Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! As I write this reflection, it is Election Day eve. The stakes are high for this election, especially for people of faith. Whatever the outcome, may the Lord help us to walk as a nation in the way of peace and truly work for the common good, the protection of all human life, and the safeguarding of our freedoms as envisioned in the founding of our nation.

Both the first reading and the gospel offer consolation and hope for the days ahead. 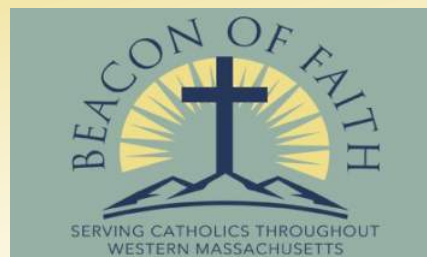

BIULETYN Parafialny



Jezus, który naucza z mocą, krytykuje postępowanie uczonych w Piśmie. Zarzuca im, że działają na pokaz: chcą wyróżniać się przez swój strój, są spragnieni uznania i honorów, ich zarozumiałości towarzyszy chciwość i obłuda. Nie tylko objadają ubogie wdowy, ale również – powierzchownie i fałszywie pobożni – modlą się na pokaz. Przeciwnieństwem zachowania uczonych w Piśmie staje się „uboga wdowa”, która stanowi wzór oddania i zaufania Bożej Opatrzności. To ona wykazuje się prawdziwą pobożnością i ofiarnością. Widzi to Jezus, który siedzi naprzeciw ostatniej, tzn. trzynastej skarbony na dziedzińcu, do której wrzucano dobrowolne ofiary na ofiary całopalne. Tak więc kobieta, która wrzuciła do skarbony „wdowi grosz”, przeznaczyła wszystkie swoje pieniądze na kult i chwałę Bożą.

Hojności zasiewu zależy od otwartości serca, a ta z kolei przyczynia się do obfitości zbiorów. I nie chodzi tu o wielkość inwestycji, ale o postawę człowieka, by nie dawać minimalistycznie i na pokaz, i tylko z tego, co nam zbywa. W swoim całkowitym zaufaniu ewangeliczna wdowa jest podobna do Jezusa. Na tym polega prawdziwa pobożność i wiara chrześcijańska. Jak zauważa kard. Karol Wojtyła, „Środki ubogie mają to do siebie, że są w pewien sposób najbogatsze, gdyż głównym środkiem ubogich jest ludzkie serce. Tylko trzeba do niego trafić. Bez tego środka wszystkie bogate środki są ubogie. Przestają działać”.

Słowo Boże wiedzie nas drogą do odkrycia duchowego bogactwa i umacniania go w swoim życiu. Podstawą rozwoju duchowego bogactwa jest żywy kontakt z Trójjedynym Bogiem i realizacja wskazań Kościoła. Na tej drodze pomocą mogą stać się dla nas pouczenia świętych. Św. Ignacy Loyola w słynnych „Ćwiczeniach Duchowych” zwraca uwagę, by żyć i postępować „na większą chwałę Bożą”. Jego inna zasada brzmi „więcej” i pomaga dojrzywać duchowo, by przechodzić od „muszę” do „chcę”, od tego, co „dobre”, do tego, co „lepiej”; od tego, co „poprawne”, do tego, co „święte”.
