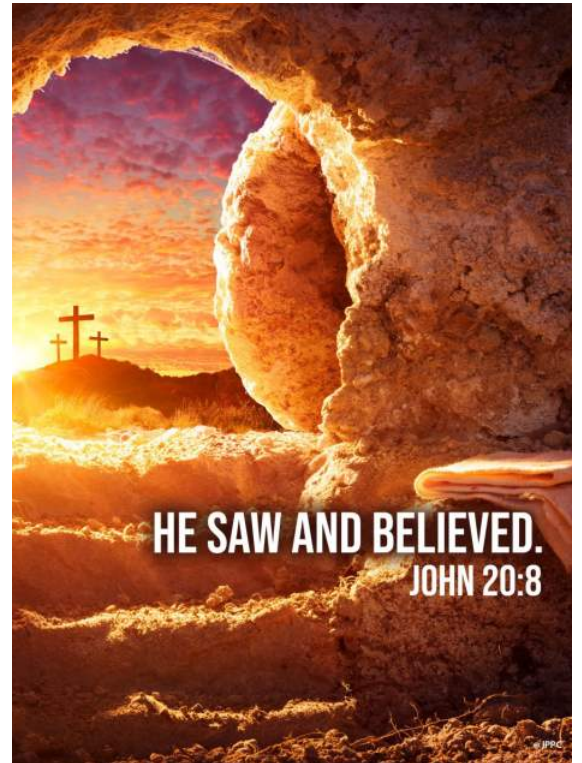

WELCOME TO ST. STANISLAUS BASILICA! We joyfully welcome all family, friends, and visitors joining us for Easter Masses at St. Stanislaus Basilica. Whether you are here from near or far, we are blessed by your presence as we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord. If you are visiting today, we invite you to come back and join us again. Our doors are always open, and we would love to see you more often. May the joy and peace of this Easter season remain with you and your loved ones throughout the year. Wishing you a blessed and joyful Easter!

THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY will be celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. Mass on *April 27*, the first Sunday after Easter, which is called Divine Mercy Sunday. Confessions will be heard from Noon to 1:00 p.m., followed by Recitation of the Rosary at 1:00 p.m., and Mass celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. A procession and recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy will take place after Mass. On the day of Sister Faustina’s canonization, April 30th, 2000, Pope John Paul II instituted the feast for the whole Church. The institution of the feast was inspired by a desire of Jesus which was conveyed by Sister Faustina. The Lord Jesus told her: *I desire that the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy (Diary 299). I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened (Diary 699).*

BIULETYN Parafialny

W tym dniu wspaniałym wszyscy się weselmy” – powtarzamy za psalmistą. Wielkanoc, najstarsze a zarazem najważniejsze dla chrześcijan święto, obchodzimy co roku. Może nam już trochę spowszedniała. Ta sama liturgia Triduum Paschalnego, męka, grób, zmartwychwstanie. Jak zrozumieć tę największą tajemnicę naszej wiary?

Spójrzmy na film pt. „Zmartwychwstały” (2016) w reżyserii Kevina Reynoldsa, który przedstawia śledztwo w sprawie Jezusa. Historię śmierci i zmartwychwstania Jezusa widzimy oczami rzymskiego Trybuna Claviusa, któremu Poncjusz Piłat zleca odnalezienie uczniów skazanego właśnie na śmierć Jezuego. Zdaniem Piłata podpuszczanego przez Senhedryn, ciało Jezusa wykradli jego uczniowie, którzy chcieli nadal szerzyć „heretycką religię”. Clavius podążając za rzekomymi złodziejami, wyrusza też w głąb siebie. Rzymianin jedyne czego pragnie to „wolność od zabijania i śmierci”. Jest prostym zabijaką, wykonującym rozkazy, który chce jednak pozostać zgodny ze swoim sumieniem. Ono zmienia się stopniowo w kontakcie z uczniami Jezusa.

Clavius zdaje sobie powoli sprawę, że wszystkiego nie da się wytłumaczyć wyłącznie rozumem. Widział przecież dziwne odbicie na całunie, stopione pieczęcie, pęknięte, a nie przecięte liny, odsunięty głaz, który musiałoby przesunąć kilku silnych mężczyzn. Doświadczył też niezwykłej dobroci płynącej od uczniów cieśli. Ostatecznie rozmawiając z objawiającym się uczniom Jezusem, Clavius jest pełen wątpliwości. „Ty widziałeś i masz wątpliwości. Wyobraź sobie co będą czuli, ci, którzy nie widzieli, a chcą uwierzyć” – mówi mu Zbawiciel.



Zmartwychwstanie Jezusa Chrystusa to rewolucja miłości. Nie jest kwestią przypadku, że Chrystus Pan zmartwychwstał właśnie w niedzielę. Światłość Jego zmartwychwstania rozświetliła poranek pierwszego dnia tygodnia. Swoim powstaniem z martwych Jezus zapoczątkował nową epokę w ludzkiej historii. Oświetlił całą ziemię światłem przyszłego wieku. Samo zmartwychwstanie niesie jednak ze sobą wiele znaków zapytania, które musimy wciąż odczytywać, jak tyle pokoleń uczniów Zmartwychwstałego. Do dziś tęgie umysły tego świata głowią się, co i jak. A tajemnica nadal pozostaje tajemnicą. I chyba tak musi być.



