Sessions will allow the faithful to voice concerns, offer observations, and ask questions of the Bishop and Diocesan Officials.

Sunday Feb. 10 at St. Joseph Church, Pittsfield 6:00-7:30 P.M.

Monday March 18 at St. Mary Church, Westfield, 7-8:30 P.M.

Sunday March 24 at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish Hall, Northampton 6:3-7:30 P.M.

Also at the Bishop's request, the **first Monday of Lent March 11** all churches, including **our Upper Basilica will be open all day, and we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for a "Day of Prayer for Healing & Reconciliation."** Thus, on **Monday March 11 our 6:30 A.M. and 12:00 Noon Masses will be in the Upper Basilica.**

On Sunday April 7 at 2:00 P.M. there will be a Prayer Service for Healing at St. Michael Cathedral in Springfield (another same time at St. Joseph, Pittsfield).
