

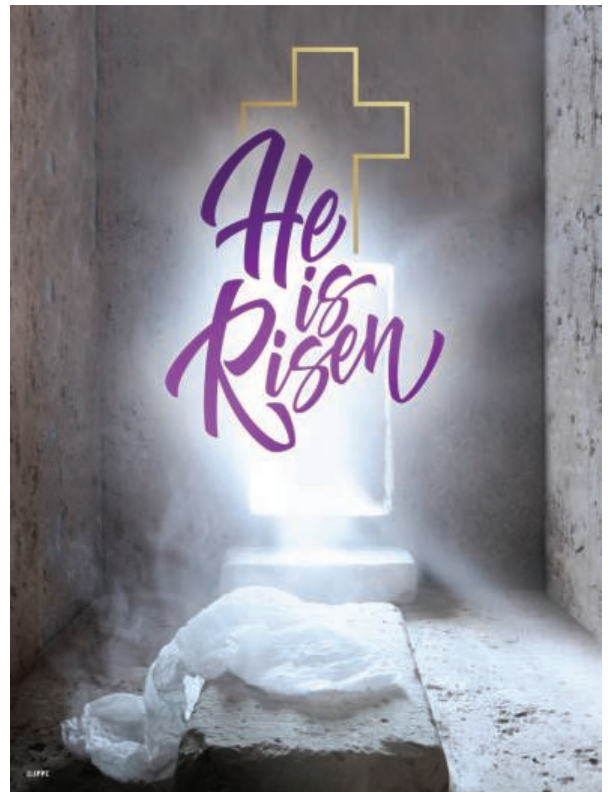

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Happy Easter! Wesołego Alleluja! I wonder what it was like to encounter the risen Jesus those first Easter days.... The gospels describe the various appearances and activities of the risen Christ with his disciples. There are moments when they have no doubt that Jesus is present in a new, unheard-of way. Then there are moments when they fail at first to recognize him. Some scholars, even Christian ones, explain away these real experiences as happening only within the minds or imaginations of the disciples—a sort of consolation from God that everything will be okay. Such scholars betray little knowledge of the scriptures and ancient history.

The ancient peoples believed in ghosts and communication with the dead. If these appearances of Jesus were just some psychological or spiritual experience of Jesus' ghost or mysterious, unseen presence to make the disciples feel better about his death, there would have been nothing special to tell and no gospels to write. It was very clear to the people who had accompanied Jesus that what happened on Easter morning had never been experienced before by anyone. In fact, the risen Jesus changed them from fearful to fearless and even gave them courage to face a martyr's death.

May that same Easter faith, the faith of our baptism, be reawakened in all of us who come to worship on this feast and throughout these 50 days of Easter. May the joy of Easter be contagious as we proclaim that Jesus IS present in our lives and that his presence can transform sin, tragedy, and violence into peace and a life that lasts forever. A blessed Easter to all of you and your families!

THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY will be celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. Mass on April 16, the first Sunday after Easter, which is called Divine Mercy Sunday. Confessions will be heard from Noon to 1:00 p.m., followed by Recitation of the Rosary at 1:00 p.m., and Mass celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. On the day of Sister Faustina's canonization, April 30th, 2000, Pope John Paul II instituted the feast for the whole Church. The institution of the feast was inspired by a desire of Jesus which was conveyed by Sister Faustina. The Lord Jesus told her: *I desire that the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy (Diary 299). I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened (Diary 699).*

BIULETYN Parafialny

Budując dom trzeba zacząć od fundamentu. Jest on bardzo ważny, szczególnie, gdy budujemy na niestabilnym terenie. Jeśli przy budowie domu fundament jest tak ważny, to, co powiemy o „fundamencie” naszego życia? Jaki on powinien być? Na czym postawić życie? Na czym je oprzeć?

Święta Wielkanocne. Nie bez powodu na określenie tych świąt używamy stwierdzenie: „Święta Wielkiej Nocy”. Dlaczego? Bo dokonało się coś wielkiego, coś bardzo ważnego. Dokonało się coś fundamentalnego dla nas. Tym fundamentalnym wydarzeniem świąt Wielkiej Nocy jest śmierć i zmartwychwstanie Jezusa. Pusty grób, o którym mowa w dzisiejszej ewangelii jest znakiem, że śmierć została pokonana; że Chrystus zmartwychwstał! Śmierć i zmartwychwstanie Chrystusa są fundamentem naszego życia, naszej wiary. Na tym fundamencie opiera się chrześcijaństwo i na tym ma się opierać życie każdego chrześcijanina. Na tym fundamencie należy oprzeć nasze życie. Chrześcijanin stawia swoje życie na śmierci i zmartwychwstaniu Chrystusa.

Generalnie my to wiemy, ale wiedzieć to nie wszystko. Tym trzeba żyć. Trzeba żyć śmiercią i zmartwychwstaniem Jezusa. Trzeba oprzeć na śmierci i zmartwychwstaniu życie nasze.

Pewien młody lekarz chciał zrobić karierę. Chcąc osiągnąć ją jak najszybciej zaczął intensywnie uczestniczyć w różnych szkoleniach, kursach, praktykach. Musiał poświęcić soboty i niedziele na studia i szkolenia. Wszystkie wolne „weekendy” spędzał nad książkami, albo na doksztalce. Modlitwa poszła w zapomnienie. Na niedzielną Eucharystię nie miał czasu. Oddalił się od Boga. Tłumaczył sobie, że studiuje żeby pomagać innym. Wspiął się dość szybko na wysokie stanowisko. W wieku 47 lat dowiedział się, że ma raka. Załamał się. Pewnego dnia, późnym popołudniem w jego gabinecie spotkała go sprzątaczką. Siedział tam zrozpaczony. Zaczęli rozmawiać. W pewnym momencie ta prosta kobieta powiedziała mu: „Panie doktorze,...na czym Pan postawił swoje życie? Pan nie wiedział, że kariera to nie wszystko? Przecież Pan jest chrześcijaninem...”. Odpowiedział: „Wiedziałem, że są inne wartości; podstawy, ale...”. I tu się rozplakał.

Na czym ty budujesz – stawiasz gmach swojego życia, na co, stawiasz w swoim życiu? Odpowiedz szczerze. Bo prawdą jest, że każdy człowiek zasadniczo na coś stawia? Na co ty stawiasz w życiu? Stawiasz na pieniądze, na zdrowie, na karierę?

St Stanislaus Parishioners participated in the **40 DAYS FOR LIFE** on March 25. 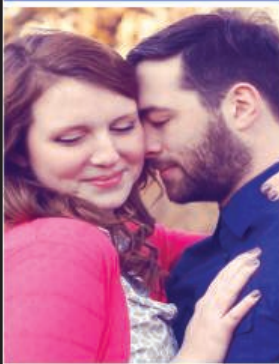
LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

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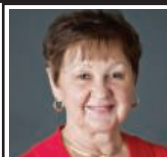
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
