeństwo chrześcijan z woli Chrystusa staje się sakramentem, czyli świętym znakiem prawdziwego powołania małżonków do świętości. Dzięki obecności Ducha Świętego małżonkowie podtrzymują i umacniają swój związek przez wzajemne oddanie i niepodzielną miłość, wypływającą z Boskiego źródła miłości. A także są zatroskani o dobro swoich dzieci.

Nierozzerwalność wypływa z samej natury miłości. Sakramentalne „ślubuję ci”, wypowiedziane wobec współmałżonka stanowi uczestnictwo w nieodwołalnym „tak” wypowiedzianym przez Chrystusa Kościołowi. Jest zatem czymś więcej niż czysto ludzką umową i przyrzeczeniem wzajemnej miłości, choć nawet ludzka tylko przysięga domaga się spełnienia tego, co się obiecało. Ten „węzeł” sakramentalny oznacza nie tylko zaangażowanie osobiste, ale przede wszystkim zobowiązanie moralne do wierności. U podstaw nierozzerwalności leżą również względy socjologiczne, ponieważ małżeństwo jest również wymogiem małżeństwa jako instytucji.
