Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! I am sure we have all asked this question at some point in our lives: “Who? Me?!” Whether responding to a simple request or the call to do something weightier, the question implies some surprise that I might be the person in question. Perhaps there is a hint of unworthiness or inadequacy. This is definitely the case in the Mass readings this Sunday.

Both the prophet Isaiah and the soon-to-be-apostle Peter are struck with a heavy sense of their unworthiness and sinfulness when faced with the glorious presence of God. Isaiah’s vision takes place during the temple liturgy as the smoke of incense fills the sacred space. Peter’s experience is not that of a vision but the tangible presence of Jesus, the Son of God, who manifests his divinity with a miraculous catch of fish. In the face of the awesome experience of God, we often feel our littleness and seeming insignificance.

The surprise response from God is that the Lord lifts us out of our unworthiness by the power of divine mercy. Isaiah’s uncleanness is wiped away; Peter’s sinfulness is forgiven. The same is true for you and me. We are often very much aware of our unworthiness, lukewarm discipleship, and sinfulness. The Lord does not like to take “no” for an answer. Any protest on our part is met by overwhelming mercy.

Are you being called by God to do something you feel unworthy to do or inadequate to the task? Is the Jubilee of Hope awakening something in you and drawing you deeper into prayer and living your faith? Are you saying: “Who? Me?!” Jesus is inviting YOU and will give you all that you need.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Życie wielu gorliwych uczniów Chrystusa to ciągle ponawiana odpowiedź na wezwanie skierowane do Szymona z dzisiejszej Ewangelii: „Wy płyn na głębię i zarzućcie sieci na połów!”. Czasem, wbrew przyjętym zwyczajom, sytuacjom, które wydają się bez wyjścia, trzeba, jak Piotr i towarzyszący mu synowie Zebedeusza: Jakub i Jan, zaufać: „Mistrzu na Twoje słowo”. Rybacy nie spodziewali się, że zarzucając sieć wbrew zasadom sztuki rybackiej, wyciągną na oczach tłumu takie mnóstwo ryb. Piotr czuł się po ludzku nieprzygotowanym do przemiany z rybaka w pasterza dusz. Dopiero pod wpływem obfitego połowu do końca zrozumiał, jak wymagające czeka go zadanie.



Słuchanie Jezusa domaga się, by porzucić czysto ludzkie kalkulacje i zaufać. Wtedy rodzi się owoc niewspółmierny do naszych wysiłków. Lęk zostaje przemieniony i zwyciężony miłością Chrystusa, która wszystko może. Bóg, nie zważając na ludzką słabość, wzywa człowieka, aby stał się narzędziem Bożego królestwa, przekazicielem tej łaski, która stała się jego udziałem. Współczesnym przykładem współodpowiedzialności za potrzebujących pomocy jest żyjąca na naszych oczach bł. Matka Teresa z Kalkuty. Jak sama wspomina: „Po kilkunastu latach życia zakonnego zamknęłam za sobą drzwi i znalazłam się sama na ulicach Kalkuty, doznałam niezwykle silnego uczucia zagubienia, niemal lęku, który był trudny do przewyciężenia”. W książce „Matka ubogich”, Renzo Allegri – zgłębiając historię jej życia i powołania – zapisała: „W tamtej chwili Matka Teresa zobaczyła jasno i wyraźnie swoją nową sytuację. Była zupełnie sama. Sama, bez dachu nad głową, bez pieniędzy, bez pracy, nie wiedząc, dokąd pójść, by coś zjeść i znaleźć schronienie na noc”. Znalazła się w straszliwej sytuacji, w jakiej znajdowali się ci ludzie, którym ona pragnęła „służyć”. Nie posiadała niczego poza wizją tego, co zamierzała realizować. „Polecenie”, jakie otrzymała od Jezusa w nocy 10 sierpnia 1946 r. było precyzyjnie określone: „służyć najuboższym spośród ubogich. Żyć wśród nich i tak jak oni”.

