Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! Since February 2nd falls on a Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are privileged to celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord this weekend. Known also as Candlemas Day or "little Christmas," this feast celebrates the Light coming into the world as a vulnerable baby carried in the arms of Mary and Joseph as they fulfill their duties according to the Torah. Simeon and Anna, representatives of the truly wise men and women of the Old Testament, recognize the Messiah even at his birth and infancy.

This feast, however, is far from being just another event in the early life of Jesus or an occasion for sentimentalism. Today's first reading and responsorial psalm place the Presentation within the larger context of Israel's history of exile and return to the Promised Land--and the return of the Lord's presence in his Temple. The prophet Ezekiel, in exile with his people, had begun his prophecy with the tragic scene of the departure of the glory of the Lord from the Temple in Jerusalem--a punishment for the people's sins and infidelity as they tried to live life apart from the Lord's will for them. But the glory of God returned to dwell in the midst of the people as they came home to their own land.

Today's feast celebrates that God has now definitively returned to his Temple, not in fearsome power and glory but in the humble flesh and form of an infant to invite us back to the fullness of divine life. Will you let in the Light in the temple that you are in this Jubilee Year of Hope?

While little is known about his life, one well-known story tells of his miraculous cure of a young boy who was choking on a fishbone. This act of healing led to Saint Blaise being invoked as a patron for those suffering from illnesses of the throat. His intercession has been sought since the 8th century, particularly for those in need of healing.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Święto Ofiarowanie Pańskiego obchodzi Kościół czterdzieści dni po Bożym Narodzeniu. Wiążą się z nim trzy wydarzenia: „oczyszczenie Maryi”, „wykupienie” pierworodnego Dziecka przez uiszczenie przewidzianej przez Prawo ofiary oraz „przedstawienie” Go w świątyni. Po kultowym akcie przedstawienia, czyli ofiarowania na wzór ofiar składanych przez kapłanów w Świątyni, ma miejsce scena prorocza. Prorokini Anna i sędziwy prorok Symeon jako przedstawiciele wierzącego Izraela, pod natchnieniem Bożego Ducha pozdrawiają „Mesjasza Pańskiego”.

Zatrzymajmy się przez chwilę nad postacią Symeona. Ewangelista Łukasz określa go jako człowieka sprawiedliwego i pobożnego, który i wyczekuje pociechy Izraela. Żyje on w bliskości Świątyni, w otwarcu na pełnienie woli Bożej. Jako człowiek duchowy jest wrażliwy na Boże natchnienia. Dlatego pojawia się w Świątynio w momencie, gdy wchodzi do niej Święta Rodzina. Bierze w objęcia i błogosławi Dziecię Jezus. „W tym serdecznym uścisku, jaki spadkobierca dotychczasowych dziejów zbawienia przekazuje Temu, który jest „Pociechą” nowego Izraela, widać wypełnienie i dokonanie tego, co miało przyjść” (E. Szymanek).



Symeon pełen wdzięczności wobec Władcy wyśpiewuje radosny kantyk. To pieśń, która wypełnia i wieńczy życie tego starca, a przez niego i całe Stare Przymierze, którego on jest przedstawicielem. Stanowi ona od czasów starożytnych w Kościołach Wschodu i Zachodu część modlitwy liturgicznej na zakończenie dnia. Symeon pod koniec ziemskiego życia widzi zbawczą misję, którą ma wypełnić wobec ludzkości Dziecię Jezus. To rodzi w nim pokój serca i ufność w Boże obietnice. Symeon nazywa Chrystusa „światłem na oświecenie pogan”, których wyzwala z ciemności bałwochwalstwa i grzechu, oraz „chwałą ludu Twego Izraela”. W ten sposób wskazuje, że misja Zbawiciela, zapowiedziana przez proroków, dotyczy zarówno Greków, jak i Żydów.

DZIEKUJEMY

– weteranom z IV Okręgu Stowarzyszenia Weteranów Polskich z Hartford CT i z Bostonu. Przyjechali w ubiegłą niedzielę by modlić się wspólnie z nami i oddać hold uczestnikom Powstania Styczniowego z 1863-1864 roku i weteranom spoczywającym na naszym cmentarzu a szczególnie P. Wincentemu Smolczyńskiemu uczestnikowi tego powstania i Ojcu Lucjanowi Królikowskiemu. Zdjęcia z ich pobytu w Chicopee.



Tradycyjne **BŁOGOSŁAWIEŃSTWO GARDEŁ** - odbędzie się 2 lutego po wszystkich Mszach św. Święty Błażej był biskupem Sebasty – miasta położonego na terenie dzisiejszej Turcji – umarł około 316 roku. Tradycja sięgająca wczesnego średniowiecza przekazała pamięć o nim jako orędowniku i opiekunie wiernych, zwłaszcza w chorobach gardła. Za jego wstawiennictwem prosimy Boga o zdrowie gardła i o łaskę dobrego korzystania z daru mowy. Żywy przez wieki kult, jaki odbierał na Wschodzie i Zachodzie, świadczy o historyczności jego postaci i męczeńskiej śmierci. Według tradycji uzdrowił w sposób cudowny syna pewnej kobiety, któremu ość przebiła gardło i groziło to uduszeniem.

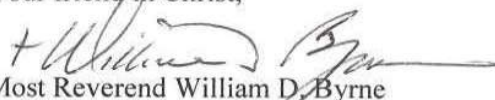

Qualified Charitable Distribution

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.

Please consider making a big impact on the future of the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus by the use of the Qualified Charitable Distribution option from your IRA!
