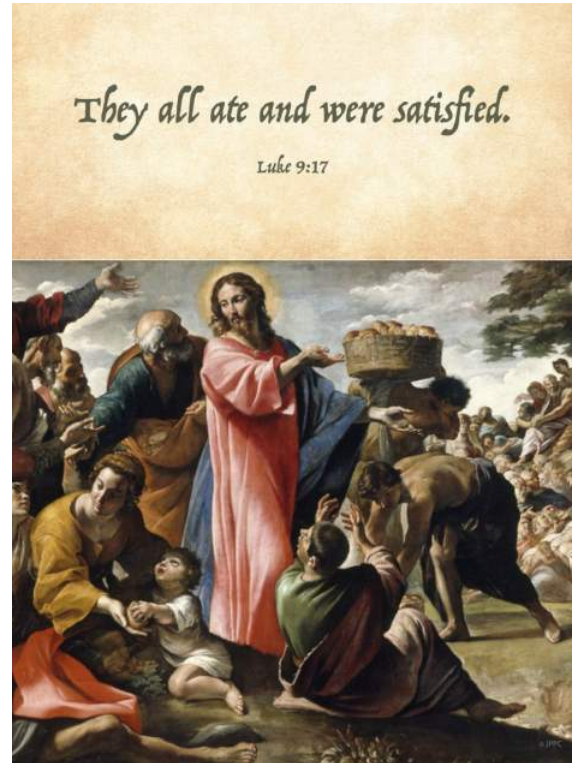

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! This Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, occurs yearly in the afterglow from the Easter season, to remind us that the crucified and risen Lord Jesus, truly present in the Eucharist, should be both received and adored. Moreover, the joy and reverence with which we encounter Him at our altar is very often an indicator of the depth with which we will encounter Him in the rest of our ordinary lives when we are sent forth

at the end of Mass.

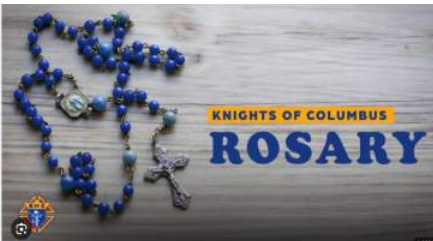
I invite us all this weekend to fine tune our belief in the Eucharist and make a decision to draw forth from this mystery all that the Lord lovingly wishes to give us. The very public act of receiving Holy Communion, with all that requires and implies about our lives as Catholic Christians, as well as the quieter moments of Eucharistic adoration, should both be part of our schedules. Our reception of the Lord Jesus as nourishment and abiding presence needs to affect everything about us—from the way we behave in church to the way we behave at home, from the reverence we show in our Basilica to the reverence with which we encounter the Body of Christ in our wounded or restless brothers and sisters.

I am reminded of the unique “monstrance” in the Eucharistic adoration chapel in Niepokalanów, the City of the Immaculate just outside of Warsaw that was founded by our Conventual Franciscan confrere, St. Maximilian Kolbe. The “lunette,” the actual container for the sacred host, is placed within a statue of Mary right where her heart is. What a powerful reminder not only of who Mary is but also of who we are called to be as disciples. We who have received the Lord Jesus Christ into our very bodies as food cannot help but continue to keep Him lovingly and adoringly at the heart of our lives as we encounter Him daily in moments both distressing and glorious.

Happy Feast of Corpus Christi!

This is a Jubilee Year of Hope pilgrimage site allowing participants to perform a plenary indulgence. They prayer service will include the Marian Rosary, Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Year of Hope prayer and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Light refreshments will be served afterward.

Consider Leaving a Lasting Legacy Qualified Charitable Distribution

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income. If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Boże Ciało skupia nas na Eucharystii jako uczcie i trwałej obecności w Najświętszym Sakramencie. Dla pierwszych chrześcijan uczta eucharystyczna była przeżyciem wspólnotowym. Zachęcali się wzajemnie do przyjmowania Komunii św. słowami: pójdźmy po życie, po moc, po miłość, po świętość! Komunia łączy nas zarówno z Chrystusem, jak również z braćmi i siostrami.

Dar Eucharystii jest oddaniem samego siebie Pana Jezusa, który „do końca nas umiłował”. Dzięki tej obecności spełnia się Jego obietnica, że pozostanie z nami aż do skończenia świata. Pan Jezus pozostał z nami w znaku chleba i wina. Eucharystia jest również sercem orędzia fatimskiego. Anioł przyniósł kielich i hostię od strony kościoła parafialnego mówiąc: „Bierzcie i spożywajcie Ciało i Krew Jezusa Chrystusa, okrutnie znieważane przez niewdzięcznych ludzi. Naprawiajcie ich występki i pocieszajcie Boga”. W ten sposób chciał pokazać, że prawdziwe Ciało i prawdziwa Krew Zbawiciela są w każdej katolickiej świątyni. Tam, a nie w cudownościach mamy szukać tego, co w widzeniu otrzymały dzieci: zjednoczenia z Bogiem przez Eucharystię. Wysłannik z nieba chce nam pokazać, że również naszym udziałem może stać się eucharystyczne doświadczenie pastuszków.



Od sposobu naszego udziału w Eucharystii zależy jakość naszych relacji nie tylko z Bogiem, ale także z naszymi bliźni. Jeżeli bowiem czas eucharystycznego zgromadzenia jest dla nas zewnętrznym rytuałem, w trakcie którego nasza uwaga błądzi po wielu miejscach, to mamy podstawy do obaw, iż traktujemy Jezusa po prostu jak przedmiot. Przedmiot ważny, ale nie będący Osobą. Jest świętą rzeczą, kawałkiem chleba, który spożywamy i zaraz o nim zapominamy, przytłoczeni naszą zabieganą codziennością. Traktując Jezusa jak rzecz, zaczynamy też traktować innych jak przedmioty, które służą poprawieniu naszego samopoczucia. Udział we Mszy św. daje nam komfort spełnionego obowiązku religijnego, a nasi bliźni są przez nas traktowani jak narzędzia, które służą uzyskaniu naszego zadowolenia.

Pomocą w owocnym przeżywaniu spotkania z Jezusem w Eucharystii może być również doświadczenie mistyczne bł. Marii Kandydy od Eucharystii (1884–1949), karmelitanki bosej z Ragusy na Sycylii. W swoim dziele o Najświętszym Sakramencie wyznaje, że poznała Jezusa-Hostię bardzo późno: „Miałam około osiemnastu lat, gdy pojęłam coś z tej tajemnicy. Spóźniłam się raz na Mszę Świętą i nie mogłam przyjąć Komunii świętej. Ponieważ kościół był już zamknięty, chciałam zawrócić, ale jakaś uboga kobieta powiedziała mi: «Dlaczego pani nie wejdzie do zakrystii, aby choć na krótko odwiedzić Pana?». Te słowa, a także przykład mojej starszej siostry, naprowadziły mnie na obecność Jezusa w tabernakulum”.

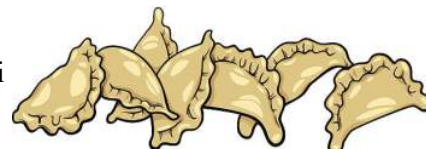
