Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! In the gospel this Sunday, Jesus makes some radical statements about discipleship. Being his follower involves more than just a casual relationship. In fact, Jesus affirms, believing in him means conforming our life to the cross and placing loyalty to him above everything and everyone else. The old and overworn expression about being “spiritual but not religious” does not seem to measure up to the uncompromising demands of the gospel. The adventure of faith in the company of the Word-made-flesh requires wisdom, discernment, discipline, and total commitment.

One of the unfortunate scenarios I encounter regularly in ministry is the number of people who lament the fact that their children and grandchildren do not bother with church or practice their Catholic faith as part of the believing community. Even though human weakness and scandal can be present wherever human beings are, belief in Jesus Christ cannot be separated from belief in the Body of Christ, the Church. When people think of “church,” they most often think of bricks, mortar, and institutions. The Church, however, is first the place where we encounter the grace of the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, in addition to sound teaching and a body of imperfect but sincere disciples who are trying to live according to the gospel. We do not journey to God alone but always in the company of others, especially the poor and marginalized whom we have consoled and helped along the way.

During the last week of August we celebrated two great saints especially dear to our new Augustinian Pope, Leo XIV: St. Monica and St. Augustine. St. Monica prayed for decades that her wandering son Augustine would discover the treasure of the Christian faith and be baptized into Christ and his Church. Augustine turned out well, to say the least. May we have that same prayerful perseverance as pick up our crosses each day and invite others to do the same.

Jezus Chrystus jasno formułuje w Ewangelii wymagania, które stawia wszystkim swoim uczniom, a nie tylko Dwunastu. To bardzo konkretny argument, byśmy dłużej nie odkładali na bliżej nieznaną przyszłość robienia porządku z tym, co jawnie stoi w naszym życiu w opozycji wobec wiary i Bożego wezwania. Spójrzmy więc pokrótce na przedstawione wymagania.



Pierwszym z nich jest gotowość do rezygnacji ze wszystkiego. „Nikt z was, kto nie wyrzeka się wszystkiego, co posiada, nie może być moim uczniem”. Te twarde i radykalne słowa Jezusa odnoszą się do wszystkich, którzy przez chrzest zostali włączeni do grona chrystusowych uczniów. Bóg po to daje nam rodziców – ojca i matkę – byśmy ich kochali. Po to daje życie, byśmy się nim cieszyli. Pragnie jedynie, abyśmy ponad to wszystko cenili sobie kontakt z Nim. Św. Paweł powie: „Dla Niego wyzułem się ze wszystkiego i uznaję to za śmieci, bylebym pozyskał Chrystusa”. Tak było w życiu św. Franciszka z Asyżu, który dosłownie przyjął wezwanie do pójścia za Chrystusem. Zostawił bogactwa swojego domu rodzinnego, a towarzyszką swojego życia uczynił „Panią Biedę”.

Drugi warunek to twórcze wykorzystanie życia. Każdy człowiek do czegoś dąży, chce coś w życiu osiągnąć, czegoś ważnego dokonać. Najczęściej tym dziełem jest wychowanie dzieci, zabezpieczenie warunków życia, budowanie kochającej się rodziny. Czasem ten wysiłek twórczy dotyczy dobra ojczyzny, innego człowieka, Kościoła.

„Czy nie traci Matka odwagi, widząc ogrom ubóstwa i zdając sobie sprawę, jak niewiele w rzeczywistości może zrobić?” – zapytał kiedyś założycielkę misjonarek miłości św. Teresę z Kalkuty pewien amerykański senator. „Bóg nie powołał mnie, bym odnosiła sukcesy, lecz bym Mu była wierna” – odpowiedziała zakonnica. Podobne pytanie zadał jej kiedyś jakiś dziennikarz: „Czy nie uważa Matka, że to, co robicie to kropla w morzu potrzeb? Tak – odparła – ale gdyby nie było kropli, nie byłoby oceanów”.

„Razem w nadziei” to temat **DOROCZNEJ ZBIÓRKI KATOLICKIEJ 2025**, powracającej po rocznej przerwie w całej diecezji. This policy will be reviewed and possibly change in the month of December. *Per the Diocese of Springfield, the suggested offering per Mass is \$15.*
