Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Peace and all good things! I would like to share with you how moved my family was by the presence of so many parishioners and friends at the Memorial Mass for my mother on March 11th. The care and support you showed meant a lot to all of us and was a great consolation. In the days and weeks ahead, I hope to acknowledge your cards and gifts personally, but please know how grateful I am for your kindness. Serdeczne podziękowania dla Was wszystkich. Bóg zapłać!

This weekend we are treated to another nameless character in the Gospel of John: the man born blind. As I wrote last Sunday, this namelessness is an invitation to enter the gospel story with our name and discover how our depth of faith in Jesus measures up. The cured blind man moves from being someone who doesn't know how to find Jesus after his cure, to confessing faith in Jesus as a prophet, to the culmination of belief in the true identity of Jesus: "I do believe, Lord," and he worshiped him." Worship is due to God alone. Let the blind man's light shed light on your Lenten journey and help you to allow Jesus to be Lord of your life.

Finally, our Laetare Sunday celebration moves the Solemnity of St. Joseph to Monday, March 20th, this year. Many great saints had strong devotion to this silent saint of the sacred scriptures who showed Jesus the human face of fatherhood and is patron of the universal Church. St. Joseph, pray for us!

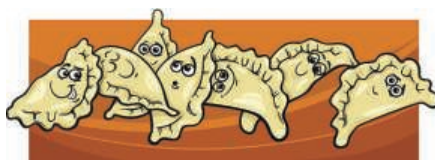

BIULETYN Parafialny



W pierwszych wiekach chrześcijaństwa Ewangelię o uzdrowieniu niewidomego czytano katechumenom przygotowującym się do chrztu udzielanego w Wigilię Paschalną. Miała ich ona pouczać, że w chrzcie otrzymają dar wiary, czyli dar widzenia więcej niż widzą oczy. Dla tych, którzy zostali ochrzczeni w wieku dziecięcym opis uzdrowienia niewidomego ma przypomnieć o otrzymanym wówczas darze wiary i przygotować do jej potwierdzenia podczas liturgii Wigilii Paschalnej.

Dar wiary, który otrzymaliśmy bez żadnych zasług z naszej strony, można również łatwo stracić, czego przykładem jest bł. o. Honorat Koźmiński (1829-1916). Wiare stracił w gimnazjum. Jako „apostoł ateuszostwa”, jak sam siebie nazwał, atakował i wyśmiewał wierzących. Do kościoła chodził tylko dla „obrazy Boskiej”, bluźnił, naśmiewał się z Jezusa ukrzyżowanego. Sam „żałował ludzkich łez wylanych nad Męką Pańską”, a w Wielki Piątek ostentacyjnie jadł kielbasę. W wieku 16 lat za rzekomy udział w spisku został osadzony przez władze carskie w ciężkim więzieniu na warszawskiej cytadeli. Niewinnie oskarżony, spędził w koszmarnej celi 11 miesięcy, gdzie nabawił się tyfusu i „wpadł w obłąkanie”. Matce, która modliła się za niego codziennie w kościele mówiono, że jej syn to wariat. Choć życie o. Honorata wisiało na włosku, przeżył i doznał nawrócenia. Tak pisał: „Jezus przyszedł do mnie w celi więziennej i łagodnie do wiary przyprowadził”. Założył 26 zgromadzeń zakonnych, z których do dziś istnieje 16. Pracował 19 godzin na dobę. Był męczennikiem konfesjonału, gorliwym kierownikiem duchowym i poruszającym serca kaznodzieją. A za największe szczęście uważał możliwość odprawiania Mszy Świętych.

Jako chrześcijanie jesteśmy wezwani do podejmowania refleksji nad treścią naszej wiary wyznawanej i celebrowanej przez Kościół. W ten sposób możemy odkrywać ją jako rzeczywistość nieograniczoną jedynie do jej przeżywania subiektywnego, lecz jako przeżywaną we wspólnocie i przekazywaną z pokolenia na pokolenie. Wiara stanowi więc dziedzictwo wszystkich wierzących, zawarte w bogatym nauczaniu, „jakie Kościół przyjął, zachował i przedstawiał na przestrzeni dwóch tysiącleci swej historii. Od Pisma Świętego po Ojców Kościoła, od mistrzów teologii po świętych, którzy żyli na przestrzeni wieków [...] Kościół medytował nad wiarą i rozwijał nauczanie, aby dać wiernym pewność w ich życiu wiary” (Benedykt XVI, List apostołski *Porta fidei*, 11).

Stanisława jak niegdyś powiedział do swoich uczniów: „**Jednej godziny nie mogliście czuwać ze Mną?**” Odpowiedzmy wezwaniu Pana. Dziś, w święto Świętego Józefa organizujemy grupę osób której celem będzie by Pan Jezus nie pozostawał sam na ołtarzu w czasie przeznaczonym na Adorację w pierwsze piątki miesiąca. Potrzebujemy osoby, rodziny, kogokolwiek kto może 1 godzinę w miesiącu spędzić z Panem Jezusem utajonym w Najświętszym Sakramencie. Zauważyliśmy że najczęściej brakuje nawet jednej osoby przed Najświętszym Sakramentem w godz. 1:30 PM do 6:30 PM. Jeżeli możesz/ możecie ofiarować Panu Jezusowi 1 godzinę raz w miesiącu przed Najświętszym Sakramentem, prosimy o skontaktowanie się z biurem parafialnym. Mamy osobę która zgodziła się by koordynować grafik na wypadek gdy wyznaczony Wam czas będzie musiał być zmieniony.

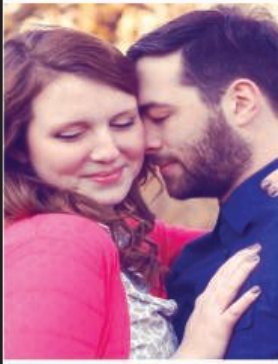
