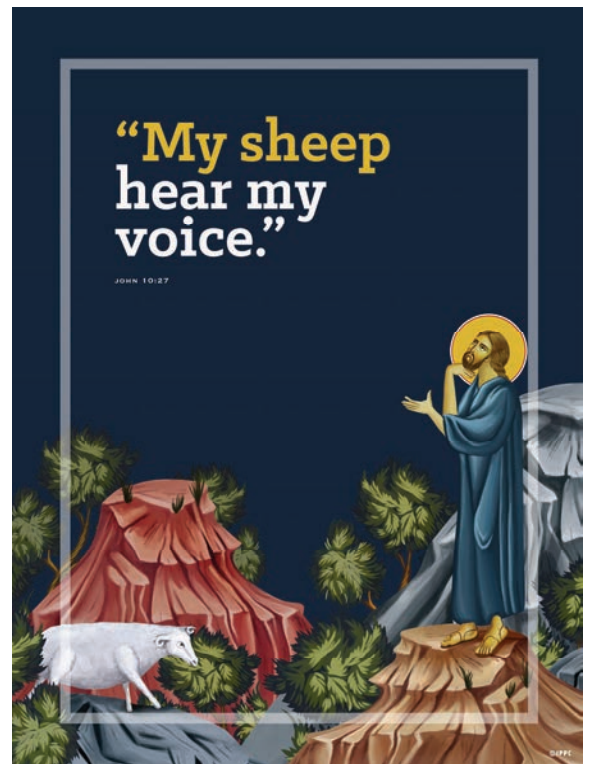

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things! Yesterday we celebrated the First Holy Communion of around thirty boys and girls from St. Stanislaus School and our religious education program. As I saw them being formed in their faith and growing more and more excited about this moment of union with Jesus, I often wondered to myself if I would ever see some of them as a Franciscan friar, priest, or religious sister. Who knows what the Lord has in store for each of them and their families?

This Fourth Sunday of Easter, also called Good Shepherd Sunday because of the gospel passages we hear every year, is also World Day of Prayer for Vocations. It's an appropriate time to ask ourselves what each of us is doing to help young men and women hear the call of God in their lives? Do we pray together as a family? Do we speak about vocations to the priesthood, consecrated life, and the permanent diaconate to those in whom we have seen signs of a vocation? Are vocations one of my intentions in my daily prayer?

As a Franciscan friar-priest who has spent a number of years in helping to form future friars, I can testify that many of those vocations were born when someone asked them a question like the following: "Hey, did you ever think about becoming a friar?" When in doubt, ask.

Please pray and sacrifice for vocations especially this Sunday and encourage the young men and women you know to hear and listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd.

IV NIEDZIELA WIELKANOCNA

Jezus powiedział: „Moje owce słuchają mojego głosu, a Ja znam je. Idą one za Mną i daję im życie wieczne. Nie zginą one na wieki i nikt nie wyrwie ich z mojej ręki. Ojciec mój, który mi je dał, jest większy od wszystkich. I nikt nie może ich wyrwać z ręki mego Ojca. Ja i Ojciec jedno jesteśmy” (J 10, 27-30).

Przed laty wchodził na ekrany film pt. „Laura”. Cieszył się on dużą popularnością. Film jest o młodym detektywie, który miał wyjaśnić sprawę zabójstwa młodej, ładnej dziewczyny imieniem Laura. Pewnej nocy ktoś zastukał do drzwi. Laura otworzyła je, a wtedy zabójca wymierzył pistolet prosto w twarz i strzelił, zabijając ją na miejscu. Detektyw kilka następnych dni spędził w mieszkaniu Laury. Sprawdzał wszystko co posiadała; ubrania, książki, nagrania, albumy, fotografie. Czytał jej listy i pamiętnik, mając nadzieję, że to naprowadzi go na ślad zabójcy. Po pewnym czasie detektyw zauważył, że rodzi się w nim dziwne uczucie. Coraz bardziej czuł się związany z Laurą. Przyznał się przed samym sobą, że się zakochał. I to w kim? W zmarłej dziewczynie.



W 2013 roku, w Stanach Zjednoczonych głośna była nie wyjaśniona sprawa śmierci 7-miesięcznego Lucasa, który był pod opieką niani i jej chłopaka. W tragicznej sytuacji Heather, matka chłopca zdecydował się na heroiczny czyn. Postanowiła oddać narządy syna dla innych potrzebujących dzieci. Serce Lucasa otrzymała Jordan Drake, która urodziła się z wadą serca. Większość swego życia spędziła w szpitalu dziecięcym w Phoenix. Wszystko się odmieniło w jej życiu 22 czerwca 2013 roku, kiedy to potrzyzymała nowe serce – serce Lukasa. Prawo amerykańskie gwarantuje przez określony czas anonimowość dawcy i biorcy organu. Matka Lucasa pragnęła dowiedzieć się w kim żyje serce jej synka. Rozpoczęła poszukiwania przez Facebook. I udało się. Po prawie 3 latach matka Lukasa i matka Jordan postanowiły się spotkać. Heather Clark usłyszała wtedy bijące serce swego synka, w klatce piersiowej 4-letniej dziewczynki. Dla wszystkich było to niesamowite przeżycie. Matka Jordan powiedziała: „To co się wydarzyło jest trudne do opisanie. Rodzina Lucasa pogrążona w smutku i żałobie okazała ogromną i bezinteresowną miłość innej rodzinie. Jesteśmy teraz rodziną. Jesteśmy przyjaciółmi”. Heather płakała słuchając bicia serca swojego synka. Płakała także matka Jordan, mówiąc, że nie potrafi wyrazić słowami swojej wdzięczności, może tylko serdecznie uściskać tę kobietę. Po czym dodała: „Mam zamiar powiedzieć córce, że Lucas uratował jej życie. Jest to wzruszająca historia o ogromnym darze i poświęceniu matki i jej synka. Lukas ofiarował mojej córeczce życie i wierzę, że z życzliwością patrzy na nią i chce, aby jak najpiękniej i najpełniej wykorzystała dar życia”. Heather powiedziała, że nigdy nie zapomni chwili, gdy usłyszała po raz pierwszy bicie serca Lukasa w małym ciele Jordan. Powiedział między innymi: „Słuchając mocnego bicia serca nie mam wątpliwości, że mój synek, żyje w rytmie tego serca”. Nagrano także bicie serca Lukasa umieszczono wewnątrz pluszaka, by Heather mogła go słuchać, kiedy zechce. Na swojej stronie na Facebooku Heather Clark napisała: „Znów będę mogła trzymać w ramionach Lukasa, słuchać bicia jego serca”. Obie matki zamierzają spotykać się regularnie.