WIOSENNE SPRZĄTANIE CMENTARZA PARAFIALNEGO - Już wiosna, a wraz z nią nasza prośba o usunięcie dekoracji zimowych. Pamiętajmy, że sztuczne ozdoby, sztuczne kwiaty, świece wotywnie, ogrodzenia wszelkiego rodzaju są niedozwolone. Palmowe krzyże mogą pozostać do 30 kwietnia – ale jeśli nie zostaną zabrane do tego czasu, zostaną wyrzucone. Świeże kwiaty w doniczkach i pudełkach są dozwolone, o ile wyglądają świeżo i są odpowiednio pielęgnowane. Natomiast sadzenie w ziemi drzew, krzewów i kwiatów jest zabronione. Dziękujemy za pomoc w utrzymaniu naszego cmentarza w bezpiecznych dla wszystkich warunkach o naturalnym i pięknym wyglądzie. Pełne zasady i regulaminy obowiązujące na naszym cmentarzu są dostępne w biurze parafialnym.

WIEŃCE NA CMENTARZACH AMERYKI - Zespół Wreaths Across America pragnie wyrazić szczerą wdzięczność naszym parafianom, personelowi biura i duchowieństwu za ich hojne wsparcie tego znaczącego programu. Dzięki waszej życzliwości w ciągu ostatniego roku zakupiono i z miłością umieszczono na grobach weteranów około 400 wieńców. Jesteśmy również głęboko wdzięczni wszystkim, którzy pomogli w umieszczeniu i zdjęciu wieńców. Życzymy wszystkim radosnych i błogosławionych Świąt Wielkanocnych!

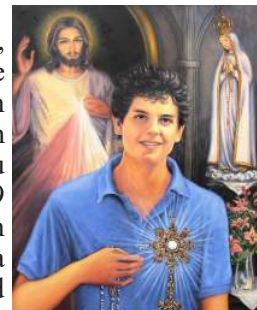

BŁOGOSŁAWIONY CARLO ACUTIS - W niedzielę 27 kwietnia błogosławiony Carlo Acutis, 15-letni projektant stron internetowych, który zmarł na białaczkę w 2006 roku, zostanie kanonizowany jako święty podczas Jubileuszu Nastolatków, co uczyni go pierwszym świętym tysiąclecia. Aby uczcić tę okazję, Fathom Events zaoferuje ograniczony 3-dniowy pokaz w kinach w całym kraju „Carlo Acutis: Roadmap to Reality”, wyczekiwanego filmu dokumentalnego o życiu przyszłego świętego. 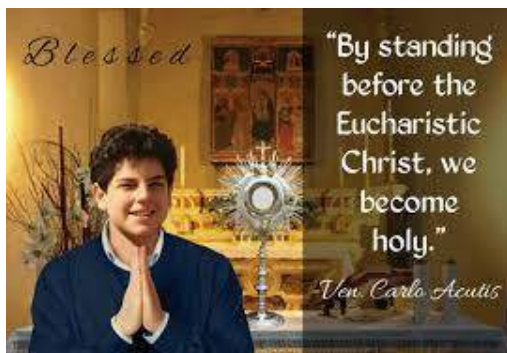


WREATHS — across — AMERICA

WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA - The Wreaths Across America Team extends its sincere gratitude to our parishioners, church office staff, and clergy for their generous support of this meaningful program. CEMETERY CLEAN-UP - We kindly ask all families and friends of our parish cemetery to remove any remaining Christmas or winter decorations as soon as possible. As a reminder, artificial items such as ornaments, flowers, votive candles, enclosures of any kind, and new plantings in the ground are not permitted. Palm Crosses may remain until April 30; any not removed by then will be respectfully discarded. Fresh flowers in pots or boxes are welcome, provided they are well-maintained and appear fresh. Permanent plantings—including trees, shrubs, or flowers planted directly in the ground—are not allowed. Thank you for helping us maintain a safe, natural, and beautiful resting place for all. Complete cemetery rules and regulations are available at the parish office.

BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS - On *Sunday, April 27*, Blessed Carlo Acutis, a 15-year-old web designer who died of leukemia in 2006, will be canonized as a saint during the Jubilee of Teenagers, making him the first millennial saint. To mark this occasion, Fathom Events will be offering a limited 3 day showing in theaters nationwide of "Carlo Acutis: Roadmap to Reality," the highly anticipated documentary on the life of the soon-to-be saint. It is scheduled to be shown at Cinemark in West Springfield April 27, 28 and 29. Those wishing to see this documentary are strongly encouraged to purchase tickets in advance and online at Cinemark. In honor of this great occasion Bishop William Byrne on Monday, April 28 will offer a Votive Mass at the Dominican Nuns Monastery at 6:00 p.m., immediately preceding the 7:00 p.m. showing at Cinemark.

Qualified Charitable Distribution



A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualified nonprofit organization such as the Basilica of Saint Stanislaus, without having the distribution counted as taxable income.

If you are 70 ½ years of age or older and have a Traditional IRA, you are eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution. Currently in 2025, up to \$108,000 in IRA funds can be counted as Qualified Charitable Distributions annually. For married couples, each spouse can make Qualified Charitable Distributions up to the \$108,000 limit for a potential total of \$216,000.
