Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Lenten peace and all good things! How is your Lent going so far? Are your acts of penance and charity and extra prayer time transforming you into a more fervent disciple of Jesus Christ? Have you set aside some time for Eucharistic adoration? An extra Mass during the week? How about that confession you're putting off? Did you sign up for a small group in a fellow parishioner's home?

When I was a child, I remember a relative of mine who was a practicing Catholic. She made the remark one day, however, that although she dutifully went to Sunday Mass and was very involved in parish activities, she didn't want to become a "holy roller." [For those who are not familiar with the term, it is a kind of derisive expression for Protestant Christians who are involved in dramatic or overly emotional expressions of personal prayer and worship.]

I don't think that most Catholics aspire to be like holy rollers, but I also heard underlying that comment a fear that becoming holy and answering too fervently our call to sainthood might turn us into something we are not, i.e. make us less like ourselves. If holiness is genuine, nothing could be further from the truth. We can learn today from the transfiguration of Jesus.

When Jesus becomes radiant on the mountain in the presence of Peter, James, and John, the disciples see Jesus' humanity not diminished but totally transformed by his divinity into what it should be: dazzling and beautiful. God's grace does not make us less of who we are but more authentically who we are called to be, both in his sight and that of others. Let our prayer this Lent be that our penitential practices, prayer, and almsgiving will more truly make us into the beautiful image of God we were created to be.

BIULETYN Parafialny

Słowo Boże zaprasza nas dziś na górę Tabor, gdzie razem z Piotrem, Janem i Jakubem stajemy się świadkami wydarzenia niezwykłego. Rozmowa o nieuchronności ofiary Mesjasza toczy się w scenerii igrzyska niebiańskiej. Widzimy odmienionego Jezusa, którego twarz jaśnieje jak słońce, a szaty stają się lśniąco białe. A obok Niego dwóch mężczyzn – Mojżesza i Eliasza – których na ziemi nie widziano od tysięcy lat, i którzy objawiają nam się w chwale. Rozmowa ta ukazuje, że decyzja o śmierci Chrystusa nie jest wynikiem ziemskiego rozumowania. Podjęta została dla naszego zbawienia. „On był światłem”. Nie jednym z proroków, nie jednym światłem więcej, ale „światłem”, które przyszło na ten świat. To z powodu zniszczenia tego światła On umrze. Na Taborze uczniowie doświadczali olśnienia Bożą chwałą, kiedy twarz Jezusa „zajaśniała jak słońce, odzienie zaś stało się białe jak światło. Święty Piotr całe życie pozostanie naznaczony tym szczególnym spotkaniem. To właśnie wspomnienie Przemienienia, które stało się dla niego podstawowym doświadczeniem jego wierności, daje zatrwożonemu Piotrowi siłę i pewność.



A teraz spróbujmy spojrzeć na naszą rzeczywistość. Tym razem bohaterem ostatniej sceny jestem ja, tzn. uczeń Jezusa, chrześcijanin trzeciego tysiąclecia, w każdej Eucharystii oświecany światłem Jego łaski. Czym dla mnie jest polecenie Boga Ojca, który nakazuje „słuchać” Chrystusa? Słuchać, tzn. doświadczać, uczestniczyć, przyjąć i także naśladować. W okresie Wielkiego Postu, uprzywilejowaną formą przemawiania Boga do ludzkiego serca, swoistą Górą Tabor i odnowieniem osobistego przymierza ze Stwórcą, jest czas rekolekcji, jakie odbywają się w tysiącach parafii. Rekolekcje to nic innego, jak słuchanie Boga i doświadczenie Jego obecności, to porządkowanie i uzupełnianie posiadanej hierarchii wartości, to odnowienie osobistej przyjaźni z Bogiem i umocnienie wiary. Żadne rekolekcje, bez względu na ich długość i metodę nie są procesem automatycznym. Raczej moglibyśmy utożsamiać je z pewną walką, pewnym trudem i oczekiwaniem. Jeśli spojrzymy na Piotra, Jakuba i Jana, to mimo niesprzyjających i tajemniczych, zewnętrznych okoliczności nie wątpimy, że ich wejście na Górę Tabor było potrzebne. Warto było tam być, aby zobaczyć „blask Nieba” i usłyszeć głos Stwórcy: „To jest Syn mój, Wybrany, Jego słuchajcie!”.

Qualified Charitable Distribution

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