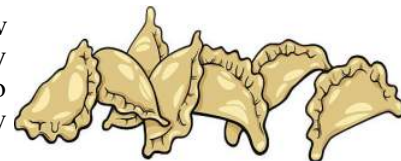

14 lutego w Kościele katolickim wspomnienie **ŚWIĘTEGO WALENTEGO** - biskupa i męczennika uważanego na zachodzie Europy i w Stanach Zjednoczonych za patrona zakochanych. Św. Walenty żył w III w. i był biskupem Terni w Umbri. Choć o jego życiu zachowało się stosunkowo niewiele informacji, wiadomo, że w czasie prześladowań chrześcijan w Cesarstwie Rzymskim za panowania cesarza Klaudiusza II Gockiego wraz ze św. Mariuszem asystował męczennikom w czasie ich procesów i egzekucji. Po pewnym czasie sam został pojmany i doprowadzony do prefekta Rzymu, który przeprowadził rutynowy proces polegający na zmuszaniu do wyparcia się wiary w Chrystusa. Walenty był torturowany i bity, jednak nie wyrzekł się wiary, za co został skazany na śmierć. Wyrok wykonano 14 lutego, 269 roku. Grób świętego szybko stał się

celem licznych pielgrzymek. Wiemy że kochać można miłością romantyczną, rodzicielską czy przyjacielską. 14 lutego to święto wszystkich tych miłości, dlatego nie ograniczaj się do złożenia życzeń jedynie swojej drugiej połówce. Równie dobrze z tej okazji możesz z rodzicami wybrać się do Waszej ulubionej restauracji albo wspólnie z przyjaciółmi zrobić przyjęcie w swoim domu.

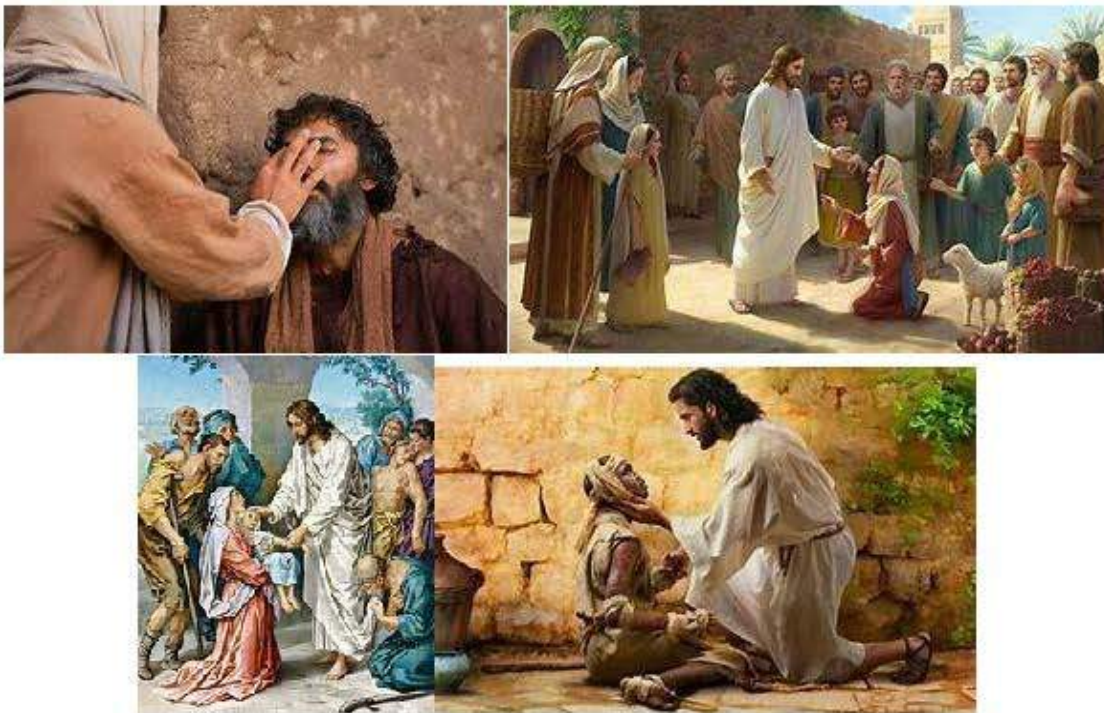

Qualified Charitable Distribution

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.

Please consider making a big impact on the future of the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus by the use of the Qualified Charitable Distribution option from your IRA!

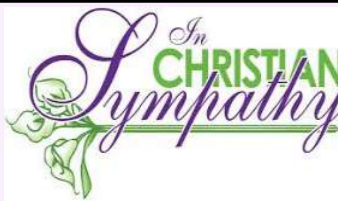
