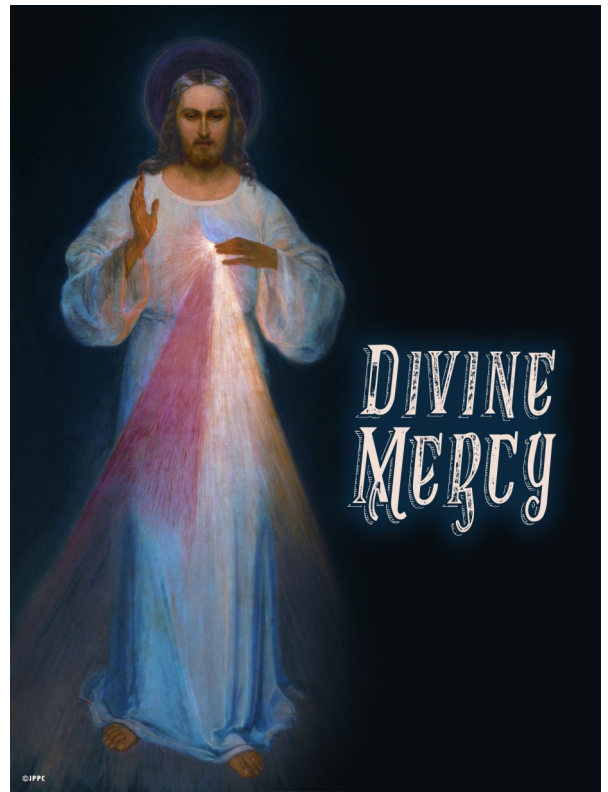

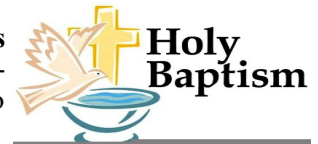

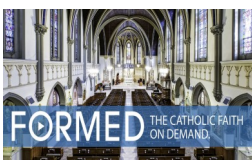

THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY will be celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. Mass on ***April 16***, the first Sunday after Easter, which is called Divine Mercy Sunday. Confessions will be heard from Noon to 1:00 p.m., followed by Recitation of the Rosary at 1:00 p.m., and Mass celebrated at the 1:30 p.m. On the day of Sister Faustina's canonization, April 30th, 2000, Pope John Paul II instituted the feast for the whole Church. The institution of the feast was inspired by a desire of Jesus which was conveyed by Sister Faustina. The Lord Jesus told her: *I desire that the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy* (Diary 299). *I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened* (Diary 699).

BIULETYN Parafialny

W II niedzielę po Wielkanocy powtarzamy za Psalmistą: „Dziękujcie Panu, bo jest miłosierny”. Wzrok nasz wędruje najpierw do Wieczernika, w którym Jezus przychodzi do Apostołów, aby umocnić ich wiarę. To spotkanie ma jednak wyjątkowy charakter. Bierze w nim udział Tomasz Apostoł, którego zwykliśmy określać mianem „niewiernego Tomasza”. Dostrzegamy, słuchając Janowej Ewangelii, że wiara tego ucznia była jeszcze zbyt słaba, aby uwierzył świadectwu innych Apostołów. Potrzebował namacalnych dowodów. Chyba to nas nie powinno dziwić. Ile to razy my sami, którzy tak wiele słyszymy o Zmartwychwstałym, powtarzamy pełni niedowierzania: „jak nie zobaczę, to nie uwierzę”.



Radość z dzisiejszej liturgii płynie dla nas z faktu, że razem ze św. Piotrem możemy uwielbiać Boga: „Niech będzie błogosławiony Bóg i Ojciec Pana naszego, Jezusa Chrystusa. On w swoim wielkim miłosierdziu przez powstanie z martwych Jezusa Chrystusa na nowo zrodził nas do żywej nadziei”. To uwielbienie związane jest z darem, jaki otrzymaliśmy od Boga. Staliśmy się, dzięki zmartwychwstaniu Jezusa Chrystusa, świadkami nadziei.

Świadectwem nadziei dla współczesnego świata jest również Święto Miłosierdzia Bożego. To była wola samego Boga, którą wyraził za pośrednictwem św. Siostry Faustyny, zakonnicy ze Zgromadzenia Matki Bożej Miłosierdzia w dniu 22 lutego 1931 roku w Płocku. Święto Miłosierdzia dał Pan Jezus grzesznikom jako „ostatnią deskę ratunku”. Z dobrze odprawioną spowiedzią i Komunią św. przyjętą w tym dniu związana jest obietnica „pełnego odpuszczenia win i kar” (Dz. 300). A więc takiej łaski, jaką otrzymujemy tylko w sakramencie chrztu świętego. Źródło miłosierdzia wypływają z przebitego boku Zbawiciela. Chrystus mówił do św. Faustyny: „rana serca mojego jest źródłem niezgłębionego miłosierdzia” (Dz. 1190). Owa rana – przebity bok i serce – staje się dla całej ludzkości źródłem miłosierdzia Bożego. Na znanym nam dobrze obrazie Jezusa Miłosiernego „Jezu, ufam Tobie” z przebitego boku Chrystusa wypływają promienie: błądy i czerwony. Chrystus wyjaśnia Faustynie, co one oznaczają, mówiąc: „Te dwa promienie oznaczają krew i wodę – błądy promień oznacza wodę, która usprawiedliwia dusze; czerwony promień oznacza krew, która jest życiem dusz...” (Dz. 299). W innym miejscu Chrystus zachęca: „niech korzystają z krwi i wody, która dla nich wytrysła” (Dz. 848).



DZIĘKUJEMY - Składamy serdeczne podziękowania wszystkim, którzy przyczynili się do przygotowania i przeżycia Triduum Paschalnego i Uroczystości Zmartwychwstania: za przygotowanie kościoła, kwiatów, Bożego Grobu i Służbie Liturgicznej za przygotowanie liturgii i oprawy muzycznej. Wiernym za wytrwałe uczestnictwo w liturgii, osobom starszym i chorym, którzy nie mogąc uczestniczyć w liturgii w kościele, a którzy łączyli się z nami duchowo. Wszystkim Parafianom i Gościom życzymy by Pan im błogosławił, obdarzał obfitymi łaskami i napępiał serca nadzieją na to, że kiedyś otrze z naszych oczu wszelką łzę. Dziękujemy za wielką życzliwość i wszelkie dobro uczynione naszej Parafialnej Wspólnocie.
