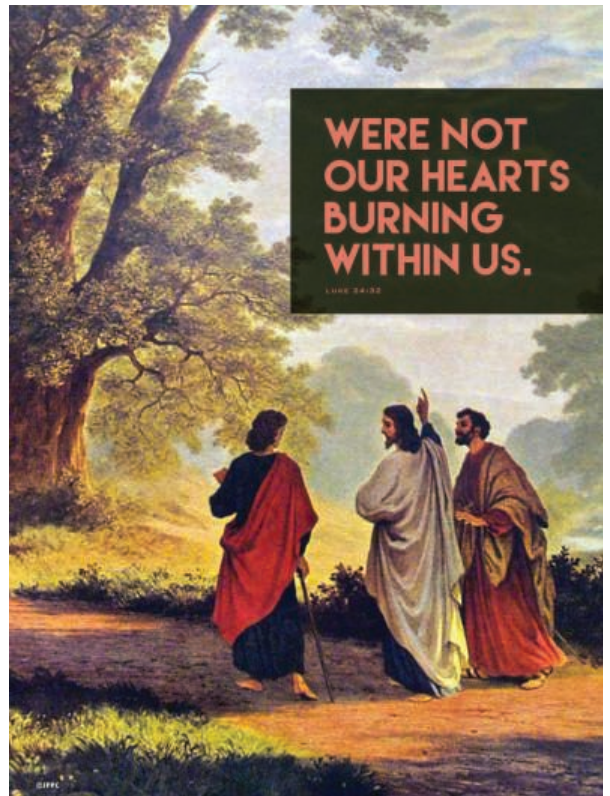

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter peace and all good things to you! The gospel passage this Third Sunday of Easter is a classic and a favorite of so many, including me. We have the opportunity to join spiritually with two disciples who were walking away from Jerusalem after they had just seen their teacher and master crucified two days before. They could not wrap their minds around the stories of the women who had encountered the risen Jesus. Unbelievable--or so they thought. Where were these disciples headed? Undoubtedly, they needed to "get away from it all," or perhaps they were full of fear they might be guilty by association with Jesus and be the next ones to hang on a cross. They were walking away from the place of their pain and fear and grief--all the while trying to figure out what this death meant for them.

Then this mysterious yet compelling stranger begins to walk with them, answers their questions, and opens their minds and hearts to the story of God's love for them and the meaning of the cross and resurrection in their lives. Their hearts begin to burn, and they recognize the risen Lord when he breaks the bread for them. They start walking back to Jerusalem. In fact, they seem to be almost running back to share the news of their encounter with the risen Lord. They are able to return to the place of tragedy and pain and squarely face it after they know the presence of the Lord with them.

Are there any places of pain or fear or grief we're running from this Easter season? Will we allow the risen Jesus to walk with us in those places and be open to his grace? Will we allow him to feed us and heal us with his very self in the Eucharist as food for the journey? Jesus will do all this if we let him.

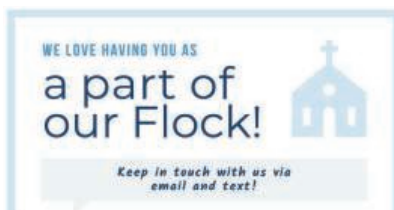

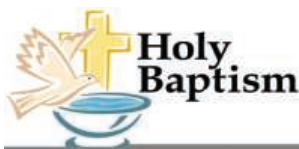

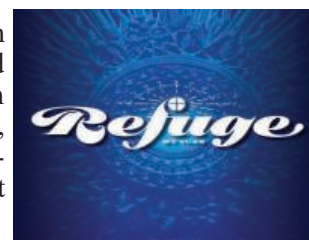

BIULETYN Parafialny



Św. Łukasz kreśli w dzisiejszej Ewangelii obraz pierwszej popaschalnej wspólnoty uczniów. I nie jest to obraz zbyt optymistyczny. Po śmierci Jezusa wspólnota rozpada się; każdy próbuje na swój sposób przetrwać trudne chwile, pokonać smutek, żal, ból i frustracje. „Dwaj z nich” (Łukasz i Kleofas) opuszczają Jerozolimę i udają się do Emaus. Jerozolima jest miejscem męki i śmierci ich Mistrza, symbolem rozczarowania i niezrealizowanych nadziei. Emaus to miejsce, które pozwoli zapomnieć o cierpieniu i porażce.

