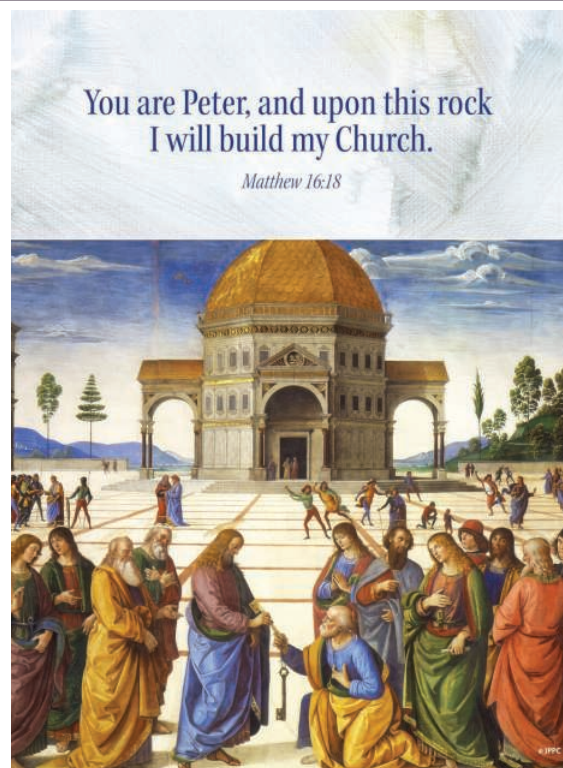

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This weekend gives us the opportunity to celebrate on a Sunday of Ordinary Time the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, whose statues flank the beloved icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa on our high altar. These two pillars of our faith also symbolize our deep connection with Rome and the Holy Father, the successor of Peter. Please continue to pray for Leo XIV as he strives to tend and feed the Lord's flock.

The first reading from Acts and Paul's autobiographical reflections in the second reading remind us that these two apostles endured much suffering—and eventually death—in their witness to Christ and their desire to spread the gospel. As I write this I am reminded that Greek Orthodox Christians in Syria were killed just a week ago by an Islamist terrorist as they worshipped. Sadly, Christian persecution in many forms is widespread today and not just something we read about in ancient history. However, “the angel of the Lord will rescue those who fear him.”

As we celebrate Saints Peter and Paul, we pray for the courage to be doers of the word as we leave church and to have the fortitude to offer our whole selves to the service of the gospel and the Body of Christ.

BIULETYN Parafialny

W dniu, w którym Kościół wspomina swoje dwa filary – Piotra i Pawła, spójrzmy pokrótce na życie każdego z nich. Szymon, zwany Piotrem, prosty rybak z Betsaidy, był stosunkowo dobrze sytuowany, a przy tym pobożny. Tak jak inni Żydzi oczekiwał Mesjasza. Wraz ze swoim bratem Andrzejem został przez samego Jezusa wezwany, aby być „rybakiem ludzi”. Więcej, Piotr stał się księciem wszystkich apostołów. Dotarł ze świadectwem Ewangelii do Rzymu. Tam też poniósł śmierć za czasów Nerona, między 64 a 67 rokiem.

Natomiast Szaweł z Tarsu, zwany później Pawłem, przez kilka lat pod kierunkiem Gamaliela uczył się prawa żydowskiego i zapoznawał się z historią swojego narodu. Potrafił też wytwarzać namioty z płótna i skór. Początkowo Szaweł brał udział w prześladowaniach chrześcijan, ale po nawróceniu pod Damaszkiem zaczął głosić Ewangelię, zakładał liczne wspólnoty. Aresztowany, mieszkał w Rzymie przez trzy lata. Tam też został stracony za czasów Nerona, około 65 roku.

Wpatrując się w życiorysy Piotra i Pawła zauważamy, w jak przedziwny sposób Pan Bóg potrafi przemieniać ludzkie serca. Dzięki spotkaniu z miłosierdziem Bożym zalękniony Piotr staje się odważny, a z prześladowcy zmienia się w gorliwego Apostoła Narodów. Patrząc na dzisiejszych Patronów warto uświadomić sobie przed wszystkim potrzebę gorliwości w głoszeniu Ewangelii. Warto uświadomić sobie, że Dobra Nowina jest zawsze nowa i zawsze niesie nowość. W dobie „nowej ewangelizacji” musi być przekazywana „z nową gorliwością, nowymi metodami i z zastosowaniem nowych środków wyrazu” (VS 106). Zapyta ktoś: po co to wszystko? Przecież Ewangelia się nie zmienia. Owszem, ale zmienia się świat, któremu ma być głoszona. Dominikanin Jacek Salij twierdzi, że jedynym powodem, dla którego należy gorliwie głosić Ewangelię i zapraszać do Kościoła, jest radość. Wy pł ywa ona z faktu, że Bóg obdarował nas swoim Synem. To radość, której nie potrafimy zatrzymać dla siebie, lecz musimy się nią dzielić z innymi. Wszystko po to, aby jak najwięcej ludzi mogło się radować razem z nami. Chodzi więc o doprowadzenie ludzi do samego Jezusa Chrystusa.

Qualified Charitable Distribution



A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.

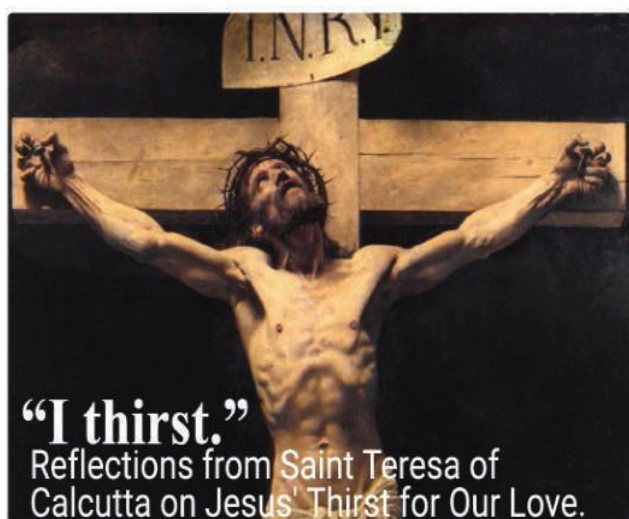
