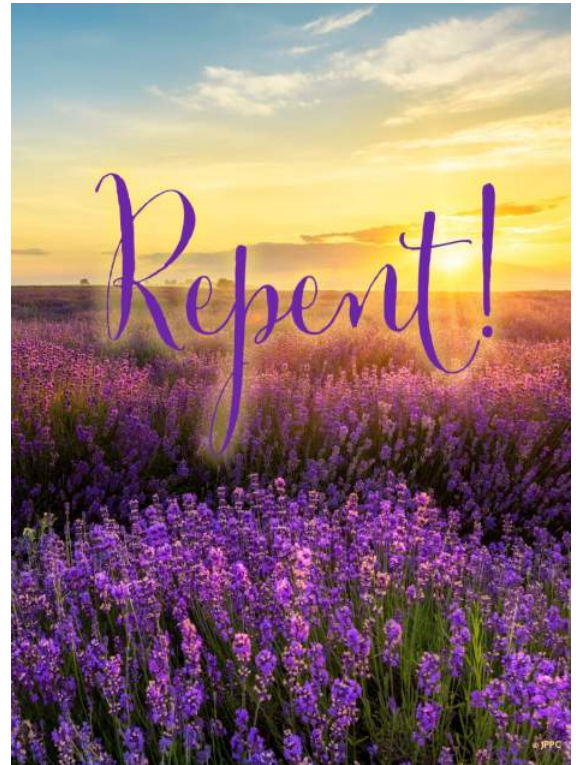

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things! The gospel passage this Sunday can be somewhat disturbing. Not only are we given glimpses into two tragedies that took place in Jesus' day—the brutality of the Roman governor who would later have Jesus crucified and the falling tower that crushed bystanders—but we are also given stern warnings by Jesus, through both direct speech and a parable, that he is serious about repentance. The Son of God began his public ministry by announcing repentance, and now he appears to show some frustration. After all he has taught by his words and wrought by his miracles, people will not allow his presence to transform their lives.

We welcome all through our basilica doors, especially in this Jubilee Year of Hope, but our Savior makes it clear that once inside, we are all called to repentance and conversion. Again, this does not mean becoming something we are not but becoming truly who we were created by God to be. Not to embrace this conversion and repentance is, in Jesus' own words, to perish.

Lent is about taking this baptismal call to heart and allowing the grace of God to free us from unhealthy or immoral attachments and relationships, addictions, dependencies, and anything which dethrones God in our lives. The good news is that such conversion brings joy and peace as God graces us with ever deepening friendship and intimacy. Happy Lent!

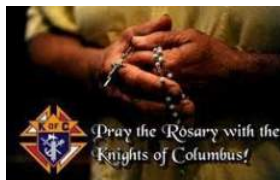

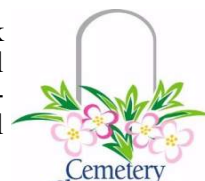

BIULETYN Parafialny

W książce pod tytułem „Nawrócenie” (2002) znajdujemy opis drogi, którą włoski pisarz Vittorio Messori dotarł do katolicyzmu. Messori urodził się w Modenie w 1941 r. Został co prawda ochrzczony, ale jego rodzina nie praktykowała wiary i nie otrzymał w niej żadnego wychowania religijnego. Niewierząca rodzina i szkoła uczyniły z niego antyklerykała i racjonalistę. Momentem przełomowym okazało się dla niego lato 1964 r. Łaska Boża sprawiła, że 23-letni Vittorio, inteligentny i dobrze zapowiadający się student i pracownik centrali telefonicznej na nocnej zmianie, mieszkający w antyklerykalnym Turynie, studiujący u laickich profesorów, wziął do ręki Ewangelię i przeżył – niewytłumaczalne w sposób racjonalny – doświadczenie nawrócenia. Spotkał Jezusa Chrystusa i otrzymał dar pewności, że ten Człowiek prawdziwie był Synem Bożym. Później Ewangelię poświęcił całe swoje późniejsze życie. Stał się jednym z najpopularniejszych pisarzy katolickich o międzynarodowej sławie. Jest autorem wywiadu-rzeki z Janem Pawłem II pt. „Przekroczyć próg nadziei” oraz z kard. Josephem Ratzingerem – „Raport o stanie wiary”. Messori był świadomy tego, że życie „albo się przeżywa, albo się je pisze”. Dlatego zawsze poszukiwał odosobnionego miejsca, w którym mógłby zastanawiać się, jak przekonać ludzi, że nadzieja istnieje, że jest ona uzasadniona, że „chrześcijanin to nie kretyn”.



Patrząc na przykład Vittorio Messoriego widzimy, że Bóg daje człowiekowi czas. Nawrócenie stanowi zmianę kierunku życia opartego o wzór świata do wzoru, który pokazuje życie Jezusa. Czasem ta zmiana dokonuje się natychmiast po poznaniu Jezusa. Niekiedy proces nawrócenia trwa rok lub więcej, aż człowiek pokona w sobie opór przed panowaniem Boga w życiu. A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
