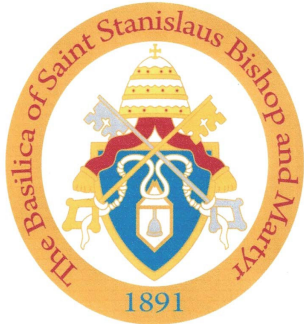

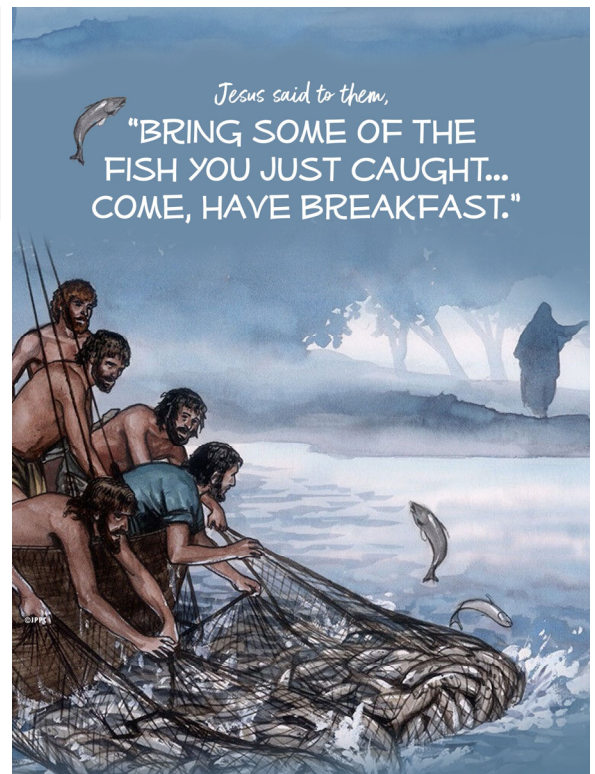

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things! This Third Sunday of Easter coincides with the very first day of May, a month in which we recall the special devotion we have for Mary, the Mother of God. The Franciscan tradition itself contains a “golden thread” of devotion to our Blessed Mother that has been so significant in forming the holy men and women of our Franciscan family, from the time of St. Francis of Assisi all the way to more contemporary saints like St. Maximilian Mary Kolbe.



Among the relatively few writings of St. Francis that we possess are two prayers to Mary in which he addresses the Mother of God as “Virgin made Church” and “Spouse of the Holy Spirit.” Our Lady’s special role in our salvation comes from her intimate relationship with the Trinity and her motherly care for us who are members of the Body of Christ, the Church.

In this month of May, set aside time to renew your devotion to Mary by praying the rosary or other prayers that immerse us in the mysteries of our faith and help us to know her motherly care, to which we were entrusted by Jesus on the cross (John 19:27). Pick up Fr. Michael Gaitley’s *33 Days to Morning Glory* (Stockbridge: Marian Press) and embark on the adventure of Marian consecration.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us and for our world!

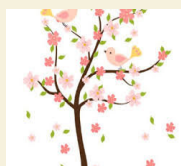

# BIULETYN Parafialny

1 MAJA 2022

## 3 NIEDZIELA WIELKANOCNA

Pięcioletnia Kasandra uczestniczyła z rodzicami w Wielki Piątek w drodze krzyżowej, liturgii Wielkiego Piątku, jak i w wieczornej adoracji przy ołtarzu grobu Pańskiego. Zadawała w tym czasie dziesiątki pytań odnośnie śmierci i zmartwychwstania Jezusa. Trzeba mieć anielską cierpliwość i sporą wiedzę religijną, aby odpowiedzieć na jej wszystkie pytania. W drodze powrotnej do domu, gdy mijali cmentarz mała Kasandra niespodziewanie powiedziała: „Tak bardzo bym chciała, aby mój dziadzio zmartwychwstał chociaż jeden raz”. Wyobrażała sobie, że Jezus zmartwychwstaje każdego roku na Wielkanoc i jakby było wspaniale, gdy dziadzio mógł to zrobić chociaż jeden raz. Dla małej dziewczynki zmartwychwstanie Jezusa było tak oczywiste jak obecność przy niej rodziców. Zapewne Chrystus wymagał takiej wiary, gdy mówił do uczniów, że powinni stać się podobni do dzieci, aby wejść do Królestwa Niebieskiego. Kasandra nie potrafiła jeszcze kojarzyć zmartwychwstania Jezusa z naszym zmartwychwstaniem. Ale i do takiej wiary dorosnąć, bo gdy wierzymy, że Chrystus zmartwychwstał, to jakby naturalną konsekwencją jest wiara w nasze zmartwychwstanie. Do takiej wiary powinniśmy ciągle dorastać i podejmować trud jej zgłębiania.



Poranek wielkanocny zapoczątkował dla uczniów Jezusa jeden z najpiękniejszych rozdziałów w ich życiu. Był to czas budzenia się i spełniania najradośniejszej nadziei, którą przynosił zmartwychwstały Chrystus. Przed trzema laty apostołowie porzucili wszystko i poszli za Nim. Jednak śmierć ich Mistrza przekreśliła pokładane w Nim nadzieje. Został zawód i rozpacz. Do pogrążonych w smutku uczniów docierają wieści o pustym grobie, o tym, że niektórzy z nich widzieli żywego Jezusa. One to sprawiały, że radosna nadzieja rodziła się nawet w tych, którzy nie dowierzali zasłyszonym pogłoskom. Może rzeczywiście Chrystus zmartwychwstał. W radosnym uniesieniu czekali nowych znaków, które potwierdziłyby to niewiarygodne wydarzenie. Czekanie nie było daremne. Jezus ukazuje się wiele razy, w Ewangelii, którą zacytowałem na wstępie czytamy: „Jezus ukazał się znowu nad Morzem Tyberiadzkim”.

**20TH ANNUAL DIOCESAN-WIDE EUCHARISTIC ROSARY PROCESSION** will take place on Pentecost Sunday, June 5, 2022, from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. (Rain or Shine) starting at St. Elizabeth Seton Parish Church, 99 King St. Northampton, MA. The guest speaker will be Rev. Jonathan Reardon – “The Transforming Power of the Eucharist” and Confessions will be available. The Rosary Procession will go through downtown Northampton (1.8 miles) with transportation available for those who are unable to walk in the procession. 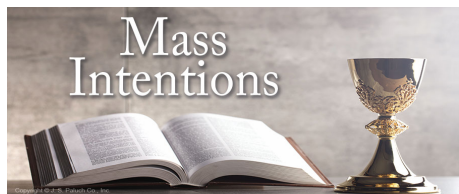
