Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! I write this Pastor's Corner from a retreat house in El Salvador where our pilgrimage group of friars, priests, and deacons is preparing to walk in the footsteps of the martyrs who gave their lives in this land. Fr. John Spain, a Maryknoll missionary from the USA who has worked here for decades and knew most of the martyrs personally, spoke tonight about the awareness that St. Oscar Romero, the Archbishop of San Salvador in the 1970s, had of his impending martyrdom. While this courageous pastor was ready to give his whole life to God and for the people, he also knew that the Church would continue and be victorious through what he called the "violence of love." In November 1977, Archbishop Romero spoke the following:

"The violence we preach is not the violence of the sword, the violence of hatred. It is the violence of love, of brotherhood, the violence that wills to beat weapons into sickles for work."

This week we have a convergence of events both sacred and secular: Inauguration Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, and the Octave for Christian Unity (January 18-25). Perhaps at no other time in recent history do we need this violence of love. Let these powerful words of a canonized saint and shepherd ring in your hearts and minds this week as we pray for unity and love in our church, our country, and our world. Let the power of Jesus turn our plain water into the rich wine of the kingdom. You are in my prayers in these sacred places.

## BIULETYN Parafialny

Każdego dnia jesteśmy bombardowani cudownymi receptami na szczęście. Wystarczy kupić jakiś produkt, skorzystać z wyjątkowej promocji czy udać się po poradę do eksperta. Wydaje się, że kupno poradnika za kilkanaście złotych to niebył wielki wysiłek. W tym miejscu pojawiają się jednak ważne pytania: skoro tak łatwo jest zdobyć w życiu szczęście, to czemu tylu ludzi wokół nas czuje się samotnych, opuszczonych, pozbawionych miłości? Czym jest prawdziwe szczęście i kto tak naprawdę się o nie troszczy? Czy jest ktoś, komu tak naprawdę zależy na naszym szczęściu? W czym możemy odnaleźć prawdziwe szczęście?



Jezus, który jest gościem na weselu w Kanie Galilejskiej, dokonuje uświęcenia miłości ludzkiej i ziemskiej. Ten, który jest Miłością, czyni pierwszy cud, czyli pouczający znak dla uczniów, a potem dla całego Kościoła. Chrystus pokazuje w ten sposób, że jeżeli człowiek nie chce, aby jego szczęście trwało tylko przez chwilę, musi zacząć budować go od mocnych fundamentów. Jezus przypomina, że miłość nie ogranicza się do sentymentu, uczuć, emocjonalnej bliskości, ale wyraża się w konkretnym czynie. Pokazuje, że chrześcijanin w dążeniu do szczęścia nie może pominąć miłości, która poszukując dobra ukochanej osoby staje się wyrzeczeniem i jest gotowa do poświęceń.

Wydarzenie z Kany Galilejskiej ma mieć swoje odbicie w życiu chrześcijańskiej rodziny. Jezus pokazuje, że rodzina jest czymś pełnym, jeśli w niej jest obecny Bóg. Nigdzie Bóg nie chce tak mieszkać, jak w rodzinie, w sercach każdego z jej członków. Nieobecność Boga w rodzinie oznacza jej klęskę, zatracenie jej istotnego celu. Dramaty wielu współczesnych rodzin są tego wymownym przykładem. Ojciec i matka są pierwszymi znakami samego Boga na ziemi. Bóg wybrał te znaki, by przez nie objawiać człowiekowi swoją miłość. Ilu klęsk uniknęłyby rodziny, gdyby żyły według tej Bożej myśli. „W moim domu rządził tylko pieniądź. Wszyscy żyli w nim dla pieniędzy. Ja popełniłem zbrodnię” – pisze w swoim pamiętniku jeden z więźniów na krótko przed egzekucją. „Nie daliśmy nic naszym dzieciom, jeśli nie nauczyliśmy ich wartości, dla których trzeba żyć – mówi w dyskusji pewien wspaniały ojciec. Czyż pod tymi słowami nie powinien się podpisać każdy ojciec rodziny i każda matka?



Poczuj ciepło i radość Świąt Bożego Narodzenia podczas nadchodzącej **KOLACJI OPŁATKOWEJ**, wydarzenia w języku polskim i angielskim! Ta polska tradycja to czas, aby zebrać się we wspólnocie, podzielić się symbolicznym świątecznym opłatkiem, zjeść pyszny posiłek i śpiewać kolędy, które napełniają powietrze świąteczną radością. To coś więcej niż tylko kolacja, to święto wiary, miłości i wspólnoty, które podniesie nas na duchu i złączy nas w jedną Rodzinę Parafialną. Nie przegap tej pięknej okazji, aby nawiązać kontakt z innymi i odkryć prawdziwe znaczenie Świąt Bożego Narodzenia! **Prosimy zakup bilet** na to spotkanie dziś w przedsionku Bazyliki po naszej Mszy św.

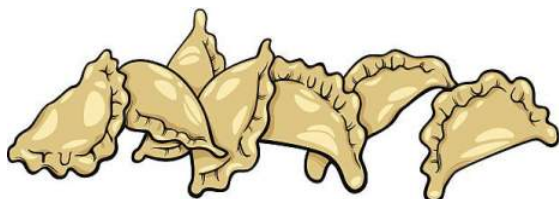

#### Qualified Charitable Distribution

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
