Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! Are you ready for more reflection on the Eucharist as we make our way through the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John? Taking our cue from the first reading this Sunday, the watchword is “wisdom.” We can all appreciate the difference between knowledge and wisdom. A person can get all the test answers correct and acquire a college degree, but that does not automatically bring wisdom. Wisdom is born from the application of knowledge to real life and the concrete needs of our brothers and sisters—a certain know-how that comes from age and practice.

Wisdom is personified in the Old Testament as a generous hostess who sets a table of rich food and drink and invites all to partake. We could say that knowledge comes from simply devouring the food, but wisdom derives only from savoring every bite. The rich biblical foundations of our faith challenge us always to move from knowledge to wisdom, from simply knowing about God to knowing God within and among us.

The flesh and blood of the Lord, given to us under sacramental signs, invite us to wisdom. Jesus promises us in today’s gospel that not only will we have eternal life from sharing at the table of the Eucharist, but we will also remain in him as he does in us. The implication is that this presence of God within us is the source of our wisdom for daily living. This is not a wisdom of this world, as St. Paul would say, but wisdom that comes from God for the life of the world.

As you receive the Lord in the Eucharist this weekend, try savoring instead of devouring. Pray for the gift of wisdom, the gift of the Holy Spirit that helps us to navigate all the challenges we face from within and without. Taste and see the goodness of the Lord.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Wielu z nas troszczy się o „chleb powszedni”. Jest to nasz ziemski obowiązek i nie ma w tym nic niezwykłego. Czy jednak nasz „chleb powszedni” zaspokaja wszystkie nasze ziemskie głody i potrzeby? Nie. Nasze najważniejsze głody życiowe zaspokaja „pokarm z nieba”. Jak nauczał św. Jan Paweł II, „Chrystus odpowiada na najgłębsze głody ludzkiej istoty. Takim jest właśnie głód miłości. On zaś jest Tym, który ‘umiłował do końca’ (13.06.1987). Ta miłość najpełniej objawia się w Eucharystii. Stąd Papież pyta: „Czy wystarczy ją tylko przyjmować?” i odpowiada: „Ona jest pokarmem, a więc trzeba z niej żyć”.

Pan Jezus doskonale znał człowieka wiedział, co potrzeba mu do pełnego szczęścia. Znając historię narodu wybranego doskonale wiedział, że sama manna – „pokarm ojców” - nie wystarczy. Dlatego przypomina nam dziś ważną prawdę: „Kto spożywa moje Ciało i pije moją Krew, trwa we Mnie a Ja w nim”. To Ciało wydane i Krew przelana dla naszego zbawiania. To prawdziwe lekarstwo, szczególnie na grzech. Jak pisał św. Ambroży, „Raną jest to, że ulegamy grzechowi, a lekarstwem – Najświętszy Sakrament”.

Przychodzi więc do nas Bóg, który staje się dla nas chlebem. Pragnie nas karmić sobą. Jak możemy przeżywać tę Bożą obecność? Wsłuchajmy się w świadectwo Agnieszki: „Pamiętam dzień swojej Pierwszej Komunii św. Nie mogłam się doczekać, bo byłam ciekawa jak smakuje Ciało Chrystusa. Okazało się że jak zwykły opłatek. Starłam się po dziecinnemu uwierzyć że to sam Bóg, ale jakoś z trudem mi to przychodziło. Mijały lata. Nie przyjmując Komunii traciłam chyba to, co najważniejsze. Prawdziwa istotę i sens. Czasem starałam się skupiać na tym że to sam Bóg, ale wciąż mi to uciekało. Przychodziły kłopoty, problemy, a ja niby się modliłam, prosiłam Boga o pomoc, ale wciąż nie docierało do mnie jak blisko może być we mnie. W końcu przyszedł moment, kiedy zaczęłam poznawać Boga bliżej. Często przyjmowałam Komunię. Nie zauważyłam nawet, kiedy Jezus na stałe zagościł w moim sercu i zaczął mnie uzdrawiać. Komunia daje mi ogromną siłę i moc do przetrwania i pokonywania trudności”.

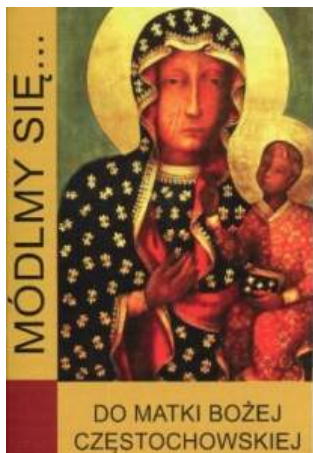

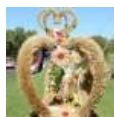
