Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

One of my favorite questions to ask those beginning their study of the Gospel of John is as follows: "What is the name of Jesus' mother according to this gospel?" As if I were asking the obvious, they immediately respond, "Mary, of course." Rather than ask them to find the chapter and verse, I respond: "Wrong." Now "Mary" is certainly the name of Jesus' mother, but the Gospel of John identifies her simply as "the mother of Jesus" and never specifically by name. This may strike us as strange until we delve deeper into this beautiful and rich Fourth Gospel.

Major characters in John's gospel are not called by name: the mother of Jesus, the beloved disciple, and today's nameless Samaritan woman. Have you ever wondered why? It seems the evangelist is leaving them nameless because he wants the hearer of the gospel to identify with the character and share his or her response of faith. In other words, the Samaritan woman represents all of us who have come to believe in Jesus.

We are challenged in today's gospel passage to allow Jesus to meet us where we are, question us more deeply, instruct us on the true meaning of our lives, invite us to repentance, pour into us his living water, and then be missionaries to others. The Samaritan woman moved from skepticism to curiosity to fullness of faith, and then she spread the news to her townspeople. Let's allow our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to do the same thing in us this Lent.

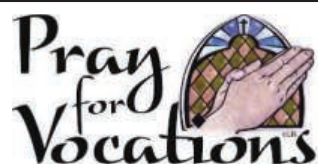

BIULETYN Parafialny

Każdy z nas, choć w różnym stopniu, doświadczył, co znaczy brak wody i co znaczy ugasić pragnienie. A cóż dopiero powiedzieć o ludziach, którzy w zarówno w przeszłości, jak i dziś w wielu regionach świata, umierają z pragnienia, bo brakuje im wody?

Pragnienie i woda, która je zaspokaja: dwie rzeczywistości, tak dobrze nam znane z życia codziennego, są w centrum ewangelicznej rozmowy Jezusa z Samarytanką przy Studni Jakuba niedaleko Sychem. Kobieta z Samarii wiedziała o wrogości w relacjach pomiędzy Samarytanami a Żydami. Dlatego zdziwiła się, że Jezus, będąc Żydem, prosi ją, by dała Mu się napić. Z rozmowy dowiadujemy się, że miała pięciu mężów, a ten, z którym przebywała aktualnie, nie był jej mężem. Można więc mówić o życiu skomplikowanym, pełnym trudnych sytuacji i rozstań, choć nie znamy jego szczegółów. Ale Samarytanką była też kobietą religijnie poszukującą, dostrzegającą różnice między wiarą żydowską i samarytańską. Wiedziała, że kiedyś przyjdzie Mesjasz, który objawi wszystko, co do tej pory pozostawało tajemnicą.



W rozmowie Jezusa z Samarytanką woda jest jednak dla Zbawiciela jedynie obrazem do ukazania wartości głębszych, duchowych, nieprzemijających i ważnych dla wszystkich, żyjących w jakimkolwiek czasie i miejscu; Samarytanką pozostaje natomiast przy dosłownym znaczeniu wody. Rozmowa zatem toczy się na dwóch poziomach. Jezus prosi: „Daj Mi pić!” rozpoczyna niezwykły dialog i ukazuje nam, że Bóg jako pierwszy wykazuje inicjatywę w kontakcie z człowiekiem. To On wciąż zaprasza do nawiązania bliższej relacji nawet osoby już zaawansowane w życiu duchowym. Wobec Boga zawsze pozostajemy słabi i potrzebujący Jego wody żywej, to jest ożywiającej łaski Ducha Świętego.

Samarytanką, choć powoli, jednak odkrywa niezwykłość spotkanego Człowieka: nie prosi Go o jakieś szczególne dary, choć z pewnością nie brakowało jej różnych kłopotów i zmartwień. Jej jedyną prośbę stanowią słowa: „Daj mi tej wody, abym już nie pragnęła i nie przychodziła tu czerpać”. Chciała się po prostu uwolnić od fizycznego trudu związanego z czerpaniem i noszeniem wody.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! In 1902 the first five Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph arrived in Chicopee to begin their teaching ministry at St. Stanislaus School. This congregation had been founded only five years earlier in Trenton, New Jersey, through the courageous vision of Sr. Colette Hilbert, FSSJ, in collaboration with Fr. Hyacinth Fudzinski, OFM Conv. For over 120 years, the Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph have faithfully served St. Stanislaus Parish and School here in Chicopee.

