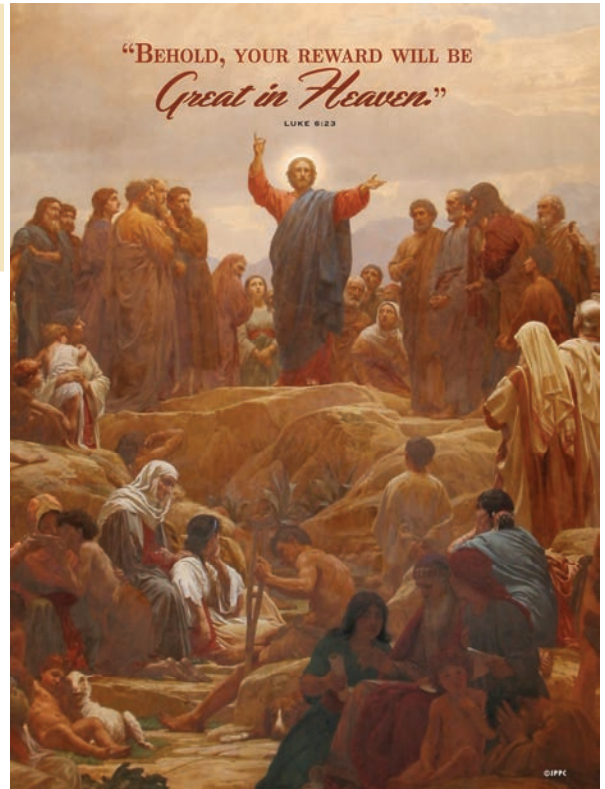

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This Sunday marks the celebration of World Marriage Day, a time “to focus on building a culture of life and love that begins with supporting and promoting marriage and the family” (<https://www.usccb.org>). Although we hear sayings like “love is love,” even from our fellow believers, all love is not the same in its human expression or moral evaluation.

All genuine love ultimately has its source in the God Who is Love. The love of friendship, family members toward each other, and charity toward our neighbor reflect divine love. But marital love between a man and woman is of a different order, and we hold Christian marriage to a distinct and high ideal: Husbands and wives love each other in a way that reflects the persevering, permanent, and self-sacrificing love of Christ for the Church. Christian spousal love is the only union that physically bears fruit in children and provides a sacred environment in which they can grow and flourish. Marriage and family life at their best reflect the dynamic and fruitful love of the Triune God, the heart of our faith.

We know that many marriages fall short of this ideal, sometimes even tragically so, but this should make the ideal all the more desirable. Married love is such that it can only be rooted in and nourished by supernatural, sacramental grace.

If your marriage needs healing, why not reach out for help this week? If you know married couples who are struggling, offer a listening ear and some of your time, wisdom, and prayer. As you think of married couples who do reflect this Christian ideal, thank God for them...and thank them too for saying yes to the gift of grace.

# BIULETYN Parafialny

13 LUTEGO - VI NIEDZIELA

Lord Irwin, były wicekról Indii z ramienia Anglii, po powrocie z Konferencji Okrągłego Stołu w Londynie odwiedził Mahatmę Gandhiego, późniejszego, wybitnego przywódcę narodu hinduskiego. W czasie spotkania Irwin zadał Gandhiemu pytanie: „Mahatma powiedz mi, jako mężczyzna mężczyźnie, jakie widzisz rozwiązanie problemów mojego i twojego kraju?” W odpowiedzi, Gandhi powoli i z uwagą sięgnął po książkę leżącą na stoliku. Była to Ewangelia wg Mateusza, otworzył ją na 5 rozdziale i powiedział: „Kiedy twój kraj i mój razem wprowadzą w życie naukę Chrystusa z Góry Błogosławieństw, rozwiążemy nie tylko problemy naszych krajów, ale całego świata.” Słowa te wypowiedział człowiek, który nie był chrześcijaninem.



Przed laty kręcono film „Quo Vadis”, w którym grała Deborah Kerr. Po nakręceniu groźnej sceny z lwami na arenie cyrkowej, jeden z reporterów zapytał ją: „Nie bałaś się gdy na arenie cyrkowej lew zmierzał w twoim kierunku?” Deborah odpowiedziała: „Absolutnie nie. Czytałam scenariusz i wiedziałam, że będę uratowana”. Dla każdego z nas Bóg napisał scenariusz zbawienia. Trzeba się z nim zapoznać i uwierzyć, wtedy będziemy mieć pewność, że nic nam nie grozi. Będziemy mieli siłę do odważnego przeciwstawiania się różnym przeciwnościom życiowym oraz odwagę pójścia za bożym wezwaniem, nawet gdy one są tak wzniosłe i wymagające jak ewangeliczne błogosławieństwa. Z objawień siostry Faustyny wiemy, że wielu rezygnuje z drogi bożych przykazań, drogi błogosławieństw. W jej „Dzienniczku” czytamy: „W pewnym dniu ujrzałam dwie drogi: jedna droga szeroka, wysypana piaskiem i kwiatami, pełna radości i muzyki, i różnych przyjemności. Ludzie szli tą drogą, tańcząc i bawiąc się – dochodzili do końca, nie spostrzegając, że to już koniec. Ale na końcu tej drogi była straszna przepaść, czyli otchłań piekielna. Dusze te na oślep wpadały w tę przepaść; jak szły, tak i wpadały. A była ich tak wielka liczba, że nie można było ich zliczyć. I widziałam drugą drogę, a raczej ścieżkę, bo była wąska i zasłana cierniami i kamieniami, a ludzie, którzy nią szli, mieli łzy w oczach i różne bóle były ich udziałem. Jedni padali na te kamienie, ale zaraz powstawali i szli dalej. A w końcu drogi był wspaniały ogród, przepełniony wszelkim rodzajem szczęścia i wchodziły tam te wszystkie dusze. Zaraz w pierwszym momencie zapominały o swych cierpieniach”.

Ewangelia na dzisiejszą niedzielę, wzywając nas do kroczenia drogą błogosławieństw przewraca niejako do góry nogami nasze życie w perspektywie władzy, bogactwa, radości, spełnienia. Kazanie Jezusa na Górze Błogosławieństw ukazuje nowe wartości, nową wizję życia, gdzie możemy odnaleźć pełne i wieczne szczęście. Szczęśliwy, to znaczy błogosławiony. Błogosławieństwo zaczyna się na ziemi, a pełnię osiąga w wieczności. Ewangeliczne błogosławieństwa wbrew pozorom nie przeszkadzają, wręcz przeciwnie pomagają w odnajdywaniu szczęścia także w wymiarze doczesnym.

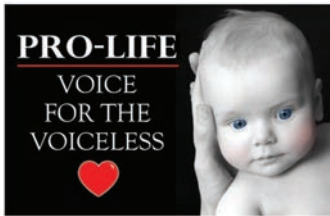

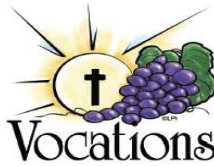
