



Re-opening St. Stanislaus Basilica

**All Services/Sacraments
St. Stanislaus Basilica
Will be celebrated in the
UPPER BASILICA ONLY!**

Saturday May 23 5:00 P.M. Vigil Mass
Sunday May 24 7:00 A.M., 9:00A.M. (Polish), and 11:00 A.M.

- Outside Doors to be left open for entry/exit and fresh air.
- Use Social Distancing in parking lot, entering Basilica, etc.
- **Use HAND SANITIZER when entering/leaving Basilica**
- Masks required for all (except medical exemptions/small children 2-5)
- Priest/Deacon/Lector/Organist/SD Leader and Cantor: No need for masks while away at least 6' or more from others.
- Center Pews will be marked for seating in every other pew.
- Family members who live together, may sit together.
- Otherwise, Social Distancing of 6' required.
- Floors/aisles will be marked for 6' Social Distancing.
- NO HYMNALS, books, missalettes, etc.
- Nothing on bulletin boards!
- Bulletins ON LINE only.
- No Altar Servers or CHOIR at the this time.
- No Holy Water, Sign of Peace, or reception of the Precious Blood
- NO Entrance or Exit Procession
- USHERS in masks, WILL TAKE COLLECTION(S) with the long-handled baskets, returning collection to Sacristy as usual.

- For HOLY COMMUNION:
- FOLLOW DIRECTION OF Priest Presider and USHERS...
- **HOLY EUCHARIST will be distributed IN THE HAND ONLY!**
- **No Exceptions, hand only, for health safety**
- Remove your mask briefly to receive Holy Communion, then replace mask.
- Two stations up front:
- **Center Benches FIRST** leave pew and walk close to the pew towards front, 6' spacing. One bench at a time, 6' spacing, two stations up front, return by side aisles.
- Two stations at the center break: one pew at a time, move towards the Ministers, return by side aisles.

- Side Window Benches, after Center Section is complete:
- Side Window Seats at the front, move forward, one pew at a time towards Communion Station up front on your side of the Basilica. Return by Center aisle observing 6' distancing.
- Side benches by windows towards the rear of Basilica, move straight forward towards Minister who will have moved to the side aisle for you to receive. Return by Center aisle observing 6' distancing.
- After the final blessing, the Presider will direct the people leaving, by area/bench. Please no crowds moving at once!
- No social gatherings in vestibule, on steps, or outside.

Upper Basilica on both extreme sides of the Sanctuary:

1. Baptistery / Friary Side
2. Sacred Heart / Chicopee Falls Side

Chairs only facing opposite way for anonymity for those who so desire. ALL MUST continue Social Distancing 6' while awaiting Confession. Sit on the Adoration/ Chicopee Falls side while waiting

Reposition of the Eucharist 11:50
12:00 Noon Mass

FOR WEEKDAY MASSES sit only on the Chicopee (Friary) side of Basilica)

Adoration: Please sit only on the Chicopee Falls/Sacred Heart side to allow for Disinfecting after Mass.

The Following weekend Saturday May 30: Confessions at 4:00-4:50 P.M. up front both niches on the extreme sides of Sanctuary.