Regretfully I must announce the official retirement of both Sr. Ceil Haier as administrator of St. Stanislaus School and Sr. M. Andrea Ciszewski as Coordinator of Religious Education, effective June 30, 2023. Both Sr. Ceil and Sr. Andrea will take up residence in the motherhouse in Hamburg, New York, during the summer. Sr. Andrea will continue to fulfill her responsibilities as General Councilor of the Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph while Sr. Ceil takes a much-deserved time for sabbatical.

Effective June 30, 2023, Mrs. Karen Shea will also be retiring as administrator of St. Stanislaus School. Mrs. Shea has dedicated endless energy, time, and talent for the students of St. Stanislaus School for over three decades. The consolation, however, is that because Karen has been a lifelong parishioner of St. Stanislaus Parish, we will still enjoy her presence and participation in parish life after her retirement from administration of our school.

It is impossible to put into words our gratitude for the long and faithful service of these three women to St. Stanislaus Parish and School and the many years of their lives they have given to the people of Chicopee and the Diocese of Springfield. A proper and fitting appreciation event is being planned for Saturday, June 17th. Details will be published via the bulletin and social media. Please continue to keep Sr. Andrea, Sr. Ceil, and Karen in your prayers as they enter this time of transition.

The parish will begin a search for school administrators (see related letter) and a coordinator of religious education. I continue to trust in the providence and care of our merciful God to provide for the Basilica of St. Stanislaus as we move forward in faith.

Dear Parents, Faculty, Staff, and School Board Members:

Peace and all good! This letter comes to you as an accompaniment to the official announcement of the retirement of both Sr. Ceil Haier, FSSJ, and Mrs. Karen Shea from St. Stanislaus School, effective June 30, 2023. No words can adequately summarize the decades of dedication, experience, and love for our school that each of them has brought to the education and welfare of our students. The months ahead will provide opportunities for all of us to express our gratitude to Sr. Ceil and Mrs. Shea for their untiring service.

As we prepare to undertake this transition to new leadership, I am also aware that the Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph are not able to provide a successor to Sr. Ceil. This necessitates the establishment of a search committee and the dedicated work of the school board to undergo a comprehensive process aimed at identifying a successor not only for Sr. Ceil but also for Mrs. Shea. The size and needs of our school are best served by a leadership team as we continue to move forward.

The Catholic and Franciscan character and mission of St. Stanislaus School are of utmost importance to all of us, as well as a smooth transition for the start of the 2023-24 school year. To this end we have engaged the expertise of Dr. Daniel Baillargeon, former Superintendent of Catholic Schools for the Diocese of Springfield, and now President of Mission Driven Catholic, a consulting firm which helps Catholic schools to excel in their mission. Mission Driven Catholic is assisting in multiple leadership searches around the country at this time. Dr. Baillargeon knows our school very well through his previous work in the Diocese and is currently engaged with the school board in its strategic planning process. He will be present at the March 15th meeting of the school board to outline next steps and ensure an efficient search process.

I ask your prayerful support as we renew our trust in God's faithfulness. I am confident the Lord will watch over this process and bring it to a successful conclusion.

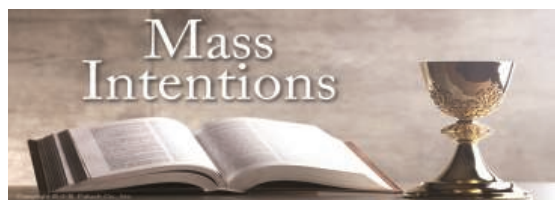

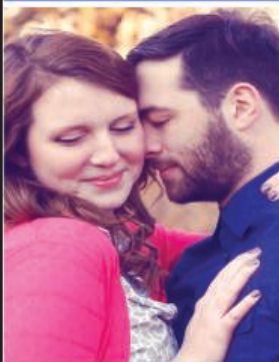

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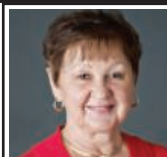
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
