Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! This Monday our country honors the birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr., the prophetic voice of non-violent protest against prejudice and racism. It is a fitting time for us as Catholic Christians to reflect on an issue which still divides our nation. Over twenty years ago, Pope St. John Paul II preached these words in a Sunday Angelus message:

Racism is a sin that constitutes a serious offence against God... There is need for a vast work of education to the values that exalt the dignity of the human person and safeguard his fundamental rights. When I observe children in our own school and the ease with which they study and play together, I am reminded that prejudice is learned—and therefore can be unlearned. May each of us unlearn what we need to and allow Jesus to transform our hearts so that this world becomes a place where all may live together in peace. That was Martin Luther King, Jr.'s dream. God's too.

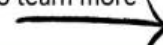

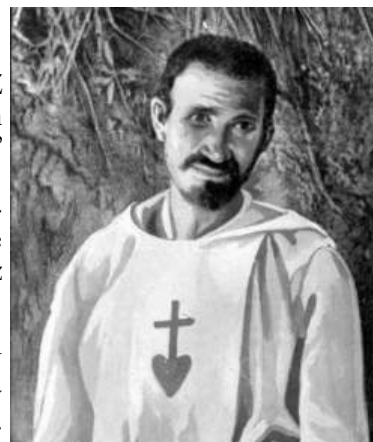

BIULETYN Parafialny

Pod koniec października 1886 r., wczesnym rankiem, pojawił się przy konfesjonale ks. Huvelin dwudziestoosmioletni wówczas Karol de Foucauld, dziś już błogosławiony. Karol mówił przez kratę: „Ojcze, nie mam wiary, przyszedłem prosić o wskazówki”. Z drugiej strony usłyszał: „Proszę uklęknąć, wyspowiadać się Bogu, a wtedy Pan uwierzy”. „Ale nie po to tu przyszedłem” – oponował Karol. „Proszę się wyspowiadać” – odpowiedział twardo spowiednik. Karol ukląkł i pozwolił mówić własnemu sercu. Później napisze: „W tym samym czasie, kiedy uwierzyłem, że Bóg istnieje, zrozumiałem, że nie mogę postąpić inaczej, jak żyć tylko dla Niego, moje powołanie religijne datuje się od tej samej chwili co moja wiara” (Brat Moris, A jeśli Bóg istnieje, TP z 13.02.2005).



Takich spotkań się nie zapomina. One zmieniają nasze życie, nasze widzenie świata. W najmniejszych szczegółach można odtworzyć ich przebieg. Tak było też po południu w Galilei, gdy Jan Chrzciciel, stojąc z dwoma swoimi uczniami, wskazał na przechodzącego Jezusa, mówiąc: „Oto Baranek Boży”. Na pytanie zaś uczniów Panie, gdzie mieszkasz, Jezus odpowiada Chodźcie, a zobaczycie. Wystarczyło jednak kilka chwil spędzonych z Jezusem, a rozpoznali w Nim Kogoś więcej. Andrzej oznajmił swemu bratu Szymonowi: „znaleźliśmy Chrystusa”. Przychodząc do Jezusa i pozostając przy Nim, Andrzej przeszedł duchową drogę od Rabbiego do Chrystusa; w Nauczycielu nauczył się widzieć Chrystusa. Tego nie można się nauczyć inaczej, jak tylko przez pozostanie z Nim. Jezus dokonuje reszty: przeobraża człowieka tak, że po spotkaniu z Nim nikt nie pozostaje tym, kim był. Uczniowie powołani pierwszymi słowami Jezusa: Chodźcie, a zobaczycie, byli wewnętrznie otwarci na nowe propozycje. Mieli odwagę iść za Mistrzem. A On sam prowadził ich wewnętrzną drogą: od Mistrza do Mesjasza, od ucznia do syna.

Qualified Charitable Distribution

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can make a tax-smart decision while increasing the impact of your support of St. Stanislaus Basilica by considering a transfer from your IRA.

Many of you may be familiar with the term “*Qualified Charitable Distribution*” or QCD. This is a distribution from your IRA paid directly to a charity.

If you are required to take a distribution from your IRA, you can direct your IRA custodian to send a portion of your annual distribution up to \$100,000 to support St. Stanislaus Basilica.

Now, why would you want to do this?

The average standard deduction is much higher than it has been in the past and many taxpayers will find that they do not have enough to itemize. This means their gifts to St. Stanislaus Basilica will not count as a tax deduction.

If you are one of those people who can no longer itemize deductions and you write a check to St. Stanislaus Basilica, you will not get a tax deduction. But if you use the QCD option from your IRA, then you will directly reduce your income, save in taxes, and make a big impact on the future of St. Stanislaus Basilica and all its ministries.
