Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things to you! The gospel passage for this Sixth Sunday of Easter is a beautiful one in which Jesus speaks to his disciples of remaining in his love and of loving one another. Our relationship with Jesus Christ is not characterized by slavery but friendship, sharing his own divine life with us through the power of the cross and resurrection.

We are so used to these words of Jesus, however, that we might miss how countercultural they are in 2024. Jesus yokes friendship and remaining in his love with keeping the commandments. In fact, the gospel ends with these words of Jesus: "This I command you: love one another." If love can be commanded, then it must be an act of the will and not be dependent on the ups and downs of human emotions.

The power of Christian love lies precisely in the fact that it is given independent of any prior evaluation of the recipient. True disciples—friends—of Jesus imitate the Savior's boundless love, regardless of whether society or a person's own prejudices deem another worthy of that love or act of charity. This is the kind of love that has made Christians go into places others would not: a soup kitchen, the cancer ward, the battlefield—even sometimes at the risk of their own lives.

The promise and hope of Easter make such a love possible. May we all give and receive the love that characterizes friends of Jesus.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Od dzieciństwa uczymy się znaczeń różnych słów. Jedne z nich są łatwe do przyswojenia i wyjaśnienia, przy innych napotykamy na trudności. Tak się dzieje m. in. ze słowem „miłość”, które odgrywa w naszym życiu szczególną rolę. Kard. Martini zwraca się w jednej ze swoich książek do dziewczynki o imieniu Sara: „Ty nie masz problemu, aby powiedzieć: Kocham cię! I wyciągasz ramiona, aby pokazać jak wielka jest twoja miłość. Ale wystarczy, byś osiągnęła piętnaście lat i tego gestu już nie zobaczymy. Jaka szkoda!”. Pewne cechy miłości jak spontaniczność, wolność od lęku, charakterystyczne dla okresu dzieciństwa, niestety tracimy z biegiem lat, i trzeba je na nowo zdobywać.



Wielu sądzi, że miłość to przede wszystkim sfera uczuć. Tymczasem istotą miłości jest dawanie dobra drugiemu człowiekowi. A to może czynić każdy. Tak na przykład wielu ludzi deklarujących się jako niewierzący działa w organizacjach charytatywnych – czasami na bardzo szeroką skalę. A w dzisiejszej Ewangelii Jezus mówi: „To wam przykazuję, abyście się wzajemnie miłowali”. W ten sposób ukazuje, że wiara w jedyne prawdziwego Boga działa przez jasne świadectwo miłości bliźniego. Jezus pokazuje tę miłość w kolejnych godzinach, kiedy podda się męce i śmierci na krzyżu. Prawdziwa miłość nie jest więc zwykłą ludzką życzliwością czy filantropią. Prowadzi do utraty życia, okazuje dobro nawet nieprzyjaciółom. Jezus myje nogi także Judaszowi. Jezus umiera na krzyżu za grzeszników, czyli za nieprzyjaciół Boga. Tylko taka miłość jest nieśmiertelna. Jakby na przekór temu, co śpiewała przed laty Anna Jantar, że „nic nie może przecież wiecznie trwać”.

Jak mówił Jean Vanier, organizator wspólnot „Arka” dla niepełnosprawnych intelektualnie, „miłość nie polega na dokonywaniu rzeczy nadzwyczajnych i bohaterskich, ale na spełnianiu rzeczy zwykłych z czułością”. I warto w tym miejscu spojrzeć na świat, w którym żyjemy. Na ile jest w nim obecna miłość? Na ile potrafimy inspirować innych do miłości i sam się nią dzielić? Jaka jest nasza miłość w odniesieniu do bliźniego, którego spotykamy codziennie? Wspomnijmy starszych i schorowanych rodziców, którzy dzisiaj potrzebują naszej wyjątkowej opieki; naszych kolegów z pracy, którzy czasem utrudniają nam życie; tych, którzy w wielu sprawach wyrażają odmienną od naszej opinię. Czy ich naprawdę kochamy? Każdy z nas ma o czym i o kim myśleć, a sięgając do przeszłości, dojdzie do wniosku, że w wielu przypadkach nie zdał egzaminu z miłości. Pozostaje, jak mówi ks. Jan Twardowski, „Żal, że się za mało kochało / że się myślało o sobie / że się już nie zdążyło / że było za późno / (...) wszystko już potem za mało / choćby się łzy wyplakało / nagie niepewne”.

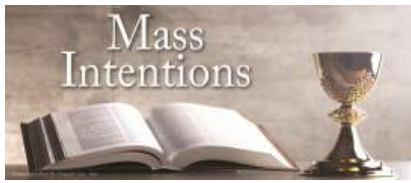
