Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Feast of Pentecost! In St. Paul's Letter to the Romans, the Apostle to the Nations proclaims the marvelous truth that "you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a Spirit of adoption through whom we cry, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God..." (8:15-16). 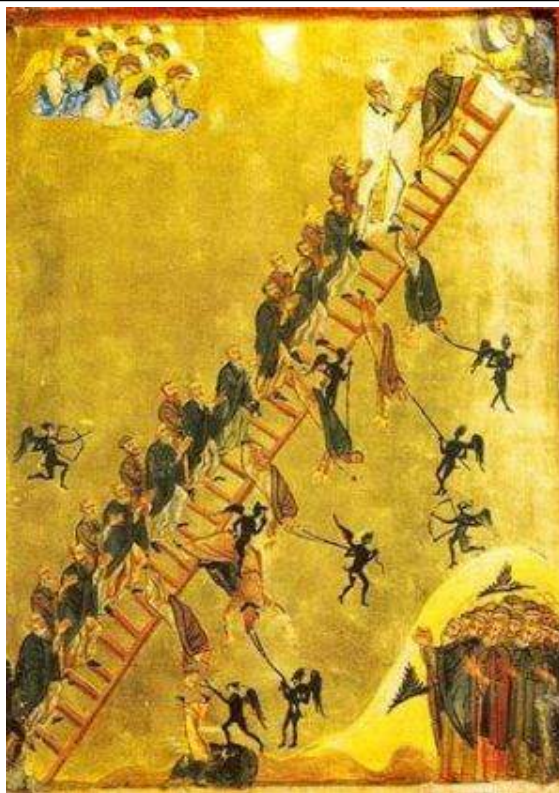

BIULETYN Parafialny

Wśród najbardziej reprezentatywnych dla sztuki bizantyńskiej ikon pokazanych na wystawie „Bizancjum”, zorganizowanej na przełomie 2008/2009 roku w Królewskiej Akademii Sztuk Pięknych w Londynie, znalazła się ikona „Drabina do nieba” (tempera na desce, 41x29 cm). Pochodzi ona ze słynnego klasztoru św. Katarzyny na Synaju i jest datowana na XII w. Bez wątpienia inspiracją do powstania ikony był traktat św. Jana Klimaka pod tym samym tytułem. Ikona znakomicie ilustruje dynamikę życia duchowego stanowiąc metaforę drogi wiary chrześcijanina wznoszącej go ku Bogu: mnisi podążają do raju po trzydziestu szczeblach drabiny łączącej niebo z ziemią. Tych trzydzieści stopni wieńczą trzy cnoty boskie: wiara, nadzieja i miłość. Są one dostępne jednak nie tylko dla herosów wiary, ale dla każdego chrześcijanina prowadzącego życie sprawiedliwe.



W dzisiejszą uroczystość przychodzimy do Jezusa, który wskazuje na to, kim jesteśmy i dokąd zmierzamy. Sam pomaga nam określić naszą tożsamość, wskazuje kierunek naszego życia, kiedy „wśród radości wstępuje do nieba”. Idzie do domu Ojca, w którym jest wiele mieszkań. Idzie po to, ażeby przygotować nam miejsce. Jezus nie pozostawia nas jednak sierotami, daje nam obietnicę Ducha Świętego. Ducha Prawdy, Ducha Pocieszyciel, który będzie nas umacniał, oświecał, pomagał lepiej i pełniej zrozumieć tajemnicę Chrystusa.

Wraz z Wniebowstąpieniem Chrystusa rozpoczyna się czas Ducha Świętego, czas Kościoła, który pomaga nam odkrywać naszą chrześcijańską tożsamość, nasze ostateczne powołanie. Każdy chrześcijanin podążający drogą życia, siłą wiary i mocą sakramentów zmierza do poznania Boga i wspina się do bram nieba. W czasie tej drogi jest nieustannie narażony na niebezpieczeństwa – musi toczyć walkę duchową z pokusami, które odwodzą go od podstawowego celu życia ziemskiego, czyli zbawienia. Jednak nie wszyscy wychodzą z tych zmagających obronną ręką. Stąd potrzebne jest nieustanne trwanie w łączności z Jezusem, który jest „drabiną” do nieba, w takim samym znaczeniu jak jest drogą do nieba, prawdą i życiem. Ta droga prowadzi w górę, gdzie Jezus zasiada po prawicy Ojca. Chrystus prowadzi wierzącego od najniższych krańców jego cielesności i doczesności, stopniowo, do przemiany, aż do chwili, w której „ujrzymy Go takim, jakim jest, i będziemy do Niego podobni”.

Qualified Charitable Distribution



A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
