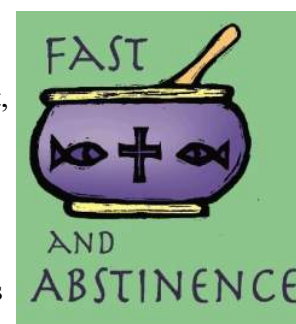

**LENTEN REGULATIONS**

- ◆ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. On days of fast two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.
- ◆ The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ◆ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age and does not cease.
- ◆ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.



Please note: Although the faithful may excuse themselves from fast and abstinence, for a just cause, there is an obligation to substitute another penance in its place. No Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from these Lenten obligations.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings in the name of the Lord!

We begin Lent this year on March 5, 2025 with the visible sign of ashes, acknowledging our frail human nature, with the words, "Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return."

The practices of fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, as well as abstaining from meat on Ash Wednesday and all of the Fridays of Lent, are outward signs of the spiritual growth we seek to do during Lent. The acts of almsgiving and self-sacrifice help us to grow in our understanding of all God has done for us. A special undertaking can be the Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl, a sacrifice by each of us for those who never have a full meal and most pertinent during this time of uncertainty in the lives of our refugees and immigrants.

May this Lent be a time of growth in our relationship with Christ and with others, and may we find ourselves in a more meaningful and intentional relationship with our God.

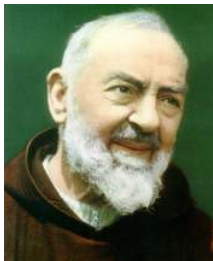
