

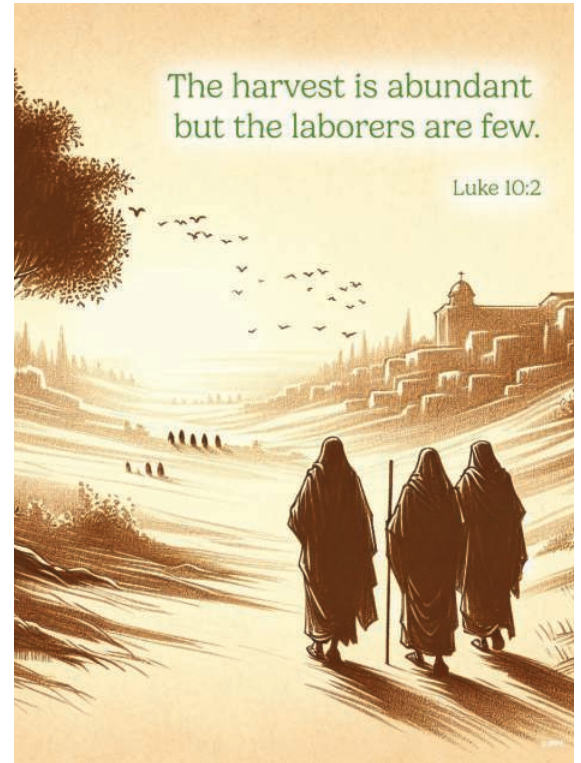

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! A Blessed Fourth of July weekend to you and your families! On this Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we hear the powerful gospel of Jesus sending out the 72 disciples to announce the kingdom of God. Seventy-two is symbolic of the number of Gentile nations (Genesis 10) as well as Moses' sharing authority with the 70 elders (Numbers 11:24-26). This Sunday's passage comes after the decisive turning point in St. Luke's gospel when Jesus "sets his face" toward Jerusalem (Luke 9:51) to continue his mission from the Father at whatever cost.

What strikes me about this passage is that it combines two things we do not ordinarily consider compatible in our daily lives: urgency and peace. Jesus gives the 72 disciples explicit instructions on what they are to do and say: no extra baggage and no procrastinating along the way. At the same time, the first greeting of the disciples to anyone they encounter should be that of peace. If the kingdom of God is at hand, then there is no reason to be anxious or upset. God is accomplishing his plan for the world in the person of his Son, Jesus Christ.

I think we can relate to the sense of urgency in Jesus' message even today, especially considering all the challenges to our Catholic Christian faith that we see at work in a world increasingly ignorant of Jesus' message, his act of redemption, and the church's vision for humanity. We need to regain a sense of urgency in evangelization as we are sent forth each Sunday from the Basilica "to glorify the Lord with our lives" and "announce the gospel of the Lord." At the same time, we should have peace in our hearts because Jesus has already won the victory. He is patiently waiting and interceding at the right hand of the Father that hearts be receptive to the Way, the Truth, and the Life—the only path that will bring the world true salvation and lasting peace.

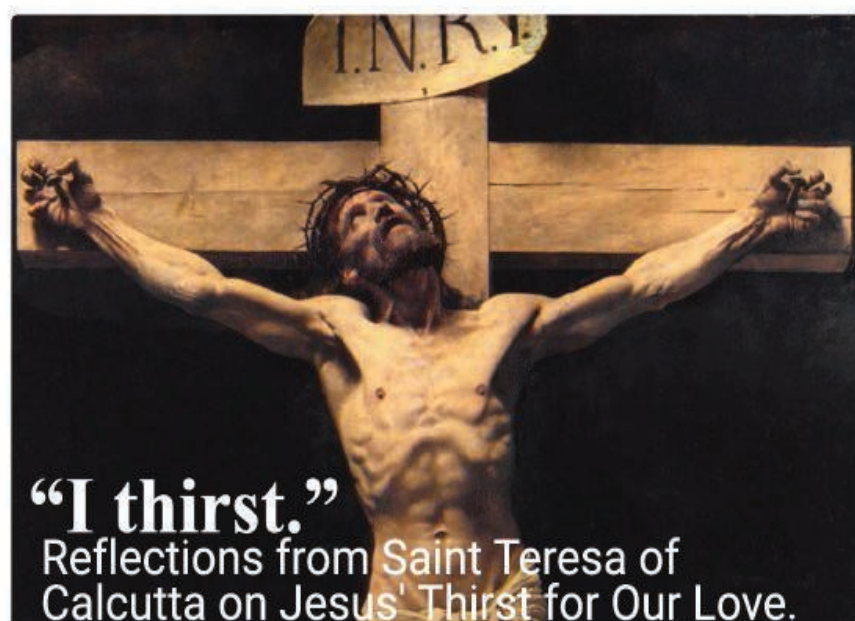

## BIULETYN Parafialny

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia mówi o tym, jak Jezus posłał swoich uczniów do miejscowości, do których sam zamierzał pójść. Słyszeliśmy słowa Chrystusa: „Żniwo wprawdzie wielkie, ale robotników mało. Proście Pana żniwa, żeby wyprawił robotników na swoje żniwo”. Zazwyczaj słowa te odnosimy do „urzędowych” świadków: księży, zakonników, sióstr zakonnych, czy katechetów świeckich. Warto jednak zauważyć, że Jezus kieruje te słowa nie do ścisłego grona dwunastu apostołów, ale wyznacza jeszcze innych siedemdziesięciu dwóch uczniów.

Głoszenie Dobrej Nowiny nie jest zarezerwowane wyłącznie dla wybranych. Każdy uczeń Jezusa ma o Nim świadczyć, aby inni uwierzyli. Nie można znać Jezusa i o Nim nie mówić. Nie można być ochrzczonym i żyć tak, jakby to nie miało wpływu na nasze życie. Mamy dzielić się swoją wiarą. II Polski Synod Plenarny określa powołanie osób świeckich jako posłanie przez Boga do świata, „aby nadawać światu ewangeliczny smak, przemieniać i uświęcać świat od wewnątrz, na sposób zaczynu, oświecać wszelkie drogi, po których kroczą, światłem wiary, nadziei i miłości”.

Każdy podczas chrztu otrzymuje zapaloną od paschału - symbolu Jezusa Chrystusa - świecę. Jej płomień symbolizuje światło wiary. Najpierw mieli o nią dbać nasi rodzice i chrzestni; potem już my sami mamy iść i zapalać światłem naszej wiary wiarę innych. Wiara umacnia się, gdy jest przekazywana. W sakramencie bierzmowania otrzymaliśmy moc Ducha Świętego uzdalniającą nas do dawania świadectwa. Pozwólmy więc prowadzić się Duchowi Bożemu. Słuchając słów Jezusa, że „żniwo wielkie, ale robotników mało” nie mogąc nie spytać, co ja robię, by stać się jednym z tych robotników.

Największą trudnością w głoszeniu naszej wiary jest nieumiejętność mówienia o sprawach wiary. Brakuje nam solidnego przygotowania, pogłębionej wiedzy o wierze, systematycznej edukacji, zrozumienia trudnego niekiedy słownictwa. Zdajemy sobie sprawę, że po dzisiejszej homilii nie wyruszą na ulice naszej parafii zastępy wysłanników Pana Jezusa. Może jednak pozostanie w nas zachęta do tego, aby bliżej zapoznać się z treściami wiary, sięgnąć po Pismo Święte lub książkę z przemówieniami papieża.

**Qualified Charitable Distribution**

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
