Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! Twice a month I have the privilege of hearing confessions for the community of the Little Sisters of the Poor in Enfield. The sisters' mail and periodical room becomes a makeshift confessional. There is a beautiful big window that looks out onto their small, enclosed garden. In spring and summer, the garden is filled with colorful flowers and bushes of various kinds. Birds and other animals abound--butterflies, cardinals, hummingbirds, mourning doves, blue jays, sparrows, chipmunks, and squirrels.

The sisters are quick to point out that one of the sisters takes it upon herself to research which flowers and plants attract which birds and animals and then to arrange everything in perfect order. The garden is beautiful to behold and so full of life. Sister would probably be the first to admit, however, that she can only do so much to prepare the ground because it is God who gives the growth, beauty, and abundance. Such is the kingdom of God according to Jesus.

A popular liturgical song has as its refrain: "Let us build the city (kingdom) of God..." Strictly speaking, this is true only in a qualified sense. Human beings do not build the kingdom of God. We pray, worship, plan, do research, sow the seeds of justice, serve others with compassion and mercy . . . and then we hope and trust in the Lord and giver of life to bring abundant life, growth, and beauty out of the small seeds of our grace-driven efforts.

This is a fitting way to think about fatherhood on this Father's Day. When dads are at their best, they provide the safety, security, discipline, and love that help their children to blossom into healthy, joyful, and holy human beings. Fathers prepare the ground and then hope for the best. With gratitude we remember this weekend all our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, and adopted fathers and pray that the seeds of God's kingdom continue to grow in their own hearts. BIULETYN Parafialny

„Ziarnem jest słowo Boże, a siewcą jest Chrystus...” – czytamy we fragmencie Ewangelii przeznaczonym na dzisiejszą niedzielę. Skoro jesteśmy uczniami Jezusa, to znaczy, że zostaliśmy wezwani do tego, abyśmy stawali się ludźmi siewu. W ten sposób rozwijamy Królestwo Boże na ziemi. Jezus pragnie, by Jego królestwo rodziło się w sercu każdego człowieka i rozpowszechniało w całym świecie, aż do chwili, kiedy Pan przyjdzie powtórnie i zostaną wypełnione wszystkie Jego obietnice.



Aby dobrze zrealizować misję, zleconą nam przez Boga, potrzebna jest cierpliwość. Pewna historia opowiada o człowieku, który dobrze przygotował swoje pole, nawodnił je obficie i na nim posadził nasionka. Po kilku tygodniach zobaczył pierwsze roślinki. Dziwił się: gdyż u sąsiada wszystko było większe. Z dnia na dzień tracił cierpliwość. Z troski o przyszłe zbiory nie mógł spać po nocach. Aż któreś takiej bezsennej nocy wpadł na genialny w swoim mniemaniu pomysł: pobiegł szybko na pole i zaczął wyciągać i naciągać każdą roślinkę, aby jej pomóc w szybkim wzroście. Była to bardzo mozolna i uciążliwa praca. Gdy ją skończył, był bardzo zmęczony. Poszedł spać, a gdy wstał, udał się do sąsiada, powiedzieć mu, czego to on dokonał, w jaki to sposób pomógł swoim roślinkom. Gdy przyszli obaj na pole ujrzeni, że rośliny zginęły: wszystko było zniszczone. Cała wioska śmiała się długo z tego człowieka, który nie umiał czekać.

Każdy z nas po zasianiu ziarna nie powinien zapominać, że ono „samo rośnie i wydaje plon”. Dlatego ufając Bogu i zdając się na Jego Opatrzność, mamy rzucić ziarno w ziemię, a potem pozwolić, by tam obumarło, wzrosło i wydało plon. Powinniśmy dawać Bogu swoje zdolności, swoje życie i ufać mocy Jego miłości oraz sile modlitwy. Kiedy jesteśmy w bliskości Boga i troszczymy się o sprawy królestwa, to Bóg troszczy się o nasze sprawy codziennego życia.

