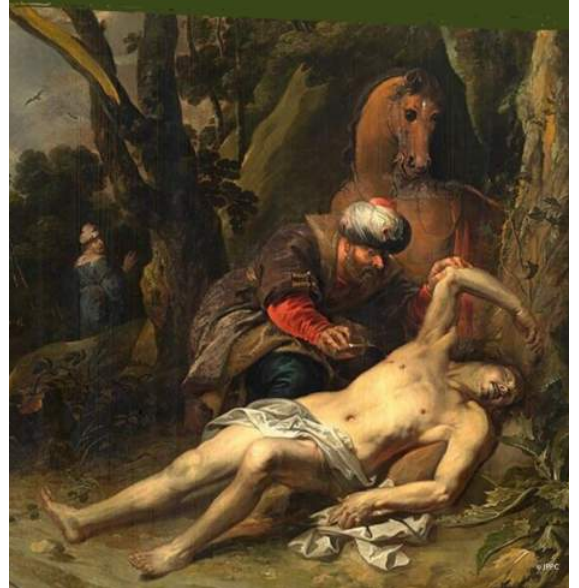

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! This Sunday's parable of the Good Samaritan is perhaps one of the best known of Jesus' stories. Parables were meant to turn the hearer's world upside down, and this one certainly would have in Jesus' day. Because of the displacement of and intermarriage between ethnic groups during and after the exile in ancient Israel, Samaritans and Jews did not associate with one another and had an active dislike--oftentimes hatred—for each other. The shocker of the parable is that a Samaritan becomes the hero because he treats the wounded traveler with compassion, even as Jews passed by him.

We are blessed to have a constant reminder of this parable in the smaller stained-glass window above the handicapped entrance to the Basilica. We see the scene of today's gospel beautifully captured in art. What also deserves mention, however, is the small stained-glass window over the opposite entrance. That scene depicts the Good Shepherd leaving the ninety-nine sheep and looking for the one that strayed. The two gospel passages (and windows!) go together. Each one of us must be the Good Samaritan who treats our neighbor with compassion, especially the wounded and marginalized, because we are all the lost sheep whom Jesus has brought back into the fold--over and over again. We are called to be instruments of God's mercy because we have all experienced that same mercy in our encounters with the Lord.

St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians, in effect, helps put our two windows of mercy together. Christianity can never be reduced to a program for charitable work or sociological and economic change. Such things may come about because of dedicated Christians, but only because they have personally encountered Jesus Christ, the Good Shepherd, through whom, for whom, and in whom all things have been created and reconciled. Having encountered the Lord in Word and Sacrament at this Mass, whom will we lift up this week? Whose wounds will we help to heal?

## BIULETYN Parafialny

Mamy wokół siebie wielu ludzi zabieganych, „krzątających się”. Ich troska jest związana z niekończącym się pomnażaniem posiadanych dóbr. A więc uwijają się, by mieć więcej i twierdzą, że ciągle im brakuje czasu. Nawet niedziela nie stanowi dla nich przeszkody. Nie tylko sami nie przeżywają jej po Bożemu, ale utrudniają to również innym. Ich spryt, zaradność wydają się wręcz nie do pojęcia. Jest tylko jeden problem – w tym wszystkim brakuje miłości. Podobnie jak u kobiety, która przychodziła do kościoła godzinę przed Mszą, aby się pomodlić. Ale po wyjściu ze świątyni robiła wiele zła swoim pozbawionym miłości językiem, rozsiewając plotki, obmowy i oszczerstwa.



Czytany dziś w liturgii fragment Ewangelii poprzedza opowieść o przedsiębiorczym Samarytaninie, który jest obrazem i wzorem miłości bliźniego: wrażliwej, konkretnej, nieszczędzącej własnego czasu i majątku. Natomiast Marta z dzisiejszego fragmentu przyjęła Jezusa i uczniów w swoim domu w Betanii. I „uwijała się około rozmaitych posług” (Łk 10,40). Pełniła wobec nich, utrudzonych drogą i pracą, rolę Samarytanina. Maria zaś usiadła i słuchała Jezusa. A sam Jezus stwierdził, że „obrała najlepszą część, której nie będzie pozbawiona” (Łk 10,42).

Jakże interesującą prawdę odkrywa dla nas Chrystus. W Jego nauczaniu chodzi o to, aby właściwie ustawić hierarchię życiowych wartości. Wartością zaś najważniejszą jest trwanie w bezpośredniej bliskości z Panem i wsłuchiwanie się w każde Jego słowo. Stąd zawsze powinno nam zależeć na tym, żeby nie uszło naszej uwagi nic z tego, co mówi do nas Jezus. Tak więc owo „krzątanie się Marty koło różnych posług” nie zostało potępione. Ale Zbawiciel uznał je za mniej ważne niż wsłuchiwanie się w Jego słowa, jak to czyniła Maria. I na tym polegała nie tylko „lepsz”, ale „najlepsza” częśćka, którą wybrała.

Taką postawę określa Pismo Święte mianem prawdziwej bojaźni Bożej. Chodzi o to, aby chrześcijanie zrozumieli, jaki jest właściwy sposób przyjęcia Jezusa nie tylko w swoim domu, ale w życiu, słuchając jak Maria, z uwagą i miłością, słów Jezusa. A słuchać znaczy również włączyć się konkretnie w służbę innym. Również wszelka aktywność i służba w Kościele musi rozpoczynać się od słuchania słowa Bożego i karmienia się Ciałem Pana. Są także dziś ludzie, którym zależy na wsłuchiowaniu się w głos Boga. W ciszy lepiej słyhać Boga. Inaczej będzie się tylko myśleć o sobie, jak to uczyniła Marta, która wyrzucała swojej siostrze pozostawienie jej samej.

#### **Qualified Charitable Distribution**

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
