

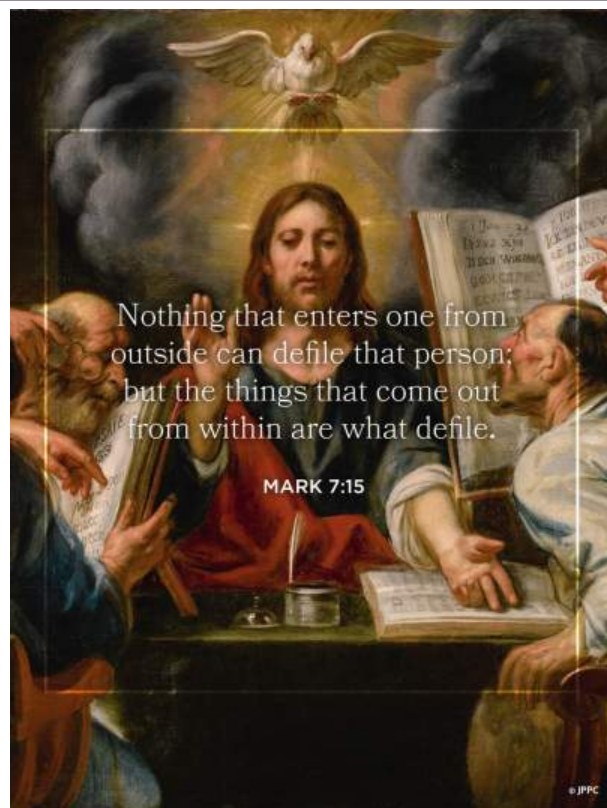

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! In this Sunday's gospel Jesus has some very harsh words for the Pharisees and scribes who criticize his disciples for not washing their hands before eating, not in terms of good hygiene but rather ritual uncleanness. The law of Moses, along with the 600+ prescriptions promoted by the Pharisees to stay faithful to that law, outline certain actions or physical states that would render a person unclean, i.e. unable to participate in the communal worship of God or even come in contact with other faithful. For the Pharisees, ritual impurity or uncleanness was central to a person's status before God.

Jesus relativizes those prescriptions of the law with the statement that true uncleanness and true separation from others result from the unchecked or unexamined vices that come from the human heart and not from an external physical state. If there were any doubt as to what some of those vices or sins are, Jesus lists examples for us: evil desires, impure thoughts, murder, adultery, greed, deceit, envy....

In today's Western culture, there has been a shift of emphasis from the personal sins of human beings to social sin or unjust structures. Our faith holds not for one kind or the other but both. In other words, sinful or unjust systems exist because they are held together by sinful people in need of repentance. A greedy company flourishes because greedy people direct it.

We are challenged this weekend to look within our own hearts and allow Jesus to heal what is wounded and repair what is broken. The joy and peace that result will be contagious to those around us and help heal our wounded culture.

9/11 MEMORIAL MASS - The Annual deanery-wide Memorial Mass, honoring the memory of the innocent victims and selfless heroes who perished in the tragic terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, will be offered at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, September 11th at Ste. This year marks the 23rd annual observance of the horrific events that took place on that fateful day in our nation's history. Please join us, as we gather, to offer our thoughts and prayers, not only for the innocent victims, including those first responders, fire, police and emergency medical technicians who, simply, went to work on that day ... and never came home but, also, for the families and friends whom they have left behind.



BIULETYN Parafialny

Dla chrześcijan najważniejsze jest przykazanie miłości. Natomiast jeśli ktoś skrupulatnie przestrzega wszelkich praw, nie przepajając ich miłością, jest daleki od prawdziwej pobożności. Jest to pobożność pozorowana, na pokaz, która prowadzi do zakłamania osobowości. Nie dopuszcza do siebie, że niestety najbardziej oszukuje nie innych, ale siebie samego. Przy takiej postawie człowiek nigdy nie spotka się z Bogiem. To do takich ludzi odnoszą się słowa Jezusa skierowane do faryzeuszy o grobach pobielanych, które na zewnątrz są piękne, a w środku pełne nieczystości.



Skrzywienie, które Jezus wytykał niektórym faryzeuszom, polegające na przywiązywaniu nadmiernej wagi do czystości zewnętrznej zamiast czystości serca, powtarza się także dziś. Martwimy się bardziej zanieczyszczeniem atmosfery, wody, dziurą ozonową, tymczasem wokół zanieczyszczenia serca panuje cisza. Kto na przykład zastanawia się nad zanieczyszczeniem prawdy za sprawą przekręcania informacji? Czy my, bardzo uważający na to, co wchodzi do naszych ust (produkty świeże, a nie przeterminowane), ale nie przykładając wagi do tego, co z nich wychodzi (słowa raniące, agresywne), nie zasługujemy na naganę Chrystusa: „Obłudnicy!”?

Każdy z nas wie doskonale, że należy przestrzegać przykazań. Tylko prawy człowiek, jak śpiewaliśmy w dzisiejszym psalmie responsoryjnym, zamieszka w domu Pańskim. Bóg nie zmusza człowieka do niczego, ale wskazuje mu, że tylko wtedy, gdy będzie żył według przykazań, osiągnie życie wieczne. Czy jednak człowiek tak do końca jest odpowiedzialny za swoje postępowanie, czy właściwie korzysta z wolności danej przez Stwórcę? Tylko wolny wybór pozwala otwierać się na działanie łaski Bożej.

Każdy z nas obiera w życiu pewien „kurs”, system wartości, według których postępuje, precyzuje cel życia. Św. Jan Paweł II w czasie IV pielgrzymki do Ojczyzny w 1991 roku mówił w Koszalinie: „Dekalog, ten moralny fundament, jest od Boga i jest dla człowieka, dla jego dobra prawdziwego. Jeśli człowiek burzy ten fundament, szkodzi sobie: burzy ład życia i współżycia ludzkiego w każdym wymiarze... Bez Boga pozostają ruiny moralności”.

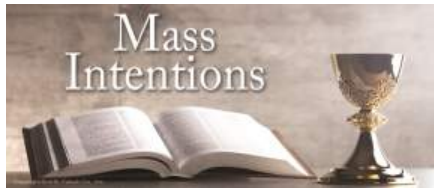