CZAS WYPOWIEDZIĆ SIĘ PRZECIWKO - Samobójstwu wspomaganemu przez lekarza! Ustawodawcy Stanu Massachusetts mają jeszcze tylko sześć tygodni na rozważenie ustawy (**ustawa Senatu nr 1331**), która zalegalizowałaby samobójstwo wspomagane przez lekarza. Projekt ustawy nosi tytuł „**Ustawa dotycząca opcji na koniec życia**”. Razem, możemy dołączyć do pracowników służby zdrowia, grupy osób niepełnosprawnych, seniorów, i niezliczonych innych osób, aby **powiedzieć NIE** wspomaganemu samobójstwu! Możemy także przyłączyć się do naszych sąsiadów w New Hampshire i powstrzymać dalsze prace legislacyjne podczas tej sesji. Oto kilka niepokojących faktów, które należy wziąć pod uwagę, zanim skontaktujesz się z wybranymi senatorami:

- Projekt ustawy umożliwiłby lekarzowi podawanie śmiertelnej mieszanki leków osobie, u której zdiagnozowano mniej niż 6 miesięcy życia, która po spożyciu spowodowałaby śmierć.
- Diagnoza może być błędna. Niezliczona liczba osób przeżyła tę sześciomiesięczną diagnozę i cieszyła się wieloma cennymi miesiącami i latami spędzonymi z rodziną i przyjaciółmi.
- Brak rzeczywistych zabezpieczeń – bezbronna osoba, która jest niepełnosprawna fizycznie, w depresji lub boi się, że będzie „ciężarem”, może podlegać nadmiernemu wpływowi innych osób, aby zażyła mieszankę leków, zwłaszcza jeśli zachętą jest korzyść finansowa.
- Wybrani senatorzy powinni skupiać się przede wszystkim na ustawodawstwie zapewniającym wysokiej jakości opiekę zdrowotną, opiekę psychiatryczną i opiekę paliatywną chorym i umierającym – szczególnie w społecznościach niedostatecznie zaopatrzonych, biednych i mniejszościowych, które najbardziej cierpią.



Weź pod uwagę darowiznę na rzecz Bazyliki—uwzględniając Bazylikę św. Stanisława w swoich planach posiadłości typu podarunku w formie spadku w swoim testamencie, funduszu z konta emerytalnego lub ubezpieczenia na życie w bardzo znaczący sposób przyczynisz się do utrzymania Bazyliki i wszystkich jej usług przez wiele lat. Planowanie zapisu pozwala teraz zachować kontrolę nad swoim majątkiem przez całe życie, zapewniając jednocześnie spokój sumienia, wiedząc, że przyczyniłeś się do dalszego istnienia Bazyliki. Jeśli Twoja sytuacja się zmieni, zawsze możesz zmodyfikować swój zapis. Co więcej, większość prezentów od Twojego majątku jest zwolniona z podatków federalnych. Mamy nadzieję, że rozważysz jedną z planowanych możliwości przekazania darowizny. Jeśli masz pytania dotyczące tego, która z różnych opcji jest dla Ciebie najlepsza, skonsultuj się z doradcą finansowym, prawnikiem, lub Twoim doradcą podatkowym.

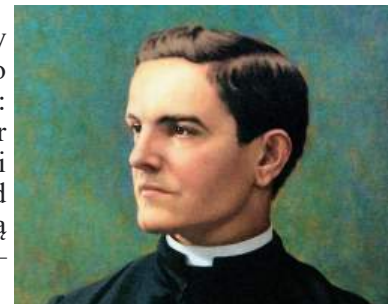

IT'S TIME TO SPEAK OUT IN OPPOSITION TO PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE

The Massachusetts State Legislature has only **six more weeks** to consider legislation (Senate Bill 1331) that would legalize the practice of Physician Assisted Suicide. The bill is titled, "*An Act relative to end of life options*". Working together, we can join health care professionals, disability groups, senior citizens, the infirmed and countless individuals in saying **NO** to assisted suicide! We can also join our neighbors in New Hampshire¹ and stop the legislation from moving forward this session.

Here are some troubling facts to consider before you contact your elected officials:

- 1.) The bill would allow a physician to provide a deadly drug mixture to an individual diagnosed with less than 6 months to live that, when consumed, would cause death.
NOTE - The diagnosis could be wrong. Countless individuals have outlived that 6-month diagnosis and enjoyed many more precious months and years with family and friends.
- 2.) No Real Safeguards - A vulnerable individual who is physically disabled, depressed, or fears being a "burden" may be subject to undue influence by others to take the drug mixture, especially if there is a financial benefit as an incentive.
- 3.) The primary focus of elected officials should be dedicated to legislation providing quality health care, mental health care and palliative care to the sick and dying – particularly in the underserved, poor and minority communities that suffer the most at the time of need.
