

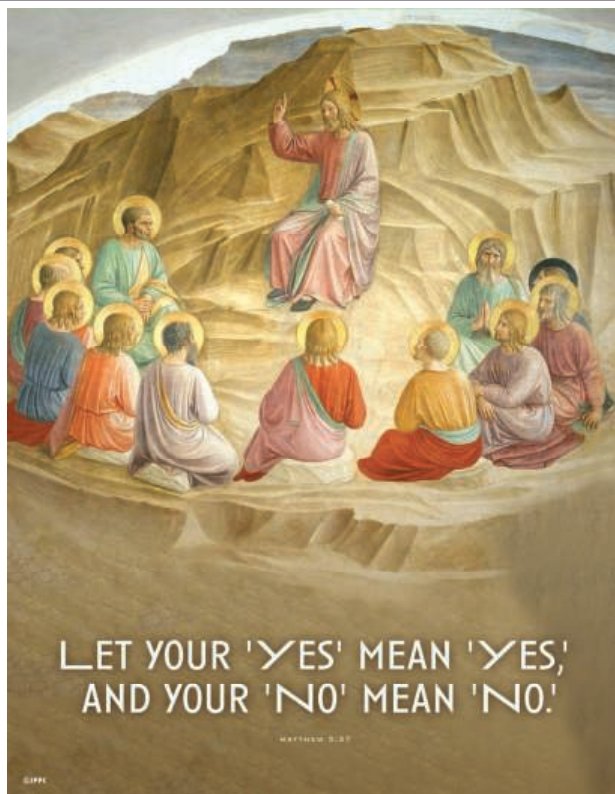

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! As I write these words, my family and I are accompanying my mom on her journey home to the Lord. I thank you for your prayers during this difficult time. My parents would celebrate 73 years of marriage this year. Mom's absence will be felt especially by my dad after so many years of married love and commitment. It's hard for my family to imagine one of them without the other.

This weekend is World Marriage Sunday. We Catholic Christians hold marriage between one man and one woman to be a sacrament, a living symbol of Christ's love for the Church. The teaching on the sacredness of marriage and the body is part of a rich tradition going all the way back to the goodness of creation in the Book of Genesis. God ratified that goodness once and for all by becoming flesh for us. Marriage is one of the institutions, however, that our culture and even our government seem bent on dismantling. I've heard many Catholics be enticed by cultural trends and repeat such empty phrases as "love is love." We would do better if we delved into the richness of our teaching and strove to live it rather than be content to repeat lawn sign slogans.

Many people accuse the Church of Jesus Christ as being obsessed with sex and the body, but as many commentators point out, perhaps it's modern culture that has the obsession. The simple truth is that we are not souls *or* bodies but souls *and* bodies, a unity separated temporarily only at death until the Second Coming when we will be glorified in Christ—soul and body. In the meantime, what we do with our bodies (and souls) matters and has eternal consequences, not to mention the ramifications for our lives on earth.

As Bishop Robert Barron recently pointed out, our doctrine on marriage and sexuality is not *against* anyone. It flows from a rich scriptural, philosophical, and theological tradition that has survived the trends and fads of many historical periods. We know that this teaching, made flesh and well-lived in the lives of ordinary Christians, often to heroic degree, leads to happiness and peace even in this life—but certainly in the life to come.

# BIULETYN Parafialny

W dzisiejszym fragmencie z Kazania na Górze Jezus interpretuje Prawo Boże w świetle przykazania miłości. „Słyszeliście, że powiedziano przodkom: «Nie zabijaj», a kto by się dopuścił zabójstwa, podlega sądowi. A Ja wam powiadam: Każdy, kto się gniewa na swego brata, podlega sądowi”. Kieruje więc nasz wzrok do środka, do naszego serca, które stanowi centrum życia. W ten sposób Syn Boży stawia swoim uczniom wymagania, które gwarantują wejścia do królestwa niebieskiego.

Piąte przykazanie Dekalogu należy do tych, z którymi – jak nam się często wydaje – nie mamy żadnych problemów. „Nikogo nie zabiłem”, ileż to razy daje się słyszeć podobne wyznanie w zwykłych rozmowach z tak zwanymi „porządnymi katolikami”, którzy w ten sposób próbują nadać wysoką rangę swojemu chrześcijaństwu. Czy to wystarczy? Otóż nie. Aby zachować przykazanie „Nie zabijaj” jest nam potrzebny najpierw zachwyt nad życiem, afirmacja tego jakże pięknego i podstawowego daru, powołania, które jest wspólne wszystkim ludziom. Z tego powołania czerpie każde inne! Jesteśmy powołani do tego, aby żyć, aby nasze życie przeżyć uczciwie, dojrzałe, aby je przeżyć w miłości, aby żyjąc – być ludźmi szczęśliwymi.

To niezwykle smutne, ilu młodych ludzi, mających po kilkanaście, czy dwadzieścia kilka lat jest znudzonych, zmęczonych życiem. Widać to nie tylko wtedy, gdy myślą o samobójstwie, co zdarza się wcale nierzadko, gdy popadają w nałogi. Widać to w tych sytuacjach, kiedy ludziom nie chce się niczego tworzyć, doskonalić, rozwijać, nie chce się przemieniać oblicza świata, w którym żyją. Życie w określonym stanie zakłada najpierw, że człowiek ceni sobie swoje życie, cieszy się swoim życiem, kocha swoje życie, jak w piosence Edyty Geppert: „Kocham cię życie / poznawać pragnę cię (...) w zachwyście”.

Dlatego tak bardzo musimy się starać i nawzajem sobie pomagać – w rodzinie, w szkole, w kościele, w gronie naszych bliskich – aby „wybierać życie”, by głosić pochwałę życia i to nie tylko pięknymi słowami, ale przede wszystkim własnym świadectwem dobrego życia, ubogaconego mądrością, uczciwością, przeżytego w wolności. Taki zachwyt nad życiem, spowoduje niewątpliwie pragnienie wzięcia odpowiedzialności za własne życie i za życie innych!