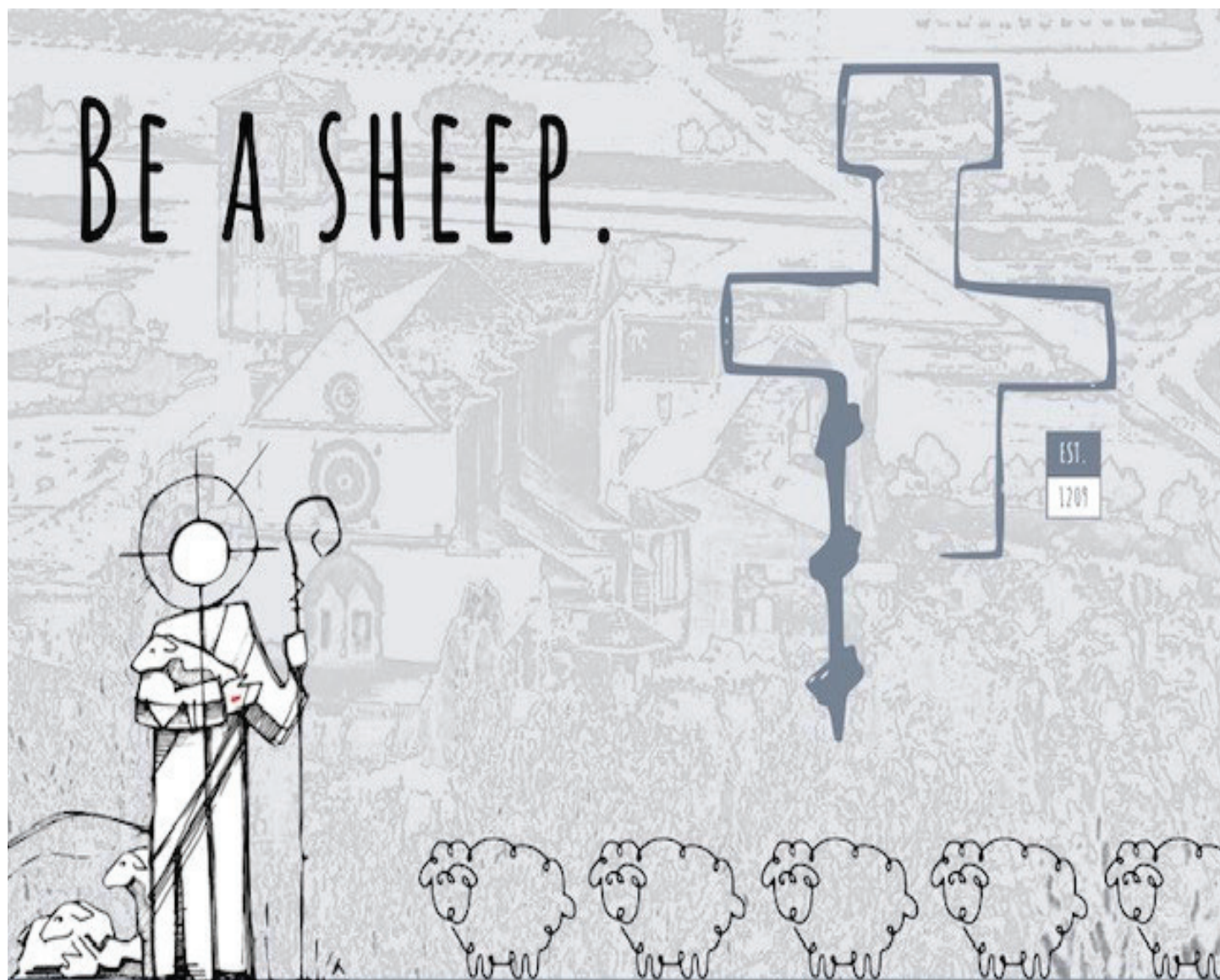

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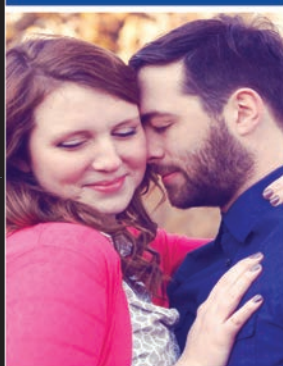
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
