Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Peace and all good things to you! I don't know about you, but this seems to be the fastest Lent I've experienced so far in my life. For reasons you know well already, it was also one of the most significant times for me and my family. Regardless of how we might evaluate the success of our Lenten promises and practices, however, Palm Sunday and this spiritual journey of Holy Week invite us to take the focus off ourselves and prayerfully gaze on Jesus. As the author of the Letter to the Hebrews writes, "Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith..." (12:2).

Try that spiritual practice this week. Take St. Matthew's narrative of the Passion of Jesus, the one we hear proclaimed this Sunday, and prayerfully read or listen to a few lines of it each day of Holy Week. What is Jesus saying to you as you see him move toward the cross out of love for you? What do you need him to bring to the cross so that you can experience the joy and peace of Easter? Jesus will be faithful. He will take that sin or fear or resentment into his crucified and glorified hands . . . if we let it go.

BIULETYN Parafialny

W Niedzielę Palmową wpatrujemy się w pokornego Jezusa, który wjeżdża na osiołku do Jerozolimy. To On jest głównym bohaterem dzisiejszej liturgii. Jesteśmy świadkami, jak tłumnie zgromadzeni ludzie stali „swe płaszcze na drodze, a inni obcinali gałązki z drzew i słali nimi drogę. A tłumy, które Go poprzedzały i które szły za Nim, wołały głośno: «Hosanna Synowi Dawida. Błogosławiony Ten, który przychodzi w imię Pańskie. Hosanna na wysokościach»”. W ten sposób ludzie oddawali chwałę Panu. Chwalić kogoś znaczy uznać, że jest dla nas ważny. Kiedy zatem oddaję Bogu chwałę, to uznaję, że tylko On jest ważny, że On jest na pierwszym miejscu. Jeśli to rozumiemy i przyjmujemy – jeśli każdy z nas to rozumie, odkrywamy wówczas i akceptujemy siebie przed Bogiem i przed drugim człowiekiem. Wtedy też na pewno zaczną się lepiej układać nasze wzajemne relacje.



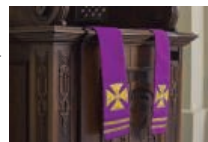
Jedną z chorób współczesnego człowieka jest przywłaszczanie sobie chwały. Jeśli ktoś z nas myśli: „ja jestem ważny”, to z tego punktu widzenia ocenia innych, jako mniej ważnych, będących tłem na własnej „ważności”. I traktuje ich „z góry”. A jedynym uzasadnieniem dla patrzenia na kogoś z góry jest pochylenie się nad nim, żeby pomóc mu się podnieść. Właściwe patrzenie na świat niszczy zatem grzech, głównie grzech pychy, który nie pozwala odkrywać bogactwa chwały Bożej. To grzech pychy zaślepił serca tych, którzy, kiedy usłyszeli od Jezusa słowa prawdy, zamiast radosnego „Hosanna”, zaczęli krzyczeć złośliwie „ukrzyżuj”.

Aby oddawać Bogu chwałę swoim życiem, winniśmy nieustannie łączyć się z Jezusem Chrystusem przez miłość. Jego szlak wiedzie od tryumfalnego „Hosanna” do ufnego zawierzenia woli Ojca, który najlepiej wie, czego nam potrzeba, wpierw, zanim Go jeszcze o to poprosimy. Mamy nieustannie śpiewać „Hosanna” pięknym życiem, opartym na skale, którą jest Boży Syn. To On pomaga nam przetrwać życiowe burze, dźwigać krzyż niezrozumienia, braku sensu życia, zagubienia w świecie nadmiaru informacji i propozycji na szczęśliwe życie. To On pomaga nam wybierać dobro, piękno, prawdę, stawiając tamę głupocie, chamstwu i niszczeniu własnego i cudzego życia. Soeren Kierkegaard snuje taką refleksję w książce pt. *Bojaźń i drżenie*: „(...) każdy był wielki na swój sposób, a każdy w zależności od wielkości tego, co umiował. Albowiem ten, kto umiował siebie, był wielki sam przez siebie; ten, kto kochał ludzi, stał się wielki przez swoje oddanie; ale ten, kto Boga ukochał, stał się największy ze wszystkich” (s. 14).

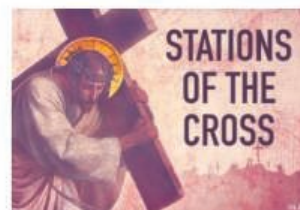

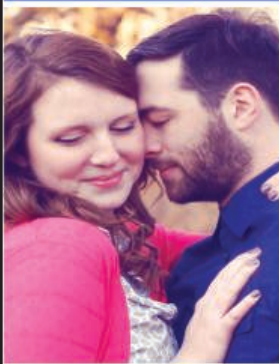

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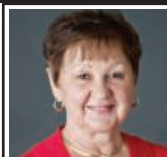
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
