

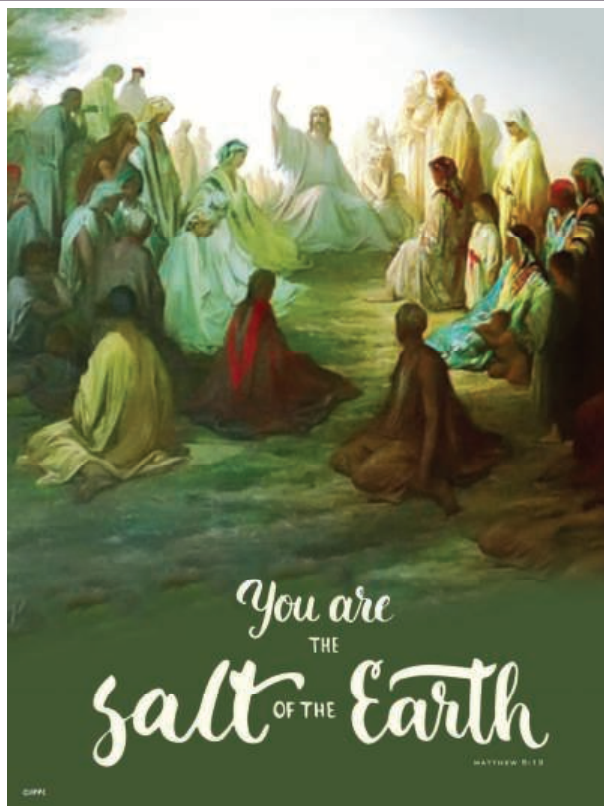

# BIULETYN Parafialny

Pan Jezus nie wzywa do tego, byśmy się stawali solą czy światłem, ale mówi, że nimi jesteśmy! 5. Niedziela Zwykła, rok A (Iz 58,7–10; 1 Kor 2,1–5; Mt 5,13–16)

Wy jesteście solą ziemi... Wy jesteście światłem świata (Mt 5,13.14). Pan Jezus uświadamia nam z jednej strony naszą wielką godność i znaczenie, z drugiej zaś ogromną odpowiedzialność za objawienie prawdziwości Jego posłania. Sól jest tą odrobiną, która nadaje potrawie smak, a światło czymś znikomym, co pozwala widzieć i rozpoznać prawdziwy kształt wszystkiego. Tak ma być właśnie z nami w świecie.



Zauważmy przy tym, że Pan Jezus nie wzywa do tego, byśmy się stawali solą czy światłem, ale mówi, że nimi jesteśmy! Czy chcemy, czy nie, jeżeli mienimy się chrześcijanami, tj. uczniami Chrystusa, jako światło jesteśmy przez ludzi odczytywani. I dlatego od nas zależy, czy orędzie Chrystusa, czy Ewangelia prawdziwie trafi do innych. Jest to niezwykła odpowiedzialność, jaką składa w nasze ręce Pan. To przecież sam Jezus przychodzi na świat jako jego światło. Takie orędzie usłyszeliśmy w tym tygodniu podczas święta Ofiarowania Pańskiego, czyli, jak je popularnie zwiemy, Matki Bożej Gromnicznej. Świeca jest symbolem małego Dziecka, które przyszło jako „światło na oświecenie pogan i chwałę ludu Bożego”. Dzisiaj słyszymy, że my sami jesteśmy światłem! Czyli mamy udział w posłannictwie samego Chrystusa.

Czym ma być nasze światło? W Ewangelii Pan Jezus mówi o tym jasno: Tak niech świeci wasze światło przed ludźmi, aby widzieli wasze dobre uczynki i chwalili Ojca waszego, który jest w niebie (Mt 5,16).

Myślę, że bardzo precyzyjnie wypowiedział to św. Jan w swoim liście: Kto twierdzi, że żyje w światłości, a nienawidzi brata swego, dotąd jeszcze jest w ciemności. Kto miłuje swego brata, ten trwa w światłości i nie może się potknąć. Kto zaś swojego brata nienawidzi, żyje w ciemności i działa w ciemności, i nie wie, dokąd dąży, ponieważ ciemności dotknęły ślepotą jego oczy (1 J 2,9–11).

Światłem jest autentyczna miłość obecna w naszym życiu. Jeżeli jej brak, nadal jesteśmy w ciemności (!), nawet gdybyśmy z uporem starali się siebie samych i wszystkich wkoło przekonywać, że żyjemy w świetle. W Ewangelii Pana Jezusa charakterystyczne jest to, że rozstrzygająca o prawdzie jest nie deklaracja, ale praktyka życia. Niestety, zbyt często mamy do czynienia z antyświadectwem, z zakłamaniem, polegającym na tym, że ludzie uważają się za chrześcijan, a swoim postępowaniem, brakiem miłosierdzia, przeczą Ewangelii. Takie postępowanie staje się przyczyną niewiary w Jezusa Chrystusa u innych. Można by przytoczyć wiele przykładów takiego antyświadectwa, ale może nie warto, bo każdy zna je z własnego doświadczenia.

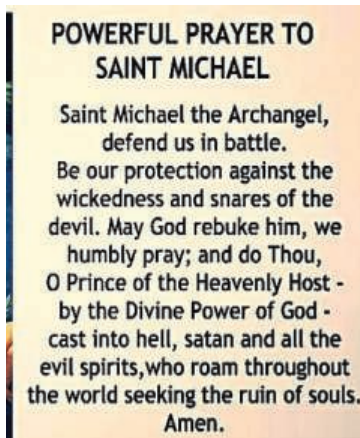

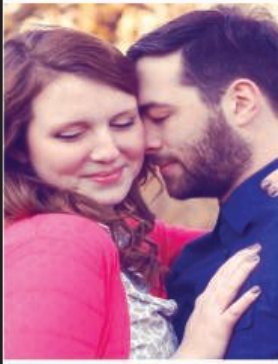
