

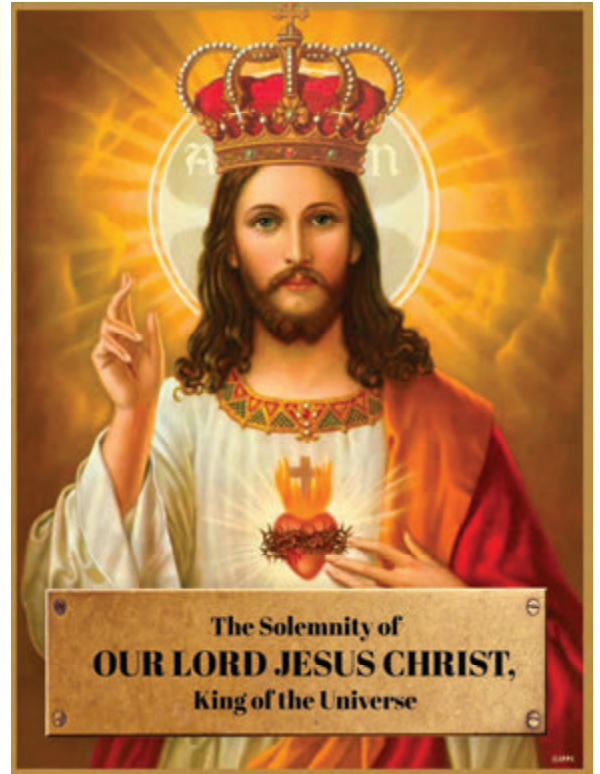

BIULETYN Parafialny

W klasztorze św. Katarzyny na górze Synaj znajduje się pochodząca z VI w. po Chr. ikona Chrystusa Pantokratora, czyli Pana wszystkiego, Sędziego Wszechświata. W postaci Chrystusa zostało wyeksponowane oblicze: żywe i naturalne. Jednak najbardziej znaczącym elementem twarzy są oczy. Zdają się pełne zadumy, miłości i miłosierdzia. Emanują pokojem i jednocześnie budują w wiernym przekonanie, że dla Boga nigdy nie jest się kimś anonimowym. Jezus na ikonie prawą ręką błogosławi, a lewą przytrzymuje zamkniętą księgę. Chrystus, który zasiada na tronie, jest otoczony światłem, jasnością i chwałą Boga. Obok Jego tronu stoją „owce” i „kozły”, czyli ludzie, którzy za życia żyli miłością i ci, dla których brak miłości stał się życiową normą.



Nie wystarczą zatem słowa, choćby nawet brzmiące najpiękniej. Chrystusowi chodzi o konkretne uczynki, a przede wszystkim o dostrzeganie człowieka potrzebującego. Emerytowany papież Benedykt zauważa, iż „miłość bliźniego jest drogą do spotkania również Boga, a zamykanie oczu na bliźniego czyni człowieka ślepym również na Boga” (DCE 16). Uroczystość Chrystusa Króla Wszechświata, która kończy rok liturgiczny, uświadamia nam, że istotą królestwa Bożego jest miłość. Jezus Chrystusa przyszedł na ziemię, aby objawić nam miłość Ojca. W tym planie miłości każdy człowiek ma swoje wyjątkowe i niezastąpione miejsce, jako oryginał. Niestety, wielu czyni tak, że pod koniec swojego ziemskiego życia wygląda jak marna kopia. Powód? Brak życia miłością na co dzień. Tylko miłość jest twórcza i wyzwala w nas to, co najlepsze, najszlachetniejsze.

REMEMBER OUR VETERANS

St. Stanislaus Cemetery is proud to announce that it has joined in the city-wide effort to remember over 7,500 Veterans at rest in Chicopee cemeteries through participation in Wreaths Across America. St. Stanislaus Cemetery is the resting place for 2758 Veterans, more than at any other Chicopee cemetery. To volunteer or sponsor a wreath online, go to: <https://www.wreathsacrossamerica.org/pages/174358>. Once on the St Stanislaus Cemetery Page (MASTST) scroll down to find "Basilica of St. Stanislaus" and click the red "Sponsor" block to sponsor as many wreaths as you desire. You can also send a check payable to "Wreaths Across America" to the St. Stanislaus Parish Office, 40 Cyman Drive,

Chicopee, MA 01013. Each wreath sponsorship is accomplished through a \$15 donation. Wreaths will be placed at the cemetery on National Wreaths Across America Day, Saturday, December 17, 2022. The opening ceremony will start promptly at noon followed by the placing of wreaths.

Each year, millions of Americans come together to REMEMBER the fallen, HONOR those that serve and their families, and TEACH the next generation about the value of freedom. This gathering of volunteers and patriots takes place in local and national cemeteries in all 50 states - most recently at more than 3,100 participating locations - as part of National Wreaths Across America Day. Locally, Wreaths Across America has been celebrated at the Agawam Veterans Cemetery since 2007

In 2021, more than 2.4 million veterans' wreaths were placed by volunteers on headstones at 3,137 participating locations around the country in honor of the service and sacrifices made for our freedoms, with each name said out loud. Wreaths Across America volunteers work year-round to ensure military laid to rest are remembered, their families and living veterans are honored, and the next generation is taught about the value of freedom.

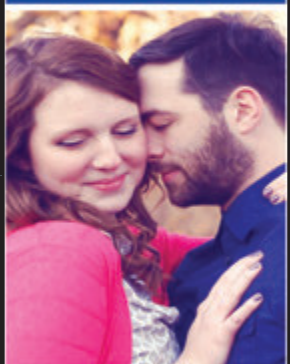
