

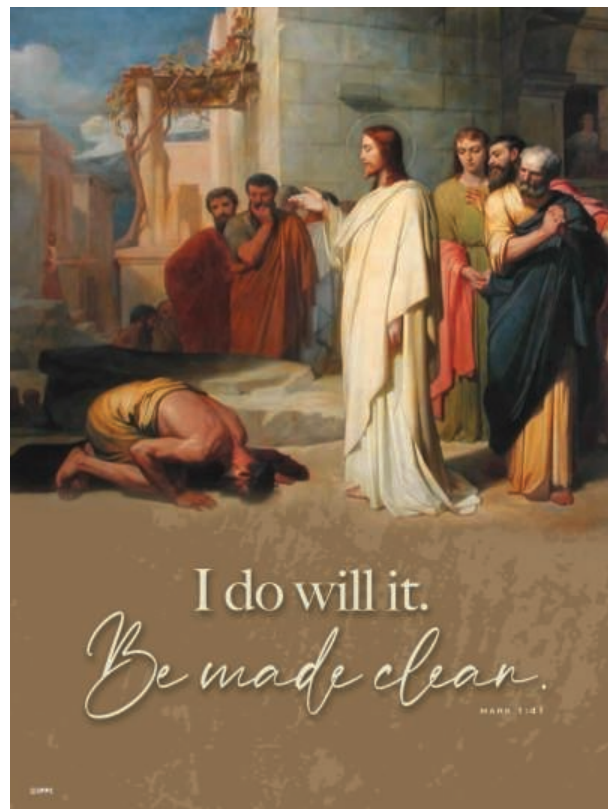

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

LENTEN REGULATIONS

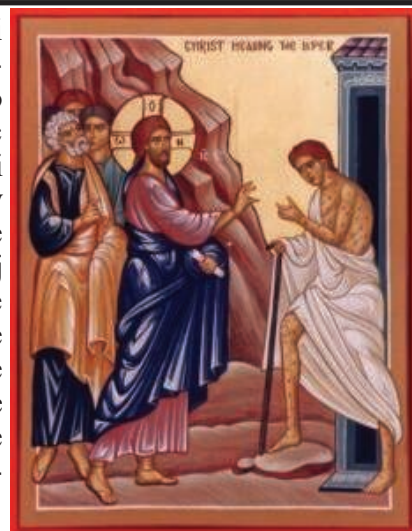
- ◆ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- ◆ The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ◆ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age and does not cease.
- ◆ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.

Please note: Although the faithful may excuse themselves from fast and abstinence, for a just cause, there is an obligation to substitute another penance in its place. No Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from these Lenten obligations.



BIULETYN Parafialny

Na rekolekcjach odprawianych w niewielkiej grupie uczestnicy odczytywali teksty Pisma św. mówiące o trądzie. Wieczorem dzielili się swoimi odkryciami. Jedna z uczestniczek, nie mówiąc o sobie, zwróciła uwagę na dziecko niechciane, odrzucone przez rodziców, któremu wmówiono, że nie może być kochane. W sercu tego dziecka została zakodowana biała plama trądu w taki sposób, że nie umie ono kochać. Gdy inni uczestnicy rekolekcji zapytali, czy dziecko niechciane nie może drogą spotkania z Jezusem szukać uleczenia ze swego nieszczęścia, nasza bohaterka odpowiedziała nieśmiało: „Najczęściej takie dziecko nie wierzy nawet w to, że Chrystus chciałby je uleczyć. Nie wierzy, bo w tej wierze byłoby jego uleczenie. Byłaby pewność, że Jezus je kocha. Zniszczona zdolność miłości człowieka rzuca i na spostrzeganie miłości Boga do człowieka”. Są ludzie, którym bardzo trudno uwierzyć, że ich ktokolwiek kocha, nawet Bóg, mimo że dzień i noc niczego innego nie pragną tylko tego, by ich ktoś pokochał i wzniecił w nich wiarę, że i oni potrafią kochać.



Dzień uzdrowienia stał się niezapomniany dla trędowatego z dzisiejszej Ewangelii. Możemy sobie wyobrazić olbrzymią radość człowieka, który do niedawna jeszcze był trędowatym. Jego radość była tak wielka, że pomimo upomnienia Jezusa zaczął opowiadać i rozgłaszać wszędzie wieść o olbrzymim dobru, które go spotkało. Nie posiadał się ze szczęścia i odczuwał potrzebę podzielenia się nim ze wszystkimi.

Każde nasze spotkanie z Chrystusem również jest niezapomniane. Uświadamia nam, że Jezus jako Zbawiciel ma moc uzdrowić nie tylko rozpadające się ciało człowieka, ale i jego duszę. Jak trędowaty z Ewangelii, mamy ze swej strony stać się apostołami głoszącymi Dobrą Nowinę i dzielić się wielkimi dobrami, które Pan uczynił w naszym życiu.

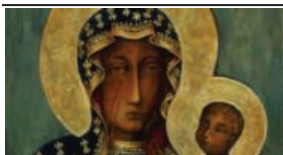

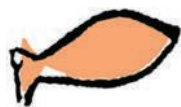

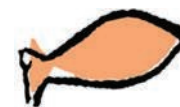

Dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings in the name of the Lord!

We begin Lent this year on February 14, 2024 with the visible sign of ashes, acknowledging our frail human nature, with the words, "Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return."

The practices of fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, as well as abstaining from meat on Ash Wednesday and all of the Fridays of Lent are outward signs of the work we seek to do during Lent: to make our interior dispositions more of what Christ would have us be. The acts of almsgiving and self-sacrifice help us to grow in our understanding of all God has done for us. A special undertaking can be C.R.S. Rice Bowl, a sacrifice by each of us for those who never have a full meal.

History indicates that in the Diocese of Springfield Lenten Penance services have been beacons of light for Catholics returning to the practice of their faith through the Sacrament of Penance. I encourage all to take advantage of this Sacrament of healing, particularly for those who have felt hurt by the Church in any way. As we journey through the Sacred days of Lent, let us be aware of the many ways by which we can provide healing to our Catholic family.

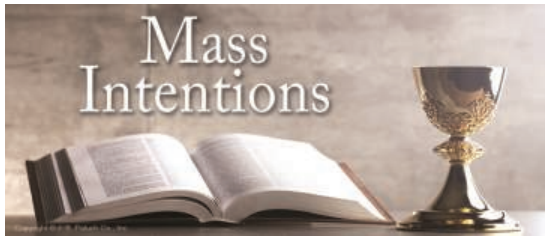
Please refer to the printed guidelines for Lenten practices as they pertain to fasting and abstinence.