„Drogi nasze codziennie wiodą do Emaus”(Maciej Kononowicz). Nasze Emaus – to miejsce wymarzone, bez cierpienia i krzyża, świat iluzji i utopii, własny raj na ziemi... Ale czy realny? Co jest moim miejscem ucieczki, „moim Emaus”? Czym jestem rozczarowany? Przed czym uciekam?

W drodze do Emaus uczniowie są egocentryczni, zajęci sobą, własnym bólem i krzywdą, poczuciem zawodu i są przez to ślepi – nie widzą Jezusa, który cierpliwie, delikatnie, z akceptacją i miłością włącza się w ich dialog. Uczniowie czują, że ich „serca pałają”, napełniają się pokojem, nadzieją, miłością, dotykają Boga. O podobnym przeżyciu pisze św. Augustyn w swoich „Wyznaniach”. W czasie duchowej rozmowy ze swoją matką – św. Moniką, niedługo przed jej śmiercią, gdy „chłonęli sercem niebiańskie strumienie wypływające z (Bożego) źródła, czas nagle się zatrzymał i [oboje] dotknęli Boga”. Rozmawiając o życiu duchowym, o sprawach Bożych można dotknąć nieba, poczuć wewnętrzny pokój, radość i miłość.

Serca uczniów pałają również dlatego, że Jezus pomaga im zrozumieć ich negatywne uczucia, emocje. Przyczyną ich cierpienia, bólu i smutku jest zamknięcie w sobie, brak otwartości na słowa proroków, słowa Pisma i Jezusa. Serca uczniów są zatwardziałe, „sklerotyczne”. Chcą mierzyć wszystko swoją miarą – chwały, sukcesu, korzyści, hierarchii świata. Trudno im nadal zrozumieć, że miarą Boga jest najpierw cierpienie, krzyż, a dopiero później zmartwychwstanie. Przez trzy lata życia z Jezusem tak mało się nauczyli...

Jezus uczy uczniów (i nas) odnosić historię życia do słów Pisma. W sytuacjach pytań, wątpliwości w wierze, problemów i trudnych sytuacji życiowych warto sięgać do Pisma Świętego i wsłuchiwać się w jego słowa. Wtedy historia życia i „wielkie problemy” ukażą się w całkowicie innym świetle. Pismo Święte pozwala zrozumieć znaczenie bolesnych faktów w życiu Jezusa, Kościoła, wspólnoty i naszym osobistym.

Commitment to attend meetings and to prepare sufficiently for them.

Required to serve on at least two of the standing committees of the Parish Council or Ministry Groups once elected.

Active in Parish ministries/committees for at least *one year*.

- Parishioners may submit their own names or the names of others for consideration.
- All those whose names have been submitted will be reviewed.
- Qualified individuals will be contacted to discuss the nature, purpose & functions of the Parish Council.
- If still interested, the nominee will be invited to meet with the full Nominating Committee to further discern their interest.
- The final list of qualified Nominees will be prepared by the Nominating Committee and presented to the Parish Council for their consideration.

The Parish Council will then approve the list of Nominees to be seated for the next council year.

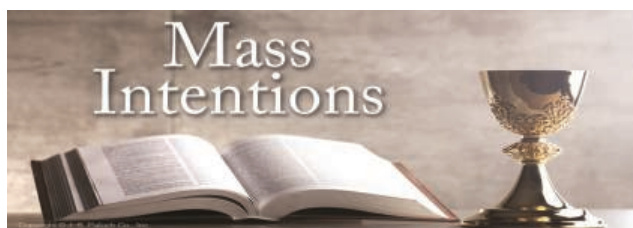

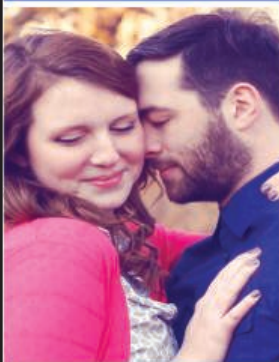

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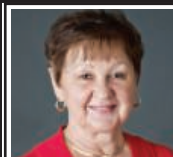
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
